SPRINGDALE, AR — The Northwest Arkansas Naturals mashed a season-high 17 hits, with six player collecting multi-hit games in an 8-7 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles Friday night at Arvest Ballpark

- Second baseman Michael Massey, left fielder Nate Eaton and center fielder John Rave each collected three hits, with Rave falling a home run short of the cycle. Nick Loftin, Robbie Glendinning and Jake Means each contributed two-hit nights as well, with Glendinning, Eaton, Rave and Means each driving in two runs.
- Eaton started the scoring in the second, leading off the inning with a solo home run, his second of the season. Rave tripled moments later, then came home to score on a Means groundout.
- After Amarillo tied the score with two runs in the fourth, Northwest Arkansas responded with three runs in the fifth, as Rave doubled home two, then Means singled him home.
- The Sod Poodles inched a run closer in the sixth, but the Naturals answered back with a two-run double from Glendinning, his second two-bagger of the game, and an RBI single from Eaton, his third hit of the game.
- Making his second start of the season, left-hander Dante Biasi allowed two runs with four strikeouts across 3.2 innings. Southpaw Walter Pennington picked up the win in relief, with 2.1 innings of one-run baseball, striking out three for his third decision in as many appearances with the Naturals.
- After Stephen Woods Jr. pitched 1.2 innings, Jonah Dipoto shut the door for the Naturals, recording the final four outs with three strikeouts across 1.1 innings for his first save of the year.

The Naturals are 7-3 all-time when playing on April 30

On April 30, 2008, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 11-6 at Hammons Field behind a two-homer, six-RBI afternoon from Naturals designated hitter **Brian McFall**. McFall connected on a two-run homer in the fifth, then connected on the team's second grand slam of the season in the sixth. Starting pitcher Carlos Rosa threw 6.0 scoreless innings, surrendering just four hits without a walk and seven strikeouts, earning his third win of the season.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active 1.63 steals/game) and pulled off a double steal 5 times. roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 26 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 26 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started Tuesday and will go again Sunday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- **■** LHP **Anthony Veneziano** started Wednesday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa started Thursday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- RHP **Alec Marsh** starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP **Asa Lacv** has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF **Nick Loftin** is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking second walks (18) system.
- C **Sebastian Rivero** is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 15 games, the Naturals have stolen 31 bases in 35 attempts (average

- 30 steals ranks 2nd in the Texas League, while a 86.11% success rate on steals ranks 7th among teams with at least 30 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's seven steals (in nine attempts) ranks tied for fourth in the Texas League.

Nate is Great

Utility man Nate Eaton is making a strong case to be the next Texas League player of the week, putting together a ridiculous six-game stretch dating back to last week in Frisco.

- Eaton enters tonight's game on a six-game hitting streak, tied for the longest on the team this season, along with Tucker Bradley and Robbie Glendinning's current stretches ... since April 23, Eaton is 13-for-23 (.565 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.500 OPS.
- This week, Eaton is hitting .500 against Amarillo, 8-for-16 at the plate with four runs batted in, three steals and a 1.306 OPS.
- With 10 starts (88.0 innings) at third base, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field, 2 starts (18.0 innings) in right field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than two positions in the field.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia has reached base in all 15 games he's played started the season, hitting .300 (15-for-50) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 13 walks, giving him a .453 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning is the ONLY Natural that has reached base in every game played this season, his 15-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth in the Texas League.
- Among 10 qualified Naturals hitters, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in on-base percentage (.453), slugging percentage (.560) and OPS (1.013), while ranking tied second on the team with 13 runs batted in, tied second in runs scored (13) and tied second in walks (13)... his .471 OBP ranks fifth in the Texas League, while his .991 OPS is 9th.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 17 on the season, which is tied for the Texas League lead and tied for third in Double-A.

- In 87 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 36 times, for a .414 on-base percentage (18 hits + 18 walks).
- and tied for fourth in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia endured a five-game hitless streak from April 19 to 27, where he went 0-for-23 with five four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped over 100 points, entering 4/19 batting .406, but was at .241 after April 26.
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
