NOTES

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs, 5-3, on Thursday at Mirabito Stadium. Rowdey Jordan had a three-hit game. Ryan Clifford and Drake Osborn both had multi-hit games. Mateo Gil hit an RBI double and extended his hit streak to six games. Joshua Cornielly struck out four batters over three scoreless innings in relief.

FUREVER YOUNG: Infielder **Wyatt Young** drew a walk on Thursday night against Portland. Young is now riding a 12-game on-base streak, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with an .851 OPS, one double, five runs batted in, and nine walks in that span. The 24-year-old tied his career high with three runs batted in on Wednesday against Portland. Young hit .429 (6-for-14) with three runs scored at in five games at Somerset last week. The 24-year-old currently ranks sixth in the Eastern League with a .375 on-base percentage.

CAUGHT IN THE ACT: Mets No. 25 prospect **Kevin Parada** has improved in throwing out attempted base stealers. Parada has caught 22 runners trying to steal and holds a 24% (22-of-93) caught stealing percentage in 59 games behind the dish this year. In 72 games at catcher across three levels last season, Parada held an 18% CS%. The 23-year-old has been elite over his last five games at catcher, as he's thrown out 40% (4-of-10) of attempted base stealers.

JORDAN'S BRAND: Infielder Rowdey Jordan went 3-for-4 with a run scored on Thursday night against Portland. Jordan is riding an eight-game on-base streak, hitting .375 (9-for-24) with a .964 OPS, three doubles, and three runs batted in. Jordan has three stolen bases in that span and has stolen a base in each of the last two games. Since beginning to bat only right-handed on July 23 at Richmond, Jordan has 16 hits and seven extra base hits (six doubles and one home run) across 19 games.

MATED MASH: Infielder **Mateo Gil** hit an RBI ground-rule double on Thursday night against Portland. Gil is now riding a six-game hit streak at the Double-A level, dating back to his first stint with the Rumble Ponies in May. Over his six-game hit streak, Gil is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one home run, one double, three runs batted in, and five runs scored. Since returning to Double-A from High-A Brooklyn, the 24-year-old is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with two runs batted in over four games.

STAN THE MAN: Outfielder **Stanley Consuegra** is riding a three-game hit streak and five-game on-base streak. Over his five-game on-base streak, Consuegra is hitting .278 with five hits, one run batted in, and two runs scored. In three games in this series, Consuegra is 4-for-12 (.333 AVG) at the plate with a run batted in and run scored.

JUST JOSHING: Right-handed reliever **Joshua Cornielly** struck out a Double-A career-high four batters over a Double-A career-high three scoreless innings, while allowing just one hit in relief on Thursday night. Cornielly has thrown six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts and just one hit and one walk over his first three Double-A appearances. The 23-year-old tossed the final three innings of High-A Brooklyn's combined no-hitter on June 4.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.


