A DIFFERENT STREAK NOTE: Brooks Lee has been an integral part of the Saints offense since returning from the Injured List, scoring his fair share of runs. Lee has crossed home plate in each of his last nine games, plating 13 runs in that span. It's the longest run streak for the Saints this year, the fourth-longest in the IL and the longest active streak among full-season minor league teams. It's the second-longest streak in June 9, 2022.

WALLNER WARMING UP: In his 19 June games, Matt Wallner has hit .326/.396/.748 sporting a 1.154 OPS. He's hit a league-high 12 home runs in his this month, averaging a 93.4 mph exit velocity and owns a .432 ISO in that span. He's also the league leader in June in RBI (28), total bases (72) and extra-base hits (17) and runs (25).

S Wallner's 12 home runs in June are the most for any Triple-A player in any month this season and tied for the most for any IL batter in any month since 2021. Wallner is the 18th IL batter since 2021 to hit 10 home runs in a month and just the second Saint to accomplish the feat, joining Chris Williams, who hit 10 home runs in June of 2023.

LEE'S LOCKED IN: Brooks Lee has made his presence known in a hurry since returning to the Saints lineup. Over his last 13 games, Lee is hitting .397 (23-for-58), collecting hits in 12 of those 13 games, hitting four doubles, six home runs, owning a 1.238 OPS. **LAST APPEARANCE:** 6/22 v TOL...made 13<sup>th</sup> start of the season, tying his season-high with 7.0 innings pitched, allowing just three hits and striking out five...marks the Saints' second start this year of 7.0 innings without allowing any runs or walks, matching Louie Varland's effort on May 3...allowed singles in the second and third innings and a double in the fifth...struck out four of the final seven batters that he faced...was his third quality start of his last four outings...his eighth start without issuing a walk...tied the league lead by picking up his eighth win of the season in a 9-7 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 6/16 @ LOU...made 12th start of the season and second of the series in Louisville...pitched his fourth quality start of the season, allowing three runs on five hits, walking one and striking out three over 6.2 innings...pitched into the seventh for the second time this season...only allowed one baserunner over first three innings on lone walk allowed...did not allow a hit until there was one out in the fourth inning, promptly erasing it on a double play to the next batter...surrendered a solo home run to Blake Dunn in the sixth inning...allowed two singles in the seventh, erasing the first on a double play...gave up a triple to hits final batter that brought second run in...bequeathed one runner to Scott Blewett that scored after his departure...picked up seventh win, tying the league lead at the time in 5-3 Saints victory.

WORLD SERIES RUNNER-UP: Caleb spent his college years not far from home at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. As a freshman, he got to experience something that not many players get the opportunity to experience: a trip to the College World Series. His DIII squad reached the championship after beating Salisbury, 7-3, Emory, 3-2 in 12, losing the first game of the semifinals to Trinity(TX), 16-7, but bouncing back to win the second game, 10-7. Unfortunately, they met their match in the championship dropping the best-of-three to Cortland, getting swept 11-3 and 6-2. He would get back to the DIII World Series in 2016, but this was less successful losing 8-0 to Trinity, beating Emory, 12-3 before being eliminated by the team they lost to in the 2015 DIII Championship Game, Cortland, 8-3.

**SOMETHINGS BREWING:** One can't help where they grow up which can determine who you root for growing up. Caleb was born in Neenah, WI and resides in Madison, WI, so naturally he rooted for the Milwaukee Brewers. His hometown team came calling in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021, taking Caleb with the 22nd pick overall from the San Diego Padres. The storybook had an incredible ending when he was called up to the Brewers on September 29, 2023. He pitched 2.1 innings of relief vs. Chicago Cubs and allowed one run on one hit while walking two and striking out five. He earned the win in his lone Major League appearance.

**GIVE BACK:** Each of the Major League team's usually choose a player or players within their organization for the hard work they put towards the community. In 2023, the Brewers selected Caleb as the Nashville Sounds Community Player of the Year.
