MISCUES HURT SHRIMP IN 6-4 LOSS

A pair of errors led directly to three Bulls runs on Friday in the Jumbo Shrimp's 6-4 defeat to Durham. The Bulls jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the third on Curtis Mead's three-run home run. In the bottom of the third, though, Jacksonville tied the score on a Javier Sanoja RBI double, Durham error and Jonah Bride RBI single. A Jumbo Shrimp error and RBI ground out for Tristan Peters in the sixth put the Bulls ahead, and an error scored a run in the seventh to make it 6-3. Tristan Grav walked with the bases loaded in the eighth, but Jacksonville could not get any closer.

THE DARK SIDE OF THE MUÑOZ

Roddery Muñoz, who starts on Saturday against Durham, is coming off maybe the best start of his career. The righthander fired 8.0 shutout innings on Sunday at Gwinnett, becoming the first Jumbo Shrimp hurler to accomplish the feat since Bryan Hoeing did so on May 24, 2022 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Muñoz struggled in his first three outings with Jacksonville, going 0-3 with a 10.97 ERA (14 R, 13 ER) in 10.2 innings with seven strikeouts against 12 walks and 10 hits (.244 BAA). However, over his last four starts, the 24-year-old is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (6 R, 6 ER) in 24.0 IP with 18 strikeouts against six walks and 16 hits (.184 BAA).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 35 of Jacksonville's 55 games (63.6 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 17 of the club's last 24 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs: Jacksonville has lost 17 of its last 20 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 15-20 (.429) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 21 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 19-for-hislast-66, slashing .288/.400/.636/1.036 with five doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs, 13 walks and 13 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 12 of those 21 games, with multiple RBIs in four contests.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 47-for-160 (.294/.444/.563/1.007) with 11 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 40 walks and 25 runs scored in 46 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the International League in on-base percentage, fourth in OPS, tied for fourth in walks, eighth in slugging percentage, tied for 12th in extra-base hits (22), tied for 15th in home runs and 16th in batting average. Among the 125 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (5.0 percent) and 20th in line drive rate (28.9 percent).

THE GREAT AWAKENING?

The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out on May 22, marking their 17th loss in 20 games. During that 20-game stretch, Jacksonville ranked 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Over the last eight games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated 52 runs - tied for the fifth-most in Triple-A, and tied for first in the International League - on 80 hits (4th in AAA) with 44 walks (8th). As a team over these last eight games. Jacksonville is 80-for-277, ranking fourth in batting average (.289), third in OBP (.388), 11th in SLG (.440) and ninth in OPS (.828).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 20 of his last 22 games, notching 11 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 34for-89 (.382/.441/.551/.992) with eight doubles, two triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, 11 walks and 14 runs scored. Among the 200 IL hitters with at least 100 PA. Sanoia has posted the highest opposite-field rate (52.1 percent) and the fourthlowest swinging-strike rate (4.1 percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 8-19 record in May was the club's worst record in any month since at least 2005.

ABOUT RODDERY

-Originally signed by the Atlanta Braves on June 11, 2018 as a non-drafted free agent.

-On July 17, 2023, the Washington Nationals claimed Muñoz off waivers from Atlanta. The Pittsburgh Pirates then claimed Muñoz on waivers on December 1, 2023, and after designating him for assignment, they traded him to Miami on December 20, 2023 for cash considerations.

2024 SEASON

-Earned first career MLB win on May 1 in a start against the Colorado Rockies in which he ceded only one run on three hits in 6.0 innings. He struck out seven against two walks.

-Worked a career-high 8.0 innings on May 26 at Gwinnett, scattering three hits and two walks with three strikeouts.

2023 SEASON

-Between the Rookie-level FCL Braves, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett and Triple-A Indianapolis in 2023, posted a 4-6 record and 5.42 ERA in 34 games, including 14 starts (78.0 IP, 70 H, 53 BB, 81 K).

-Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts (35.0 IP, 35 H, 26 BB, 36 K, .259 BAA). As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (31.0 IP, 28 H, 20 BB, 32 K, .239 BAA).

-Muñoz posted extreme platoon splits in Triple-A. He held right-handed hitters to a .217/.329/.357/.686 line in 170 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .291/.418/.545/.963 against him in 134 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit just .213/.346/.354/.700 against Muñoz, but with runners on base, they batted .286/.391/.524/.915 against him.

2022 SEASON

-Split the 2022 season with High-A Rome and Mississippi, collecting an 8-4 record and 4.66 ERA in 22 games, all starts (100.1 IP, 97 H, 42 BB, 119 K).

-While pitching for Rome, left-handed batters posted a .795 OPS against him in 163 plate appearances, compared to a .641 mark for right-handed batters in 228 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty while pitching for Rome, Muñoz held opponents to a .224/.279/.361/.641 batting line. However, that swelled to .275/.370/.428/.798 line with runners on base.

2021 SEASON
