LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped their third consecutive game in a 9-3 loss to the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Wednesday afternoon. Richmond scored four of its nine runs in the first inning against starter Brandon Young on three RBI hits. Max Wagner hit his first homer of the season to straight away center and Bowie closed the deficit to two at one point in the fifth. However, Richmond pulled away behind three homers off Kyle Brnovich to win the second game of the series.

STRIKE 'EM OUT, HIT 'EM OUT

After homers from Max Wagner and Dylan Beavers yesterday, Bowie leads the league in home runs with 41. Over the last 10 games, Bowie has hit 13 homers. Last year, Bowie hit the fourth-most homers in the league with 148. The Baysox pitching staff also leads the Eastern League and is second in all of Double-A in strikeouts with

JUD FLEXIN' ON EM

OF Jud Fabian has continued to stay hot in the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect launched his team-leading eighth homer of the season in the first inning on Tuesday with a two-run shot. The homer was Fabian's sixth of the month, which is tied for the league lead along with Harrisburg's Brady House. In the month of May, Fabian is slashing .283/.348/.617 with six homers and 15 RBI. The 23-year-old is fifth in the Eastern League with eight homers this season.

BASALLO BLASTS

C Samuel Basallo ended a 52 at-bat home run drought on Tuesday with an opposite field homer off LHP Nick Swiney. It was the second time this season that Basallo has teed off against the Richmond southpaw reliever and the homer was his fourth against a lefty this year. Last season, Basallo hit three homers against lefties across Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has three multihit performances over his last four games.

BEAVS HITS 'EM DEEP

OF **Dylan Beavers** hit his third homer in five games on Wednesday with a solo homer in the eighth. The Orioles No. 7 prospect has hit four of his six home runs on the season in the month of May. After hitting just two homers in 34 games last season in Bowie, Beavers now has six in his first 35 contests to begin this year.

SUPERBAD SETH

RHP Seth Johnson makes his eighth start of the season and his second against Richmond. The Orioles No. 10 prospect most recently dealt four innings and allowed one unearned run over three hits, one walk and three strikeouts in a no decision at Binghamton last Friday. Johnson struck out a season-high six over four frames in his last meeting against Richmond on April 28. The 25-year-old is looking to pitch five innings for the first time this season and in Double-A.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are fifth in the Southwest Division at 17-22 but most recently took five of six against Reading at home. The Double-A affiliate of the Giants took four of six against Bowie in the first meeting of the season at The Diamond. Seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster-RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), OF Grant McCray (OF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26), and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP John Michael Bertrand makes his ninth appearance and eighth start of the season. The 26-year-old most recently pitched 5.2 innings and allowed just one run on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts in a no decision vs Reading last Friday. In his last meeting against Bowie on April 27, Bertrand spun 7.0 perfect innings with four strikeouts on just 68 pitches. The southpaw leads the staff in IP and has thrown five or more innings in six of his eight outings this year with a WHIP of just 1.14.

QUICK HITS

No. 10 Orioles prospect via MLB Pipelin ϵ

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23 Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. Threw 4.0 innings, struck out three and gave up one unearned run over three hits and one walk in a no decision in most recent start on 5/17 @ BNG. Looking to pitch five innings for first time this season and at Double-A. Also looking for first Double-A win. In last start against Richmond, struck out season-high six batters over 4.0 innings of two-run ball on 4/28 @ RIC. Did not allow a run through first three innings before giving up two runs in fourth.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award Collowing his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticute He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
