**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field for game four of a six-game series, as your Quakes continue a six-game home stand against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Tonight is Friends Night, thanks to IEHP, as 1,500 fans will take home a Friends/Quakes Mug. The Friends couch will be here and Quakes players will be wearing special Friends jerseys, which will be auctioned off later tonight. Tonight's game is already sold out!

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 16th of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the tenth of 12 at home. The Quakes are currently 9-6 against the 66ers in 2024 (4-5 at home), with the first six games taking place at San Manuel. Last year, the Quakes went 6-9 at home, 14-13 overall against the 66ers.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes saw the 66ers score the game's final seven runs, coming back to defeat Rancho on Thursday night by a score of 8-6 at LoanMart Field. Rancho built a 6-1 lead, but saw Inland score two in the fifth, four in the sixth, then add another in the seventh to win the final game of the first half. Samuel Munoz and Josue De Paula both had two-run singles to help the Quakes build a five-run lead against Inland Empire starter Riley Bauman. The 66ers' finally got going in the fifth against Rancho reliever Christian Zazueta (0-1), who allowed six runs over just 1.2 innings of work in the loss. The Quakes had just one hit over their final four innings against the 66ers' bullpen. Cam Tullar (2-1) allowed one run and earned the win, while Alex Martinez got the final two outs for his second save.

**TIP OF THE CAP TO THE STORM:** The Lake Elsinore Storm defeated the Visalia Rawhide on Tuesday night by a final of 5-3, making the result of Rancho's game against Inland Empire a moot point. To start the week, the Quakes needed to go 3-0 over the final three games of the first half, while also needing the Storm to lose all three in Visalia. The Storm will return to the playoffs for the first time since 2022, when they last won the Cal League Title. Modesto clinched the First Half North Division on Sunday, also with a win in Visalia.

**SECOND HALF STARTS TONIGHT:** The second half of the Cal League season kicks off tonight, strangely enough, in the midst of their respective six-game series. If Lake Elsinore wins the second half like they did the first half, then the team with the next best record in the second half would go to the South Division Finals to meet the Storm.

This rule changed two years ago from the team with the next best overall record to the next best second half record.

**WAGNER IS PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Logan Wagner had a career-week in Fresno, going 11-for-21 (.524 avg) with four homers and seven RBIs in six games, in being named Cal League Player of the Week. He also walked four times for an OBP of .600 and had an incredible OPS of 1.838.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Friday's starting pitcher Wyatt Crowell was transferred to the Rancho roster earlier today, as he joins the team from the Arizona Complex League. In addition, relievers Jesus Luna and Carson Hobbs have been transferred to Great Lakes to start the second half. The Rancho roster now sits at 28 active players to open the half.

**WYATT CROWELL:** Left-hander Wyatt Crowell makes his Cal League debut tonight for the Quakes and his fifth total appearance of 2024. Crowell joins the Quakes today from the Arizona Complex League, where in four starts, he pitched just six innings, allowing four runs on just two hits, but with four walks and nine strikeouts. The lefty was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida State University.

**ANDRE SANCHEZ:** Inland Empire right-hander Andre Sanchez makes his tenth start of the year and second against the Quakes. His lone start against Rancho was a win on May 18, when he allowed two runs on five hits over five innings of work. In his last start overall, he allowed just two hits over six scoreless innings in a win at San Jose on June 15. Sanchez was signed by the Angels in 2022 out of Veracruz, Mexico.
