Moosic, PA (April 13, 2023) - Scranton/Wilkes Barre beat the Syracuse Mets 10-6 on Friday night. Led by Ben Rortvedt's pinch hit double, the RailRiders put up a four-run ninth to break a tied game. The team also smashed three homers in the victory.

The RailRiders got on the board in the second with a solo shot off the bat of Jamie Westbrook.

Syracuse tied it up in the bottom half with a Jonathan Arauz homer.

In the next frame, Estevan Florial created a run on the base paths. He walked to reach, stole two bags, and raced home on a throwing error. SWB led 2-1.

Again the Mets tied it up in the bottom half. Luke Ritter led off with a double and back-to-back walks loaded the bases. Ronny Mauricio grounded into a double play, but it did push a run across for a 2-2 game. Two runs in the fifth put Syracuse on top for the first time in the contest. Arauz walked and a triple off the bat of Carlos Cortes sent him home. Ritter followed with an RBI single for a 4-2 advantage.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre chipped away thanks to Michael Hermosillo's 10th home run of the season. In the eighth, the RailRiders put two up for a 5-4 lead. Westbrook led off with a single and Carlos Narvaez smoked a homer to left field for the team's third of the contest.

Syracuse once again tied it in the next half inning. Luke Voit reached on an error and DJ Stewart sent a no-doubter to deep right center for a six-six ballgame.

The RailRiders took control in the top of the ninth. Narvaez reached on an error and moved into scoring position on a wild pitch. Andres Chaparro singled to put runners on the corners. Ben Rortvedt smoked an RBI double in a pinch hit opportunity off the bench. Westbrook followed with a run scoring base hit of his own. Hermosillo poked a sacrifice fly into center and Rortvedt raced home. Westbrook took second and then stole third. He jogged home on a Jesus Bastidas knock to complete a four-run frame. SWB led 10-4.

Clayton Beeter pitched five and two thirds innings allowing four runs. He let up five hits and four walks. Michael Gomez finished the sixth clean and threw a 1-2-3 seventh. Greg Weissert (W, 2-2) gave up two runs, one earned, with a pair of strikeouts. Josh Maciejewski slammed the door shut in the ninth.

#### news & notes

**BULLPEN BEST** – The RailRiders bullpen has impressed this season with a 3.84 earned run average in 311.1 innings pitched. The staff has totaled 365 strikeouts to just 174 walks. The 'pen was second in the International League with 19 saves led by Greg Weissert's six. Matt Krook impressed out of the pen with a 1.23 ERA in 21.0 innings pitched while Colten Brewer recorded a 1.37 ERA in 19.2 innings.

**WESTBROOK IS WORKING** - In his birthday month, Jamie Westbrook has shined up at the plate. He is batting .393 in 18 games played with 24 total hits. In this time he had a team-high 15-game hitting streak. Westbrook has had five homers and 15 runs batted in in the month. He has walked, 8, more than he has struck out, 6.

MATT ATTACK- Matt Krook has been called upon by New York as their 27th man for their split doubleheader today. Krook has made just one big league appearance. In 16 outings he has lowered his ERA down to 1.23 with just three earned runs allowed. The southpaw has just 16 walks to 39 strikeouts. In 2022, Krook nailed a franchise record of 155 strikeouts for a season-high along with 10 wins as a part of the starting rotation.

**FIELDING FAUX PAS** - The RailRiders have committed a total of 72 errors on the season with one last night. This puts them second in the International League with a team at 75. Andres Chaparro has the most with 11. Syracuse has made 55 miscues. Visalia leads all of Minor League Baseball with 107 errors.

**HOMER HEAVEN** The RailRiders were the first International League team to hit 100 home runs and they now have 129. This puts them first in all of Minor League Baseball to the Las Vegas Aviators who have hit 128. Syracuse has 110 as a team. The New York Yankees have totaled 116. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. SWB homered 20 times against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty.

**LEADING THE CHARGE** - The RailRiders have had seven different first basemen this season. Andres Chaparro leads the way with 27 starts, while Billy McKinney has made 23 starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez each made their first professional start at the corner this season and now have each defended there a couple of times. Franchy Cordero also played a handful of frames at first.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect outfielder Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched a Sunday Day game, Took game one of the doubleheader

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- · Worked solely as a reliver in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- · Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.

- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- · Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.
