The Nuts and Caps split a six-game series at LMCU Ballpark in June; a Caps win tonight would clinch another series split, while a Lugnuts victory would give Lansing its second series win of 2021.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Whitecaps 3. Colin Peluse tossed his third quality start of the year, allowing one earned run in six innings, striking out six, and the Lugnuts took the lead in the first inning and never looked back in the Saturday night win. Patrick McColl hit a two-run homer to right, his third career professional roundtripper.

On Deck: The Nuts returning home for an off day tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand July 27-August 1 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

No Place Like Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is fourth in the Majors in batting average (.325), second in home runs (32), tied for first in RBIs (79), first in on-base percentage (.426), second in slugging (.669), first in total bases (224), first in OPS (1.094) and tied for first in runs scored (75). 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, playing for Beloit (MIA), leads the Minors with 23 homers.

Going Deep: Is it difficult to homer at LMCU Ballpark? Sure it is, but don't tell the Lugnuts. Lansing has hit four home runs in this series -- a two-run shot by Cobie Vance in the opener, a grand slam by Austin Beck three days ago, and a two-run roundtripper from Michael Guldberg two days ago, and a two-run dinger by Patrick McColl last night. In total, the Lugnuts have seven home runs in 11 games at West Michigan. In comparison, the Whitecaps have hit 15 home runs at home in 34 games.

Countdown to 400: We are nine meetings away from the 400th game between the Lugnuts and Whitecaps all-time, currently scheduled to take place on September 15th in Lansing. The Lugs lead the all-time series, 196-195.

Heading to the Show: Yesterday, the Baltimore Orioles promoted 2015 Lugnuts pitcher Conner Greene to the Majors. When he debuts, Greene will become the 158th Nut all-time to reach MLB and the fourth this year.

Hoya Saxa: Right-hander Jack Cushing, a product of Georgetown, has been brilliant since joining the Lugnuts from Low-A Stockton. Cushing's appearances: six innings, one run vs. Dayton; a seven-inning complete game, one run at Great Lakes; five shutout innings of relief vs. Lake County; and Thursday night's six innings, two runs at West Michigan. All told, Cushing has 25 strikeouts and five walks in 24 innings with a 1.50 ERA, allowing an OBA of .157.

Trusted Relief: This series involves the most heavily used relief pitchers in the High-A Central, with Jared Tobey (28 games, 1st in the league), Dalton Sawyer (27 games, 2nd), Zack Hess (26 games, tied-3rd), and Charles Hall and Angel Reyes (25 games, tied-5th).

Whitecaps Killer: Drew Millas went 3-for-5 and is now hitting 16-for-36 (.444) with seven runs, two doubles, two homers and seven walks (.523 on-base percentage) in nine games against West Michigan this year. Millas also enters today having hit safely in his last eight games, tied for the second longest hitting streak on the team.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: Matthew Boyd, the Blue Jays' 6th-round pick in June from Oregon State, made his professional debut in relief with a scoreless eighth inning, allowing two singles and striking out two, in the Lugnuts' 8-0 loss to Dayton at Cooley Law School Stadium. The Nuts managed six singles in defeat. Daniel Norris started and tossed 3 1/3 innings, allowing five hits and six runs, striking out six.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Roster Index: The newest Nut, José Mora, is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1999 (38), 2001 (40) and 2009 (38) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.6% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Taylor Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Fables and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Diaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McCall set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McCall played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McCall, and outfielder Michael Guldborg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birling-mair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

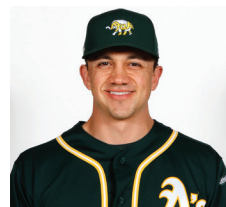

Command Artist: Of 360 total batters faced in his Minor League career, Leal has walked just nine -- two intentionally (both on June 23, 2021, at Cedar Rapids) -- while striking out 110.

Last Outing: Started July 18 vs. Lake County, pitching three scoreless innings, allowing two hits, walking none and striking out four... needed only 51 pitches, 35 strikes... departed in scoreless game... Captains won, 4-2.

2021:

- Began the season with Stockton, appearing in relief on Opening Day, May 4 at Modesto, and tossing three scoreless innings.
- First three appearances with the Ports were all in relief, totaling 7 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 12 K.
- Received first start in series opener at Visalia, May 18: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R (2 ER), 0 BB, 4 K.
- Worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K).
- In all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced in the High-A West, spanning 26 2/3 innings.
- Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland... made Lugnuts debut that same day, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... removed after walking James Outman, yielding to Brady Basso with runners at 1st and 2nd and one out... Basso stranded the runners... Lugnuts went on to win, 9-7, with two runs in the bottom of the 7th.
- Originally slated to start opener on June 22 at Cedar Rapids, but game was postponed due to rain... moved into piggybacking on opener Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 of June 23 doubleheader... held the Kernels to only one hit (Trey Cabbage double) and no walks in first four innings of relief... in bottom of the 7th inning with the game tied 0-0, allowed a second double to Cabbage, who moved to third on a Jair Camargo flyout to right... issued a pair of intentional walks to load the bases, then struck out Michael Helman for the second out... got in front of No. 9 batter Gabriel Mielci 1-and-2, but served up walk-off grand slam in 4-0 Lugnuts loss... struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings in defeat.
- Started June 29 vs. Dayton and suffered the loss: 4 2/3 IP, 9 H, 6 R, 1 BB, 6 K, allowing two home runs in Lugnuts' 10-8 series-opening defeat... gave up two-run homer to Eric Yang in the 2nd inning and two-run homer to Juan Martinez in the 3rd inning... departed with bases loaded in the 5th and watched reliever Sam Romero allow two of the inherited runners to score.
- Started July 6 at Great Lakes: 5 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 0 BB, 7 K, 3 HR... allowed home runs in three straight innings, 2nd-4th, hit by Brandon Lewis, Ryan Ward and Deacon Liput... Lugnuts lost, 8-2, in eight rain-shortened innings.

This young man came into our program and changed his body, overcame a significant foot injury and absolutely attacked the game with a relentless work ethic. He found a way to get better every day, and is one of the best I've ever seen at commanding the baseball. He is what our program is all about. Tremendous character and makeup, great student, selfless and just a wonderful teammate. He is the ultimate competitor and undoubtedly will go down as one of the best to ever step foot on the mound for the Bulldogs."

Pro Debut 2019: Debut in A's system on June 27 in AZL... did not walk his first batter until 10th appearance, 20 innings in... promoted to Stockton for final appearance of the year, August 31 at San Jose... base stealers went just 2-for-4 in attempts against him... left-handed batters hit 3-for-44 (.068) with 0 walks and 19 K's... right-handers batted 22-for-102 (.216) with 4 walks and 32 K.
