SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (16-7, 59-33) vs. TULSA DRILLERS (11-12, 37-55) LHP PETE HANSEN (6-3, 4.07 ERA) vs. LHP JACKSON FERRIS (6-5, 4.74 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: Springfield visits Tulsa (LAD) for the 3rd game of a 6-game series ... is the 15th of 18 in the season series ... are 12-2 vs. the Drillers this season ... is the 2nd the of 2 trips to Oklahoma this season ... went 5-1 in a 6-game series at ONEOK Field from May 20-25.

TEXAS PETE: LHP Pete Hansen makes his 18th start and his 4th vs. TUL ... SGF is 13-4 in his starts ... leads the club with 6 QS ... allowed 2 runs over 5.2 IP in last outing, a no-decision, on 7/18 vs. WCH ... has completed 5.0 IP in 10 of last 11 starts ... former Texas Longhorn is 2-0 with a 1.59 (3ER/17.0IP) ERA in 3 starts vs. TUL.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield blanked Tulsa, 4-0, to even the series ... OF Darlin Moquete put the Cards on the board with a 2-run HR in the 3rd and OF Joshua Baez added a solo HR later in the 6th ... bullpen combined for 4.2-shutout IP with RHP Austin Love picking up the win and RHP Osvaldo Berrios recording a 5-out save.

TALKING UP ARMS: Wednesday's shut out was the 6th of the season for SGF's staff and the 2nd vs. TUL ... lowered July ERA to a TXL-best 2.31.

WIN QUEST: RHP Cade Winquest shutout TUL for 4.1 IP in his Double-A debut Wednesday ... gave up 2 hits and struck out 4 with 2 walks ... threw 72 pitches ... promoted from Peoria (A+) on 7/14 where he was 2-6 with a 4.52 ERA in 17G/15GS.

DUB STEPS: SGF holds the TXL's best overall record (59-33) and best 2nd-half record (16-7) ... are tied at a season-high 26 games above .500.

FEEL THE BERN: C Leonardo Bernal extended his hit streak to 10 games after finishing 1x4 on Wednesday ... has matched his personal-best season streak ... is batting .293 (12x41) ... picked up his team-leading 50th RBI (t-3rd TXL).

SERIES BUSINESS: Springfield has won 7 of its last 8 series beginning with its early June 6-game set at Frisco ... is 10-8 in series openers, 13-4 in series finales, and 2-0 in rubber games ... has swept 3 series (including 2 6-gamers).

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson ranks 3rd in the TXL with a 2.43 ERA after allowing 2 runs over 5.1 IP in his last start Sunday ... also ranks top 5 with a 1.18 WHIP (4th), 90 strikeouts (3rd), and a .214 opponent average (3rd).

BULL-DOZA: IF Ramon Mendoza tied C Leonardo Bernal for the team with 11 HR on Sunday ... his previous career-best HR total was 6 in 2023 with Peoria (A+) ... hit 3 HR all of last season over 212 AB at 2 different levels.

ALL THAT RAQUET: LHP Nick Raquet earned his 8th win in relief Friday and is 2nd in the TXL in wins ... has an 0.80 in 24 appearances and has not allowed an ER in last 15 appearances (since 5/25 at TUL) ... has a 1.01 WHIP and .222 OBA.
