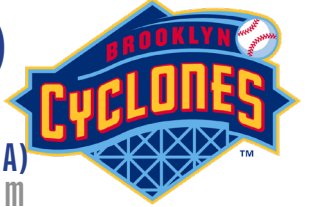

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its second-straight contest to Aberdeen, 7-1, in 10 innings on Thursday afternoon at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones yielded a season-high-tying six runs in the top of the 10th inning...RHP **Jonah Tong** struck out seven batters in his High-A and Brooklyn debut, permitting just one unearned run over five innings...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** followed his performance with four frames of shutout relief, collecting four whiffs...RHP **Moisés Chace** hurled four scoreless in the start for Aberdeen, while RHP **Juan Núñez** punched out eight in 4.2 innings of relief.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut on Thursday...In five appearances (three starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 23.2 IP)...No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run...Entering play on Friday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (48.9%)...Single-A Lynchburg's LHP **Matt Wilkinson** (50.5%) is first...Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (40.7%)...Tong's 43 strikeouts are good for third-most in the minors.

ALL ABOARD THE 7 TRAIN: It was announced on Thursday that RHP **Christian Scott** is expected to make his Major League debut for the New York Mets on Saturday night at Tropicana Field against the Tampa Bay Rays...The 24-year-old will become the 99th former Brooklyn Cyclone to appear in the big leagues and the first to debut in 2024...Through five starts this year at Triple-A Syracuse, the Mets' top pitching prospect held a 3-0 record with a 3.20 ERA (9 ER in 25.1 IP) with six walks and 36 strikeouts...Scott spent part of the 2022 and 2023 seasons on Coney Island, making six appearances in each campaign...In 12 outings (11 starts) with the Cyclones, the Florida native accrued a 1-0 record with a 3.00 ERA (15 ER in 45.0 IP) with 14 walks (7.53 BB%) and 52 strikeouts (27.96%).

SWIPING THE TOP SPOT: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (52) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...De Los Santos enters Friday's contest 15-for-16 stealing bases to start the season...The 15 swipes are tied for second in the South Atlantic League and tied for fifth throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for sixth across the Minors for steals (122).

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Tuesday's 9-2 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now six wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 994-840 (.542) in 1,834 games since 2001...Brooklyn captured its 900th victory in franchise history with a 6-5 triumph vs. Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown...Since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021, the Cyclones are 196-209 (.484) in 405 games.

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** continued his stellar start to his 2024 season on Thursday with four innings of shutout relief...Since one out in the bottom of the eighth on April 19 at Jersey Shore, the 24-year-old has not allowed a run...The 8.2-consecutive scoreless frames is the longest spotless stretch by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for second in strikeouts (23), third in strikeout-to-walk rate (11.50), and fourth in innings pitched (15.2).

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native reached base three times on Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI...Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions...Coming into Friday's contest, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (10) and doubles (4), fifth in slugging (.547), tied for sixth in OPS (.929), tied for seventh in RBI (14), tied for eighth in batting average (.297)...Lorusso trails only Triple-A Syracuse's OF **Ben Gamel** (13) for the most extra-base knocks in the Mets' farm system.

ATOP THE HEJ-JES: With his scoreless relief outing on Wednesday night vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Josh Hejka** is now tied with RHP **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...The 27-year-old broke a tie with LHP **Carlos Valdéz** (46) for second place on the all-time list in the contest...In his 47 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.74 ERA (23 ER in 75.2 IP) and three saves, walking just 17 and striking out 68.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The reliever yielded just one unearned run over 2.1 innings on Wednesday and notched a three-inning save in last Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings)...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 11.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old has the lowest WHIP (0.35) and opposing OPS (.188) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (2)...He is also one of three relievers (Greenville's RHPs **Caleb Bolden** and **Jonathan Brand**) in the circuit to throw that many innings and not allow an earned run.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** celebrated his 22nd birthday on Wednesday and continued his impressive pitching to start the year on Tuesday, hurling 41 scoreless innings in his first start of 2024, extending his scoreless innings streak to a season-high 91...Orellana began the year with 81 consecutive spotless frames out of the

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn continues its first two-week homestand of the season against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess six of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (6), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), RHP **Juan Núñez** (26), RHP **Carter Baumler** (28), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...Bradfield Jr. is currently on the 7-day injured list...In 18 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 10-8 record against Aberdeen, including a 7-5 record at Maimonides Park...Since 2002, the Cyclones and IronBirds have met 242 times with Brooklyn leading the all-time series, 127-115 (.525).

bullpen...Last Wednesday in relief, the 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit.

LOVE THE DRAKE! C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...The 25-year-old has collected an eye-popping .389 (14-36) with a 1.083 OPS, adding four doubles, a home run, and four RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 45 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in on-base percentage (.479)...He is also third in OPS (1.017) and batting average (.359), and seventh in slugging (.538).

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington last Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs **Jordan Geber**, **Brett Banks**, and **Justin Lawson** united on a one-hit shutout of Wilmington in Friday's 3-0 victory...The one-hitter marked the first time the Cyclones held an opponent to one or fewer hits since May 22, 2022...Brooklyn bested Hudson Valley, 3-1, in Game 2 of a doubleheader...It was the first one-hitter in a nine-inning game since a 6-1 rout vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning that night...It was Brooklyn's second shutout of the series and third of the year after RHPs **Nolan McLean**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joey Lancellotti** combined on Brooklyn's 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday...RHPs **Brandon Sproat**, **Jordany Ventura**, and **Justin Lawson** registered a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 66 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 99 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the first win of his professional career in relief last Saturday afternoon vs. Wilmington... Entered in support of RHP **Tylor Megill** (2.0 IP) and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) to start the top of the fourth with the game tied at two...Allowed just one unearned run on two hits over a career-high five innings...Walked only one and struck out a career-high-tying five...Charged with a balk...Tossed a career-high 76 pitches and 55 strikes (72.4%)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** to start the top of the ninth with Brooklyn leading 4-3...Cyclones went on to win by that final.

PROSPECT RADAR: Sproat enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top pitching prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 23-year-old is considered New York's No. 11 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 13 by MLB Pipeline...He is the fourth-ranked pitching prospect in the organization by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Pace, Fla. native earned a hold pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...Sproat came on in support of fellow Cyclone RHP **Nolan McLean** in the top of the sixth...The right-hander retired the side in order on just six pitches (all strikes) earning punch outs of C **Maxwell Romero Jr.** and OF **Andrew Pinckney**...McLean earned the win and teammate RHP **Calvin Ziegler** picked up the save in New York's 4-2, seven-inning win.

GATOR BAIT: Sproat did not pitch after being drafted by the Mets last season, but thrived for the 2023 NCAA runner-up Florida Gators...In 19 starts, the right-hander posted an 8-3 record with a 4.66 ERA (55 ER in 106.1 IP), earning All-SEC Second Team honors...Sproat finished the campaign seventh among Division I pitchers in strikeouts (134).

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: Sproat was drafted for the third and final time in the MLB draft last summer, ultimately signing for a \$1.47 million bonus...Prior to being New York's second-round selection in 2023, the 23-year-old was picked by the Mets in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Florida, but did not sign...In 2019, Sproat was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the seventh round out of Pace High School, but also did not sign.

FAMILIAR FACES: While at the University of Florida, Sproat spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League...During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones TWP **Nolan McLean** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
