### JACKSONVILLE DROPS SECOND GAME IN CHARLOTTE

Home runs from **Santiago Chavez** and **C.J. Hinojosa** on Saturday were not enough as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 6-3 to the Charlotte Knights from Truist Field. The Knights (7-7) grabbed the lead immediately in their first at-bats against Jumbo Shrimp (7-6) starter **Jeff Lindgren** (1-1). After jumping out ahead 3-0, early on, Charlotte starter **Jesse Scholtens** (1-0) struck out five of the first six batters he faced but served up a home run to Chavez in the third to get Jacksonville on the board. Hinojosa went yard to lead off the fourth to cut the deficit to 3-2. Charlotte played three more runs before Jacksonville added their last run in the seventh but couldn't muster any more offense.

### FIRST THINGS FIRST

Jacksonville's streak of 10 leadoff men reaching base to start off the game ended Thursday night. Of those 10 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Seven of those 10 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; Brian Miller reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers, Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against Durham and Edwards drew a free pass to start Thursday's affair at Charlotte.

### LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on Friday, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. In their last 13 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats nine times. Jacksonville has scored first in seven of its 13 games thus far in 2023, going 6-1 when doing so. The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times in 2022 (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through nine games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 15-for-39, slashing a robust .385/.419/.718/1.137 with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 RBIs and six runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 13th in the International League in RBIs, fifth in batting average, eighth in slugging, 13th in OPS and tied for 14th in total bases.

### CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 31-25 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (12-9). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rd-lowest) among 2022 division opponents.

### THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only six teams in the IL (Iowa, Columbus, Omaha, Toledo, Syracuse and Norfolk) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first 13 games. Despite the club's 79 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp are ranked ninth in average (.253), 13th in on-base percentage (.336), 13th in slugging percentage (.415) and 12th in OPS (.751). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line is .242/.333/.409/.742, figures that rank ninth, 10th, ninth and ninth, respectively.

### THE DIVINE RIGHT TO RULE

Through the club's first nine games of the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff struggled, ranking last in the IL with a 6.66 ERA. Since their off day on April 10, the Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have turned a corner and have ruled the Queen City since their opening contest on Tuesday. So far in the first five games against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have the second-best ERA in the IL (3.05) and have allowed 15 earned runs, the fewest during this span. In 17.1 innings, Jacksonville's firemen have yielded four runs (three earned) for a 1.56 ERA. They've also allowed 12 hits with five walks and 17 strikeouts.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in eight of Jacksonville's first 13 games so far this season, going 11-for-46 (.241/.317/.296/.613) at the plate with two doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored...Groshans' on-base streak ended at 11 straight on 4/14... Peyton Burdick has two multi-homer games this season...His 116 MPH home run on 4/12 was the second hardest hit ball in MiLB this season...The Jumbo Shrimp played 39 one-run games in 2022, finishing 20-19. Through the club's first 12 games, Jacksonville is 3-1 in one-run games to start 2023.

### ABOUT LUIS

-Palacios was signed as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2016 by the Miami Marlins when he was 16 years old.

-He was first introduced to the states in 2019 to pitch for the GCL Marlins.

-In 2018, Palacios led the DSL with a 0.597 WHIP in 63.2 innings. He struck out 62 and walked four. They slashed just .155/.173/.183 off him.

### 2022 SEASON

-Palacios posted a 2.65 ERA in April in 17.0 innings. He struggled in the month of May (8.23 ERA in 31.0 innings), but pitched better in June (4.13 ERA in 24.0 innings).

Palacios earned a promotion from Low-A Jupiter to High-A Beloit on July 22. He was promoted again, this time to Double-A Pensacola, on September 9.

### 2021 SEASON

-Palacios pitched better at home with Low-A Jupiter in 2021. In six starts at home, he went 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA. However, in six road starts, he posted a 1-4 record and 5.10 ERA in 30.0 frames.

-Palacios held right-handed hitters to a .166 average and .549 OPS in 206 plate appearances. Left-handed batters batted .315 with a .969 OPS in 56 plate appearances.

-Opponents batted .167/.208/.313/.521 in 52 plate appearances with runners in scoring position.

### 2019 SEASON

-Palacios split the season as a starter and reliever. In four starts, he collected a 1.69 ERA (16.0 IP, 13 H, 2 BB, 17 K). In six relief appearances, he had a 0.74 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 H, 0 BB, 25 K).

### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Palacios hails from Cagua in Venezuela. Cagua was established in 1620 as "Cagua La Vieja", a town of original Spaniards. Cagua was rebuilt in its current location in 1622 with the new name of "Nuestra Señora del Rosario de Cagua," which was changed to "San José de Cagua" during the 18th century. The city is now known simply as Cagua. The origin of the name comes from the indigenous Cumanagoto word "Cahigua," which means snail.
