Lug•Notes

Movin' on Up: Earlier today, Lugnuts outfielder Henry Bolte was promoted to the Double-A Midland RockHounds. The 20-year-old Bolte departs the Midwest League as the league leader in runs (60), doubles (19), extra-base hits (36) and total bases (138); tied for first in triples (6); second in RBIs (52); third in OPS (.912); fourth in slugging percentage (.519); tied for fourth in stolen bases (28); tied for fifth in home runs (11) and base hits (74); and tied for sixth in walks (41). In his final game with the Lugnuts, Saturday, he went 2-for-5 with a first-inning RBI triple off of Minor League Baseball's No. 1 pitching prospect, Jackson Jobe. Bolte's place on the Lugnuts' roster was filled by returning infielder Sahid Valenzuela, transferred from Double-A Midland. Valenzuela has played for both the Nuts and the RockHounds in each of the last two seasons.

Less Than Jake: 2023 Oakland Athletics first-rounder Jacob Wilson, who starred for the Lugnuts at tail end of 2023, went 3-for-5 last night for Triple-A Las Vegas in an 11-8 victory over Sacramento. Wilson is now hitting .447 (21-for-47) in 11 games with the Aviators, with an overall slash line of .463/.497/.705 between three different levels this season.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in total bases (971), triples (32) and OPS (.742), and 2nd in batting average (.255), runs scored (386), base hits (627), doubles (127), RBIs (351) and slugging percentage (.395).

Speedball: On June 2, the Lugnuts beat Peoria in Game 1 of a twinbill in one hour and 23 minutes, 5-1, setting the franchise record for quickest seven-inning game. Then on June 27, the Nuts set a new team record for fastest nine-inning game, beating the Whitecaps in one hour and 44 minutes, 3-0.

Prospecting: Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 29).

History: Jake Garland (5 innings), Grant Judkins (2 2/3 innings) and Colton Johnson (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which Donnie Hood hit for the cycle.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: In a battle of aces, birthday boy Aaron Sanchez (5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 K) outpitched South Bend's Archie Bradley (3 IP, 2 H, 3 R, 5 BB, 6 K) in a 6-1 Lugnuts win at Coveleski Stadium. Sanchez improved to 7-0 with a 0.63 ERA.

2013: Chris Hawkins's two-out bases-loaded grounder up the middle in the bottom of the ninth seemingly lifted the Lugnuts to walk-off victory over the Great Lakes Loons. But Santiago Nessy, the Lugnuts' base runner at first, did not run to second base, turning around and celebrating with his teammates. The Loons executed the force play at second base, erasing the game-winning run, and then defeated the Lugnuts in ten innings, 5-4.

2017: Drama in South Bend! With two balls and two strikes on J.B. Woodman, the bases loaded, two outs, and the South Bend Cubs clinging to a 5-4 lead, Woodman injured an abdominal muscle hitting a foul ball against closer Wyatt Short and was forced to leave the game. He was replaced by pinch-hitter Bo Bichette who took Ball 3 high, fouled one off to the right, and then swung and missed a high fastball to end the game.

History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.


Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAAAII-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall, in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
