TODAY'S PITCHING MATCHUP: Winn vs Dominguez

Keaton Winn will look to continue his brilliance on the mound as he makes the Sunday afternoon start for the GreenJackets. In his last outing, Winn went 6.1 innings, the longes start for any GreenJackets pitcher this year. In his last three starts, he has gone at least six-innings in each, and has an ERA of 2.49 during that stretch. Winn was selected by the Last 5: 2-3 San Francisco Giants in 2017 in the 20th round. He decided to return to Iowa Western Community College for one more season, and he was drafted by the Giants again, this time in the 5th round.

TEEING OFF

Johan Dominguez will make the start for the Intimidators. The 2019 All-Star pitched on Tuesday in the All-Star Game for the North Division, and he went 0.2 innings without allowing a run. The 23-year old has thrown in 39-innings this year which is the 2nd most he has tossed in his career. In 2016, he pitched in 58.1 innings when he was part of the Milwaukee Brewers organization in the Dominican Summer League. He was traded to the White Sox in 2018 in a trade that sent left-handed pitcher Xavier Cedeno and outfielder Bryan Connell to the Brewers.

End of the 1st-half

It wasn't the end the Augusta GreenJackets were hoping for. After they controlled their own destiny going into their final two games of the 1st-half, the Rome Braves played spoi er and beat the GreenJackets the following day, while Charleston also lost. It left the door open for Lexington to control their own destiny. They did just that, and the GreenJackets ended up a 1/2 game shy of winning the title in the 1st-half of the season.

Valderrama begins his 2nd stint at the helm of the GreenJackets as he returns after spending last year as a Manager in the Arizona League. In 2017, Valderrama led the ship for Augusta as the GreenJackets played their final season at Lake Olmstead. The previous three seasons he managed in the Dominican Summer League. This year will mark his 12th season as a coach in the organization, as the former Giants outfielder served as a hitting coach for the summer team for six seasons prior to being Manager.

The Venezuelan native was originally signed by San Francisco as a non-drafted free agent in 1995, playing 11 seasons with the organization through 2005. He saw action in seven Major League contests in 2003, going 1-for-7. He finished his playing career in the Milwaukee Brewers farm system, playing at the double-A level in 2006. Valderrama resides in Bachaquero, Zulia, Venezuela. Fondest memory of his time in Major League Baseball was playing next to idol growing up Barry Bonds.

"I grew up being a Barry Bonds fan. I was in Oakland and I look to my right and there he was right next to me. That was the most exciting thing in my career, to play with a guy I followed."

Clay Rapada begins his 4th season as the GreenJackets Pitching Coach. Rapada spent parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues with the Chicago White Sox, Detroit Tigers, Texas Rangers, Baltimore Orioles, New York Yankees and the Cleveland Indians. 2019 will be his 4th season in the Giants organization. Under Rapada's tutelage in 2018, two pitchers, John Gavin and Joey Marciano, were chosen for the 2018 All-Star Game.

In Rapada's seven major league seasons, he went 8-0 with a 4.06 ERA over 93 innings-pitched. Rapada logged two innings of postseason experience. In 2010 he pitched 0.1 innings for the Texas Rangers in the playoffs without allowing a run. In 2012 he threw in both the ALDS and ALCS for the Yankees and did not allow a run in 1.2 innings-pitched. He finished his baseball career by competing in the 2016 World Baseball Classic for Team USA in Sydney, Australia. Overall in the minor leagues, Rapada went 34-27 with a 2.96 ERA in 497 games.
