#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Columbus Clippers used three four-run innings and 22 hits to blitz the Indianapolis Indians 15-4 on Tuesday night in the series opener at Victory Field. The Clippers came out with four runs on five hits in the first inning to jumpstart the offensive outpouring. After Columbus doubled its lead to 8-0 in the third, Indianapolis chipped away in the home half thanks to a Jason Delay two-run bloop single into shallow right field that plated Brenden Dixon and Mike Jarvis. Sacrifice flies by Malcom Nuñez and Jarvis provided Indy with its final runs of the contest, but the Clippers scored seven unanswered down the stretch to hand the Indians their seventh consecutive loss. Columbus' 22-hit display marked the most by an Indy opponent since July 15, 2019, when the Indians yielded 22 knocks in a 20-1 loss to Syracuse.

TEAM STATS: As a team, the Indians lead the International League with a .270 batting average (496-for-1840). They also rank among top-10 team leaders in triples (2nd, 15), hits (5th), doubles (T-7th, 103), on-base percentage (T-9th, .353), slugging percentage (9th, .425) and OPS (10th, .776). The Indians pitching staff has logged the fourth-most strikeouts this season with 539, trailing Norfolk (599), lowa (585) and Columbus (555).

SPEEDY MIKE: Mike Jarvis went 2-for-3 last night with a run, RBI and his first Triple-A three-bagger. He singled in the bottom of the third to score the Indians second run of the contest, drove in one with a fourth-inning sacrifice fly and tripled in the bottom of the ninth inning for Indy's lone baserunner of the frame. It was his first triple since June 22, 2023 with High-A Greensboro vs. Winston-Salem. His two-hit performance was also his first multi-hit game of the season between Indianapolis and Double-A Altoona.

NO DELAYING DELAY: Jason Delay joined Mike Jarvis in logging a two-hit game for the Indians, roping a two-run single in the third inning to plate the Indians first runs of the contest and a double in the fifth inning. It was his first game after ending his rehab assignment and being officially optioned to Indianapolis. In five games with Indy this season, he has a .313 batting average (5-for-16) with three runs, two doubles and five RBI. He has appeared in 54 career games with Indianapolis since 2021, hitting .263 (42-for-160) with 23 runs, 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs and 22 RBI.

AT THE VIC: The Indians are now 1-7 on their 13-game homestand, with a 0-1 record against Columbus after losing their first of five home series at Victory Field last week vs. Omaha. The Indians won each of their first three homestands (4-2 vs. Memphis, 5-1 vs. St. Paul, 4-2 vs. Buffalo) before splitting last homestand with the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-3. Indianapolis' first series loss at home came on the heels of their first road trip with more than one win, splitting a six-game series at lowa from May 21-26.

SEVEN: The Indians have now lost seven consecutive home games for the first time since opening the 2024 season with seven-straight home losses from March 31-April 14 vs. Omaha and St. Paul. The seven-gamer is also their first seven-game overall losing streak since May 23-30, 2021 at St. Paul and Omaha. The Indians last eight-game losing streak came from June 29-July 5, 2010, with their longest losing streak in the Victory Field era coming in 13 games from July 10-24 (1), 2004. The Indians longest home losing streak is nine games from July 1-22, 2010 and May 5-22, 2002.

GORSKI'S GOOD: Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., carried a scorching-hot May into June on Sunday, launching his 10th home run in his past 19 games dating back to May 16. In that time, he leads all International League batters in home runs, RBI (27), slugging percentage (.853), extra-base hits (15), total bases (58). He hit nine homers in May, which were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.

TODAY: The Indians continue their 13-game homestand with the second game of a six-game set vs. the Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, today at 1:35 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians went 1-6 against the Omaha Storm Chasers to begin the homestand, and are looking to break a seven-game losing skid tonight against the worst record in the International League. Continuing the series today for Indianapolis is RHP Daulion Jefferies (0-1, 7.20), making his first career start against Columbus after making the majority of his Triple-A appearances in the Pacific Coast League. Countering for the Clippers is LHP Joey Cantillo (0-0, -.-), who made one start with the AZL Guardians on May 30 to begin his season (1.1ip, 3h, 5r, 5er, 2bb, 2k). In 2023, Cantillo logged a 1.04 ERA (1er/8.2ip) and 11 strikeouts in two appearances (one start) against Indy.

THEY SAY HELLO: Infielders Brenden Dixon and Jackson Glenn were promoted to Indianapolis from Double-A Altoona, and catcher Jason Delay and southpaw Jose Hernandez were optioned to the Indians yesterday as corresponding moves for Jack Suwinski, Henry Davis, Liover Peguero and Ben Heller going to the big leagues. THIS DATE IN 2015: Indians closer Blake Wood recorded his 15th save of the season in a 5-2 win over Lehigh Valley after converting seven save opportunities in the month of May, which is tied for the third-most by an Indians pitcher in a single season dating back to 2005. Wood converted 29 saves in 34 opportunities to lead the International League in that category for that season, it was the most saves by an Indians pitcher since Bob Scanlan recorded 35 in 2000
