RIDERS CANNOT OVERCOME MIDLAND'S BIG FIRST IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 11-6 on Thursday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (12-12) drew first blood on Thursday with three runs in the initial inning. **Evan Carter** had a big night, going 3-for-3 with a walk and a hit-by-pitch, and he started the scoring when he scored on a throwing error by Midland (13-11) catcher J.J. Schwarz. **Dustin Harris** then ripped an RBI single to center and he later scored on a double steal of home. The Riders stole six bases in the first inning, led by three from Harris and one from Carter, **Luisangel Acuña** and **Nick Tanielu**. In the bottom of the first, Midland struck back, chasing starter **Ryan Garcia** (0-2) from the game with five runs. They then added three more in the second with a Schwarz three-run shot to take an 8-3 advantage. Frisco added a run in the seventh on an Acuña RBI double and another in the ninth when **Thomas Saggese** ripped an RBI single to left, but it was not enough. Out of the Riders bullpen, **Hever Bueno** threw 2.1 scoreless innings. Midland's David Leal (2-1) took home the win out of their bullpen.

IN NEED OF MORE JUICE:

The RoughRiders have not lived on the long ball in 2023, only hitting one home run in their last three games and 21 all season in 24 games, which is ninth in the 10-team Texas League. In the first nine games of this 12-game road trip, Frisco has only managed eight home runs with a .435 slugging percentage, in part due to 20 doubles and five triples.

MAKE THOSE HITS COUNT:

The RoughRiders have shown up where it counts with runners in scoring position this season. In those situations, they are hitting .264/.366/.432/.798 while being second in the league in home runs (nine) and RBIs (112). This compares to a regular slashline of .252/.366/.406/.772. **Evan Carter** is seventh in all of MiLB (min. 25 PA) with a .478 average with runners in scoring position this season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .324 (35-for-108)/.373/.444/.817 through the first 24 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (35), tied for fourth in doubles (8) and sixth in total bases (48) and second in stolen bases (14). Over his last 20 games, he is batting .356/.410/.500/.910. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 32 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also second most in Double-A (Biloxi, 34). As a team, they are hitting .370 (10-for-27)/.364/.963/1.327 with four grand slams and 32 RBIs. They are one of two teams in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already (Triple-A Norfolk) as **Trevor Hauser** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have completed this season.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed 12 errors through 24 games. On Thursday in Midland, they had their first multi-error game of the year. The team's .986 fielding percentage is the third-best in Minor League Baseball. Their 12 errors are the second-fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 141 walks is third among non-Triple-A teams while their .363 team OBP is first in Double-A. **Evan Carter** has the Double-A lead with 24 walks and **Dustin Harris** is fourth with 22 (second in the Texas League) while Carter is first in OBP (.495) in the league and in Double-A.

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 19 of his 21 games this season, batting .333 (27-for-81)/.495/.506/1.001 with two doubles, four home runs, 24 walks, 20 RBIs and four stolen bases. Carter is first in the Texas League in OBP (.495), tied for seventh in RBIs (20), first in walks (23) and 14th in OPS (1.001). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter also opened the season as the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 19 times to seven strikeouts over 13 games with a .522 OBP.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
