CARDS STRIKE FIRST BUT FALL TO MISSIONS: The Cardinals took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on an RBI single by Matt Lloyd but were held to just 4 hits for the rest of the evening as Springfield fell to the San Antonio Missions 4-1 on Thursday night at Hammons Field. Dakota Harris had two hits for Springfield including a double, but the Cardinals went just 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position against three San Antonio pitchers. Springfield starter Tink Hence struck out 5 Missions over just 3.2 innings but was tagged with the loss. Nathanael Heredia and Wilfredo Pereira combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Ryan Bergert** makes his 17th start of the season for the Missions... Last pitched on Satruday, August 9 agaisnt Frisco and allowed 2 ER on 7 H with 4 K over 3.2 IP...Over 3 starts in July went 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA...Put together a breakout campaign in 2023 which he split between High-A Fort Wayne and San Antonio going a combined 6-4 with a 2.73 ERA...Made 9 appearances (8 starts) with the Missions last season and went 1-2 with a 2.86 ERA...Struck out 126 in 105.2 IP across the two levels and allowed just 4 HR...Spent his first full season in Fort Wayne in 2022 and struggled going 4-10 wiht a 5.84 ERA allowing 124 H (18 HR) with 129 K in 103.1 IP...Opponents batted .290 against him...Missed the entire 2021 college season at West Virginia following Tommy John Surgery...Padres still selected him in the 6th round and signed him for an above-slot \$500,000 (4th round money)...Scouts loved his high-spin 4 seam and two breaking pitches and felt he was primed for a breakout as a junior at WVU in 202...In COVID-shortened 2020 season went 2-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 4 starts, striking out 30 in 24.2 IP...24 years old

CARDINALS & MISSIONS CLASH FOR FIRST TIME IN 2024: The Cardinals this week at Hammons Field meet the San Antonio Missions (Double-A, San Diego Padres) for the first of two series between the two clubs this season. The two clubs meet again at Nelson Wolff Stadium in San Antonio the last week of the regular season (September 10-15). The Cards and Missions split 12 games last season.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals have ridden the roller coaster at Hammons Field this season, winning their first 8 home games of the season before dropping 22 of their next 28 to fall to a season-low 14-22 at Hammons Field on June 29. Since then, however, the Cardinals are 14-5 over their last 19 home games to climb over .500 at Hammons Field at 28-27.

The Birds have been quality team away from home all season long, boasting the best road record in the Texas League at 31-19 (.620). Springfield's home ERA sits at 5.27 while its road mark is 3.75.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After a 1-4 start to the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have bounced back and come into play Tuesday as one of the hottest teams in the Texas League. Over their last 31 games since June 30 the Cards are 21-10, the best record in the Texas League during that time. Springfield has only lost consecutive games once since the beginning of July (July 28 vs Corpus Christi 9-0 & July 30 at Tulsa 8-1).

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in power numbers this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles during that same stretch. The Cardinals have clubbed 32 homers over their last 31 games. Springfield is 2nd in the league with a .414 SLG and OPS of .761 during that time. During the same stretch the Cards have scored 172 runs (5.5/game), most in the league during that time.

In the 2nd half, the Cardinals have already hit 37 HR and is on pace for 71. Springfield hit just 37 homers in the first half of the season.

SHUT 'EM DOWN: The Cardinals pitching staff over its last six games has recorded 2 of its 7 shutouts in the 2024 season. The Birds have allowed just 28 hits over 53.0 IP (.153 BAA) during that stretch and have struck out 67. Springfield has a 2.38 ERA during that stretch.

THEY GET ON BASE: The top-hitting team in the Texas League all season long, it should serve as no surprise that the Cardinals also have the top OBP in the circuit. Sitting at .348, Springfield's on-base mark is 12 points higher than any other team in the league (Tulsa & Midland, .336).

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 27 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd among all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .340 average while adding 8 of his 9 HR this season and a league-high 26 RBIs. Crooks during that stretch is slugging a league-high .623 and has a 1.025 OPS. Among active qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks leads the league in batting average (.306) behind Bryan Torres, and OBP (.403) and OPS (.885) and is 3rd in SLG (.482). Crooks is currently riding a season-long 8 game hitting streak.

HOME RUN KING MAKING HIS MARK: After breaking the Springfield career home run mark with his 60th on July 12 vs Wichita, Chandler Redmond has kept on hitting since the beginning of July. Desdite going 0-for-4 on Thursday, the Cardinals' slugger is batting .348 over his last 21 games the last monthplus with 5 HR and 19 RBIs. His 1.070 OPS during that time leads the club.

The hot stretch is a welcome one for **Redmond**, who was batting just .186 at the end of June.

KING OF THE "K": With 20 strikeouts over his last two starts. Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews reclaimed the minor league lead in whiffs. With 151 K's, Mathews leads Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson of the Cleveland organization by one strikeout (150). Among qualified pitchers in the minor leagues, Mathews is 6th in K/9 at 12.70.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 19-for-19 and his 19 saves and 41 appearances lead all of Double-A. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 14.0 IP (0.56 ERA) and is 9-for-9 in save opportunities. Over his last 13 appearances, Svanson has been unscored upon, allowing just 8 H with 12 K over his last 15.0 IP.

The Cardinals are 43-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


