### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**STOP THE SLIDE:** The Marauders have gone three consecutive series without a series win, their longest such stretch of the season; the club split with Daytona July 13-18, lost to St. Lucie 4-games-to-2 July 20-25, and split last week's series with Dunedin. Since July 16 (16 games), the Marauders have gone 5-11.

**HOMER-HAPPY:** The Marauders hit a franchise-record seven home runs on Saturday against Dunedin—**Jase Bowen** and **Jack Herman** hit two each, while **Maikol Escotto**, **Endy Rodriguez**, and **Dariel Lopez** each hit solo homers. It shattered the previous franchise mark of four homers in a game, last accomplished on June 23 vs Jupiter. Bradenton is now second in the league with 76 home runs as a team.

**WELCOME ABOARD:** Newly-acquired catcher **Abrahan Gutierrez** went 2-for-4 in his Pirates organization debut Sunday vs Dunedin as a DH, doubling in his first at-bat and singling in his second trip. The 21-year-old catcher from Caracas, Venezuela was acquired from the Phillies on July 30 in exchange for 2019 Marauder, LHP Braeden Ogle. Gutierrez is facing his now-former teammates for the first time this week.

**E-MAN, MASTER OF THE BATTER'S BOX:** **Endy Rodriguez** went 0-for-4 last Thursday, ending both an 11-game hit streak and a 23-game on base streak. Both were season-highs for the Dominican Republic native, and his 11-game hit streak is the longest by a Marauder this season. During the on-base streak, Rodriguez batted .322 with a .402 OBP. He currently leads the team with 71 hits (T-3rd in the league), 39 RBI (T-9th), 15 doubles (T-7th), and four triples (T-2nd), and is pacing all Marauders hitters with 19 multi-hit games and 12 multi-RBI games.

**THE OPPONENT:** Leading into Thursday's game, the Threshers weathered a six-day period without games to allow for testing and contact tracing after a Covid outbreak in the Phillies complex. They took two of three games from Fort Myers before the remainder of the series was cancelled in light of the outbreak. This week's series is the Marauders' first of two visits to BayCare Ballpark against the Threshers; Bradenton will return September 7-12, its second-to-last series of the season.

**TOP PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#13), **Jared Jones** (#17), **Sammy Siani** (#19), **Nick Garcia** (#21), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Dariel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

**UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:** New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +48 (Tampa's +223 leads all of MiLB)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top seven in home runs: **Jase Bowen** is T-3rd with 11 HR; **Hudson Head** is T-4th with 10 HR; **Endy Rodriguez** and **Sammy Siani** are T-6th with 8 HR, and **Alexander Mojica** is T-7th with 7 HR.
