SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a season-long five-game losing streak with a 7-3 win over the SeaWolves. After Erie took a 1-0 lead in the first, **Andy Thomas** tied the game with an RBI single in the third. In the fourth, **Carter Williams** gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with an RBI single, **Simon Whiteman** brought in a run with a sac bunt to extend the lead to 3-1. **Luis Matos** and Marco Luciano added back-to-back homers later in the inning to open a 6-1 lead. Erie closed back within four in the fifth with an RBI single by Dillon Dingler, but Matos pushed Richmond's lead to 7-2 with an RBI single in the sixth. In the ninth, the SeaWolves scored a run to close within four and loaded the bases to bring the potential tying run to the batters box but were held off. Working in relief for the first time this season, **Nick Zwack** allowed one run over four innings. **Parker Dunshee** made his Giants organization debut and pitched two scoreless innings.

IIBBERDUCHS

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first set between these two teams this year. They will play 18 total games against each other this season. Richmond will travel to Akron for a six-game series from July 18-23. The RubberDucks return to The Diamond for the Flying Squirrels' final regular-season homestand from September 5-10.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** ended a five-game losing streak and reclaimed first place in the Southwest Division with Sunday's win in Erie. Richmond has been in first place in the division all but two days this season. The Flying Squirrels have dropped six-of-their-last-eight games dating back to the last homestand against Altoona. The Richmond pitching staff is second in the EL in ERA (3.35).

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won five-of-their-last-seven games, including taking four-of-six in last week's series in Atloona. Akron's pitching staff is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.54) and tied for first in saves (12). The RubberDucks have the second-lowest team batting average (.213) in the EL. Akron's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 8), INF Jose Tena (No. 14), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 18), INF Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 21), OF Petey Halpin (No. 25), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 27), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 29) and C Bryan Lavastida (No. 30). There are seven Akron players on MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects list, including Martinez (No. 9), Halpin (No. 15), Cantillo (No. 17), Burns (No. 20), Tena (No. 21), Nikhazy (No. 28) and Leftwich (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Mason Black makes seventh Double-A start. He last pitched on Wednesday at Erie and threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit with six strikeouts. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more on Black, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tanner Burns makes his sixth start of the season. He last pitched on Wednesday at Altoona and surrendered two runs over five innings to pick up his first win of the year. He has allowed two-or-less runs over each of his last four starts. The Alabama native was selected with the 36th pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Auburn. Burns spent the entire 2022 season with Akron, going 3-7 with a 3.55 ERA in 21 starts. He made three starts against the Flying Squirrels last year, going 1-1 with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1P). He last faced the Flying Squirrels on August 24 at Canal Park and threw 5.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Burns is rated by MLB.com as the No. 20 Guardians prospect and No. 29 by Baseball America.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop Marco Luciano was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. Last Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Luciano added a homer in Sunday's win over the SeaWolves. He has reached base in seven-of-his-nine games started this season.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .352 (19-for-54) with a homer, eight doubles and five RBIs over his last 14 games, including seven two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is fifth in the league in hits (34), tied for fourth in doubles (8) and seventh in runs scored (20).

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the third-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in 11-of-his-13 games since then and in 29-of-31 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 12 times in 132 plate appearances (9.0 percent), the second-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his third Double-A homer in Sunday's win over the SeaWolves, going 4-for-4 with a homer, a double, a walk and three RBIs. For the season, Matos is ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.304), fourth in hits (35) and ninth in total bases (51). He is also ranked sixth in the league in wRC (24), first in BB/K (1.42) and has the lowest swing-and-miss percentage (6.0%).

BURGOS THE KING: Reliever Raymond Burgos has pitched 10 games without allowing an earned run this season, the longest active streak in the Eastern League and tied with Harrisburg's Amos Willingham for the longest in the league overall this year. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was a extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (94.1%). He is the only pitcher in the EL (min. 15.0 IP) with a 0.00 ERA

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked fifth in batting average (.304), fourth in hits (35) and ninth in total bases (51). Hayden Cantrelle is ranked fifth in OBP (.419). Ismael Munguia is ranked fifth in hits (34), tied for fourth in doubles (8) and seventh in runs scored (20). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3).

WHERE THE RUBBERDUCKS RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Aaron Bracho is tied for sixth in homers (6). Julian Escobedo is tied for fourth in doubles (8). Bradley Hanner is tied for second in wins (4) and tied for first in games pitched (12). Trey Benton is tied for first in games pitched (12). Cade Smith is tied for first in games pitched (12) and first in saves (10).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America e organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for aveage and the best athlete. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
