Home for a While

The Fightin Phils remain home for the penultimate series of the season's first half on Friday night against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the 11th-of-18 meetings between the teams this season and fifth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading trails the season-series 6-4 after dropping five-of-six at Portland from May 19-24 and going 3-1 so far this week. Following this week, Reading returns to Portland from Aug. 18-23 for the teams final matchup of the season.

Staying Hot

The Reading Fightin Phils fell to the Portland Sea Dogs, 13-12, in a wild 10-inning slugfest at FirstEnergy Stadium that featured 25 runs, 31 hits, seven home runs and multiple lead changes. After falling behind 2-0 early, Reading erupted for five runs in the third inning, highlighted by Raylin Heredia's three-run homer, and built an 8-3 lead in the fourth behind Pedro León's two-run home run and an RBI double from Caleb Ricketts. Portland chipped away throughout the night before taking an 11-9 lead in the eighth on a three-run homer from Miguel Bleis. The Sea Dogs added another run later in the inning to make it 12-9, but the Fightins delivered a dramatic response in the ninth when Erick Brito crushed a game-tying three-run home run with one out remaining, sending the game to extra innings. Portland regained the lead in the 10th on an RBI single from top prospect Franklin Arias, and Reading was unable to answer in the bottom half. Brito paced the Fightins with a 4-for-4 performance, three runs scored, a home run and three RBI, while Bleis starred for Portland with four hits, a homer and five RBI. Despite the loss, Reading's offense piled up 17 hits in one of the season's most entertaining games.

King Tucker

Braydon Tucker continued his excellent 2026 season on Wednesday night, allowing one run over six innings, along with six strikeouts in his sixth win of the season. This came on the heels of back-to-back seven-inning starts from the 26-year old. Through 10 starts this season, Tucker has a 1.26 ERA (8 ER, 57.0 IP). Tucker has tossed five innings or more in nine-of-10 outings and six-plus frames six times, all of which were quality starts (6.0 + IP & < 3 runs). Tucker has not allowed more than two-earned runs in a start this season and has allowed one-or-less in nine-of-10 appearances. Entering play on Saturday, Tucker leads the Eastern League in ERA (1.26), T-2nd wins (6), is 4th in BAA (.203), 6th IP (57.0) and third in WHIP (1.04). Tucker now leads all of Double-A in ERA and is second amongst full-season minor leaguers in ERA. He has even a lower ERA than MLB's leader, who is Brewers' starter Jacob Misiorowski at 1.34.

Binelas is Back

Alex Binelas has clubbed home runs on back-to-back nights, hitting his 11th and 12th long balls of the season, which included a 469 foot bomb on Wednesday night. Binelas' home runs in consecutive games come after not hitting one since May 6, snapping a streak of 28 games in a row without a home run. The teams home run leader clubbed nine during April and just one in May. Now, nearly two weeks into May, Binelas has two this month. His 12 home runs rank as tied for seventh in the Eastern League second in the Phillies organization, trailing Lehigh Valley's Felix Reyes, who has 14 with the IronPigs this season.

Welcome Back Caleb

Following his transfer from Lehigh Valley (AAA) on Tuesday, Caleb Ricketts reintroduced himself to the Fightin Phils in a big way in his first game back. The 26-year old blasted two home runs, which marked the fourth two-homer game of his career, and second this season (4/21: LHV vs DUR). Ricketts also drove in a career-high six runs, surpassing his previous high of four on June 8, 2025, when rehabbing with Clearwater (A) against Bradenton. His two home runs was the third multi-homer game by a R-Phil this season and his grand slam was the fifth hit by Reading in 2026. Then, he followed it up with four more RBI and another home run on Wednesday night. Through three games with Reading, Ricketts is 6-19 (.316), with three home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.158 OPS. On the other side of the ball, Ricketts ended Thursday night's win with a caught stealing at second base to end the top of the ninth inning.

Following the Trends

The status of the game in the sixth inning has been a large tell in the Fightin Phils success this season. When leading after six innings this season, Reading is 22-2; while they are 2-28 when trailing at the conclusion of the sixth inning. The trend continues in the seventh (23-1/1-29), as well as the eighth inning (22-0/0-28)

Check In on the Skipper

Fourth year Manager Al Pedrique picked up his 200th win with the Fightin Phils on Thursday night, which dates back to his first win with Reading on April 13, 2023, against the Hartford Yard Goats. Pedrique now ranks seventh all time in managerial wins with the R-Phils, as he passed both Shawn Williams (189) and P.J. Forbes (194) this season. Next up on the list is Gary Varsho who won 235 games across three seasons as Reading's manager.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 13, 2007: At Binghamton, Mike Costanzo's two home runs and three RBI spark the R-Phils to a 6-1 win over the Mets. Landon Jacobsen gives up five hits and one run over 7.0 innings for the victory.

Playing Portland

The Sea Dogs enter play this week, with a 30-30 record, which is fourth in the Eastern League's Northeast Division, but right in the thick of the playoff race with nine games left in the first half. Portland most recently hosted Hartford at home, taking three-of-six games, which included wins on Tuesday and Wednesday, then one on Sunday after dropping three-straight from Thursday-Saturday. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Somerset. The Sea Dogs' roster features 10 of Boston's top-30 prospects: Franklin Arias (1), Anthony Eyanson (2), John Holobetz (12), Hayden Mullins (14), Miguel Bleis (15), Jedixson Paez (19), Gage Ziehl (20), Nelly Taylor (21), Johanfran Garcia (26) and Yordanny Monegro (28).

Portland Pitcher

Righty, and Red Sox No. 20 prospect, Gage Ziehl makes his 10th start of the season tonight for Portland. So far, Ziehl is 2-2, with a 4.98 ERA (24 ER, 43.1 IP), along with 49 strikeouts. He earned the win on June 7 against Hartford, allowing one run on five hits over six innings, with eight strikeouts. Ziehl split 2025 between the White Sox and Yankees system. He was traded from Chicago (AL) to New York (AL) on July 30, 2025, for Austin Slater, then flipped to Boston on Feb. 1, 2026 from the Yankees. The 23-year old was drafted by the Yankees in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Miami.
