 The Reno Aces return to Greater Nevada Field to host the Albuquerque Isotopes for their final homestand of the 2024 campaign... Reno has a chance to clinch a postseasor birth this week, as they are currently 3.0 games ahead of the Las Vegas Aviators for the final spot... The BLC-Nine is coming off a split-series with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys in their final road trip of the year... The Aces were defeated in walk-off fashion in Sunday's series finale vs the Space Cowboys... After collecting his first career Triple-A home run in last night's win, **Andy Weber** delivered a clutch game-tying big fly in the top of the seventh to complete a three-run comeback. Weber has swung it well since his promotion to Reno, slashing .308/.321/.615 with two home runs and seven RBI in eight games... **Jordan Lawlar** started the scoring for Reno with his second home run of the year, solo shot in the fourth frame. The Diamondback's #1 overall prospect has so far lived up to his potential in 7 games with the Aces this season, going 12-for-31 (.387) with five extra-base hits and 10 RBI... The Aces will now take on the Albuquerque Isotopes, the Triple-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, for their final series of the season, with the first pitch scheduled for 6:35 p.m. PT.

- Reno leads Triple-A in AVG (.286), and Hits (1432)... 2nd in Total-Bases (2372), Runs (872), and RBI (835)... 2nd least amount of strikeouts (1084).
- ♥ This is the 7th of 12 matchups between the two clubs this season... Albuquerque took the first series, coming out on top in four out of six matchups.
