"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS EVEN SERIES IN CAPITAL CITY: Eight of nine Saints collected a base hit, seven scored a run, and six of the St. Paul nine drove in a run as the Saints outthit the I-Cubs to even up the series at two games apiece with an 11-8 victory on Friday night at Principal Park. Hitting second in the lineup, Jeferson Morales teed off for his second home run of the season, also his second in three days in Iowa, to lift the Saints in front 1-0 in the Top 1st. Iowa quickly responded with a pair in the bottom of the inning before the Saints dug themselves into a 5-1 hole after three. St. Paul would respond with a five-run top of the fourth, led off by four straight hits from Yunior Severino, Mike Ford, Carson McCusker, and Armando Alvarez, the latter two which drove in runs. The Saints would tack on three more in the fifth on McCusker's fifth of the season, a three-run blast, and never trail the rest of the way. The 5-1 deficit the Saints overcame was their biggest comeback victory of the season so far.

MCCUSKER MASHING: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 4th in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). The 6-8 slugger has hit five home runs in the past eight games which is [the most HR in the minor leagues since April 9](#) and now ranks t-2nd in the International League in HR this season. His two-run double on Tuesday in Iowa registered at 111.8 mph off the bat, the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Saint this year. McCusker now has four of the top-6 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. While his top-end exit velos are impressive, he's also consistently hit the ball hard, and [ranks 2nd the International League with a 64.5% hard-hit rate](#), meaning nearly 70% of his batted balls are put in play at 95 mph or harder.

THEY DON'T CALL IT A "CHALLENGE" FOR NOTHING: After Armando Alvarez failed to overturn a call at the plate yesterday, the Saints have now been incorrect on their last 14 consecutive ABS challenges (Armando Alvarez had the last successful challenge on 4/6 @COL).

BACK, TRACK, WALL...YOU KNOW THE REST: The 11 home runs allowed by the Saints the past three games in Iowa is tied for the most homers the St. Paul pitching staff has allowed in [a three-game span in franchise history](#), matching a stretch from June 22-25, 2024 when the Saints allowed 1 HR and then 7 HR in their final two games in Toledo and then 3 more to begin their next series at home vs Iowa. The Saints had entered Wednesday giving up just three homers (the fewest allowed in Triple-A at the time) in 110.0 innings through 13 games of the season, an average of 0.25 HR/9. The 11 longballs they've ceded in the last three games translates to an average of 4.0 HR/9, buoyed by the 8 allowed in Wednesday's game two, including 5 round-trippers hit in a nine-run seventh inning (both the runs and homers allowed were the most allowed in a single-inning in Saints history). The Saints now rank 21st out of 30 Triple-A teams in total homers allowed, but the 3 HRA by the starting staff is tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A.

FORGET ABOUT THE CURVEBALL, RICKY...GIVE 'EM THE HEATER!: The Saints have crushed fastballs to begin the season and rank [6th in the International League](#) as a team by weighted on-base average (wOBA) with a .371 mark. The Saints are hitting .288 (83-288, 4th in IL) while slugging .431 (11th in IL) with a 22.6% whiff-rate (4th-lowest) on the hard-stuff. Eight of the 14 St. Paul home runs have come vs fastballs so far this season. Some of the Saints' best hitters against fastballs early are listed below:

WALKIN' DOWN THE LINE: St. Paul's 87 walks drawn as an offense currently ranks 3rd in the International League entering Thursday and the Saints' .364 team on-base percentage is third. The Saints have drawn at least two walks [in each game this season](#) and have taken four or more bases on balls in 12-of-16 contests so far this year.

START ME UP: The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a solid start to the year, spinning a 3.66 ERA among starters that ranks 7th in the International League. If you throw out Andrew Morris' outing on Wednesday (7 ER, 3.2 IP), the Saints starting staff have a 2.83 ERA (19 ER, 60.1 IP). The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so.

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints Opening Day roster features nine of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to Baseball America while also touting five of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No 2. MLB.com, No. 2 BA), INF Luke Keaschall (3/3), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Both Rodriguez (19/37) and Keaschall (45/60) rank among the top-100 overall lists of both publications.

- KING PABLO:** Last pitched on April 2 at Rate Field vs. the White Sox...earned his first win of the season, and his first win since September 10, 2024, in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 ER, 1 HR) in 7.0 quality innings...secured his first career win against the White Sox and the Twins' second win of the season.
- With his 7.0 innings pitched, López surpassed 900 career innings...he is the 53rd among active starting pitchers in MLB to accomplish this.
- His lone run allowed was a home run from Brooks Baldwin during the seventh inning.
- This marked the first time he has allowed one run or less since his scoreless three game streak from August 18-30, 2024.
- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since being traded to the Twins, López has gone 13-8 with a 3.86 ERA (191.1 IP, 82 ER), 10.21 K/9, 1.93 BB/9 and 0.99 HR/9 in 32 starts at home, compared to 16-11 with a 3.60 ERA (212.2 IP, 85 ER), 9.86 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.31 HR/9 in 36 road starts.
- In 2024, allowed a .265 (90-for-340) batting average and .711 OPS at home, compared to a .240 (90-for-375) AVG and .700 OPS away.
- In his last seven road starts, López has gone 2-3, a 4.28 ERA (40.0 IP, 19 ER), with nine walks and 29 strikeouts...allowed 21 runs on 49 hits (5 HR).
- In two starts at Kauffman, Pablo has posted a 0.73 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), with three walks and 15 strikeouts...also has a .146 (6-for-41) opponent batting average.
- LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through two starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .360/.360/.600 in 25 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .136/.174/.136 in 22 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 93.0 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 54.5 compared to righties' 84.4 mph and 17.6 percent.
- Has a whiff rate of 18.8 percent vs. lefties and 22.4 percent vs. righties.
- THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer nearly 45% of the time, the most he's used the pitch in his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- In 2024, he ranked in the 95th percentile for extension, 92nd percentile for fastball run value, 90th percentile for BB % and 89th percentile for chase %.
- Currently ranks 95th percentile for breaing run value and 90th percentile for fastball run value...ranks in the 89th percentile for BB % and 87th percentile for extension.
- In his last start on April 2 against Chicago-AL, he racked up nine swing and misses...had a high velocity of 97.3...of his four hits allowed, two were 4-seamers, one was a fastball, and one was a changeup.
- Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE:** This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
- Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.

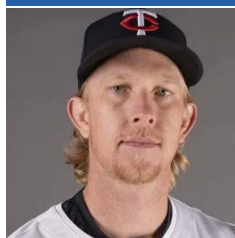

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his Saints debut on Sunday against Omaha after pitching in three games out of the Minnesota bullpen to open the season before being DFA'd, electing free agency, and re-signing with the Twins. Wriggled out of a bases-loaded jam in the first inning and worked around traffic in three of four innings. Struck out three of the last five batters he faced to end his outing. Generated just six swings-and-misses, retired three via fly outs and two via groundouts.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp and the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints will mark the 10th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings; he worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineout in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT!: Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former "Dirtbags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.
