- Has not allowed more than three earned runs in any outing this year, with no more than two total runs in any of his first nine starts to open the season
- The Cardinals #20 prospect by MLB.com, he ranks among Double-A Central leaders in ERA (4<sup>th</sup>, 3.26), starts (t-1<sup>st</sup>, 15) and innings pitched (t-5<sup>th</sup>, 69.0)
- Carried a no-hitter into the 5th inning on 5/16 at Arkansas, ultimately allowing one hit and one walk over 5.0+ shutout innings, striking out four
- Has struck out a season-high seven batters twice this year – 5/5 vs. WCH (3.0 IP, 2 R) and 6/18 vs. WCH (6.0 IP, 1 R)
- Was 1-0 with a 2.78 ERA in nine starts (11 G) in his first full professional season in 2019, tossing 35.2 innings for Low-A State College, striking out 38 while walking 11 and giving up two home runs
- In 2019, named a New York-Penn League All-Star, ranking ninth among Cardinals Minor League pitchers in WHIP (1.07)
- Selected by St. Louis in the 4th round in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft after three seasons at UC Irvine, where he was a two-time all-Big West honoree and finished his career 26-9 with a 2.53 ERA in 33 starts (55 G), striking out 260 in 243.0 innings.
- Was 10-1 with a 1.60 ERA during sophomore season, posting the second-lowest ERA in school history and sixth that season (2018) in NCAA D1
- Traveled with the U.S. Collegiate National Baseball Team after sophomore season
- High school teammate of Atlanta Braves first round pick (2015) Kolby Allard at San Clemente High School (San Clemente, CA)
- Other notable San Clemente HS alumni include Carolina Panthers QB Sam Darnold, *Lost* actor Jorge Garcia, *Star Wars: The Last Jedi* director Rian Johnson, and former Kansas City Chiefs quarterback Bill Kenney

### Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last Games...** The Travelers claimed the opener of the six-game series with a 4-0 win on Tuesday night. The combination of RHP Alejandro Requena (6.0 IP), RHP Ray Kerr (1.0 IP), RHP Nick Duron (1.0 IP), RHP Dayeison Arias (0.2 IP) and RHP Michael Stryfeller (0.1 IP) combined to toss the shutout and outduel Cardinals LHP Tyler Pike, who allowed just one run through his 6.0 innings, striking out five and not allowing a single walk. The Travs plated their lone run against Pike in the 2<sup>nd</sup> on a run-scoring groundout from DH Carter Bins, before adding three insurance runs against the bullpen in the 7<sup>th</sup>, accounting for the eventual final score of 4-0.
- **23 straight for Plummer...** OF Nick Plummer worked a walk and added a double in his first two at-bats on Tuesday, extending his current 23-game on-base streak that dates all the way back to 6/29. During his streak, Plummer is batting .337 (29x86) with six home runs, 18 RBIs, 13 walks and 18 runs, hitting safely in 19 of the 23 games. This torrid stretch has propelled the 24 year old up the league's offensive leader boards, with Plummer currently ranking among the circuit's best in batting average (5<sup>th</sup>, .303), on-base percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .413), slugging percentage (8<sup>th</sup>, .502), OPS (6<sup>th</sup>, .915), hits (9<sup>th</sup>, 69) and total bases (9<sup>th</sup>, 116). The Cardinals all-time record for on-base streaks is INF Tommy Edman's 32-game on-base streak from 5/23-6/29/18.
- **Power away from Hammons...** Despite Hammons Field traditionally being a home run haven, 1B Luken Baker has had more home run success on the road this season with 11 long-balls in 34 road games vs. 4 home runs in 36 home games. The 2<sup>nd</sup> rounder in 2018 out of Texas Christian powered four home runs in the return to his home state on the 12-game trip to Frisco and San Antonio the last two weeks, increasing his team-leading total of round-trippers to 15, which is tied for 3<sup>rd</sup>-most in the league. Baker only trails Northwest Arkansas C MJ Melendez (24) and former Nationals SS Bobby Witt, Jr. (16) among the top homer totals in the Double-A Central.
- **Julio returns...** C Julio Rodriguez has been activated from the Injured List after being out of commission since 5/11. The 24 year old from Santiago de los Caballeros, Dominican Republic is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Cardinals #12 prospect, joining C Ivan Herrera (#3 STL/#80 MiLB) to form one of the highest-ranked catching prospect tandems in Minor League Baseball. Rodriguez debuted with Springfield in 2019 and opened this season with the Cardinals, playing just three games before hitting the IL. C Aaron Antonini was transferred to High-A Peoria in conjunction with Rodriguez's return.

Named STL MiLB Player of Month for May - .317 (26x82), 7 HR, 19 RBI, 3 2B, 13 R in 21G between SPR and High-A Peoria... Currently ranked as #15 STL prospect by MLB.com... Played outfield and pitched at East Carolina University, batting .341 with 12 HR and 91 RBI over 116 games and going 13-5 with a 3.47 ERA in 137.2 IP (139 K), adding nine saves... played for 2019 Collegiate National Team... received 2019 USA Baseball International Performance-of-the-Year award for walk-off home run against Japan... three-time North Carolina 2A All-State Team (2015-17) in high school... struck out only eight times over final three years of HS baseball.
