RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (23-10)



RHP Andre Sanchez (0-2, 4.38 ERA) vs. RHP Christian Zazueta (2-1, 2.55 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for game one of a six-game set, as your first-place Quakes host the Inland Empire 66ers in game one of the six-game series. Tonight is Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans can log on to our website during every Recycle Tuesday and learn how to score a free ticket to that Tuesday's game. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the seventh of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the first of 12 here at home. Last year, the Quakes went 7-5 here at home against the 66ers, 17-7 overall. Rancho took five of six at Inland Empire just three weeks ago in their only series of 2025.

LAST GAME: The Quakes thumped Visalia again on Sunday afternoon, winning by a final of 14-3 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Mike Sirota clobbered two home runs (6,7) and drove in five and six Quakes finished with at least two hits, with Sirota and Mairo Martinus leading the way with three each. Logan Tabeling went three innings in his first start, while newcomer Shawndrick Oduber (1-0) netted the win in his debut. Visalia's Grayson Hitt (0-1) took the loss, allowing four runs while recording just four outs. The win for Rancho gives them four of six in the series, marking their fourth straight series-win and giving them five series wins on the year (5-1-0)

LONG-BALLS: Rancho clubbed a total of eight home runs over the six-game set in Visalia, giving them a league-high 27 round-trippers in 33 games. San Jose is next up with 23. Mike Sirota went deep twice and moved into the top spot for home run hitters in the Cal League with seven, one more than teammate Eduardo Quintero.

EVEN MORE WEEKLY AWARDS: The Cal League Awards just keep coming for Rancho, with Eduardo Quintero getting tabbed as this week's Player of the Week. Quintero, the fourth Quake to win a weekly award this year, hit .375 (9-for-24) last week with three homers, five RBIs and six walks, giving him OBP of .500 for the week.

OH THOSE ROSTER MOVES: Rancho took their first offensive gut punch to the roster on Monday, as OF Mike Sirota was promoted to High-A Great Lakes. It was a very deserved promotion, as Sirota was tops in the league in homers (7), slugging (.687), OPS (1.130) and extra-base hits (17). On Thursday, the Quakes promoted two of their most valuable arms to High-A Great Lakes. Starting pitcher Sean Paul Linan, who, at the time, led all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts with 50 over just 29.2 innings, will be making his first trip to High-A. Reliever Alex Makarewich, who did not allowed an earned run over his first 13 innings and has 27 strikeouts is also in High-A for the first time. Shawn Oduber took one of those open roster spots and debuted on Sunday in Visalia. Joendry Vargas, who's been gone from the team for exactly one month with an injury, has been activated from the Injured List.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his seventh start of the year and his second against Inland Empire. In his only outing against Inland Empire, he allowed one unearned run on two hits over five innings in a win on April 25th. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on two hits over three inniings in a no-decision at Visalia on May 7th. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 as part of the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

ANDRE SANCHEZ: Right-hander Andre Sanchez makes his eighth appearance, his seventh start, and his second start against the Quakes. In his only outing against Rancho, he allowed four runs on seven hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision on April 26th. In his last outing, he allowed three runs on four hits over jsut 2.1 innings in a no-decision against Stockton on May 8th. Last year, Sanchez pitched exclusively for Inland Empire, going 3-8 with a 6.88 ERA over 24 games (19 starts). The Angels signed Sanchez out of Cordoba, Mexico in May of 2022.
