LAST TIME OUT: The Saints took a 4-0 lead into the seventh inning stretch but could not hold onto it in a 6-5 walk-off loss in Louisville on Wednesday. Yunior Severino hit his 16<sup>th</sup> home run of the season in the first inning, giving the Saints a 1-0 lead. The Saints went with a bullpen game on the mound, getting 6.0 innings of shutout baseball from Scott Blewett, Nick Wittgren and Zack Weiss to open the ballgame. Payton Eeles cranked his first Triple-A home run in the sixth inning to straightaway center field, making it 3-0. Edouard Julien joined the party in the seventh, homering in his second straight game, extending the lead to 4-0. The Bats plated three in the seventh to make it a one-run game. Chris Williams answered for the Saints in the eighth, hitting the team's fourth homer of the game. The Saints took a 5-4 lead into the ninth, turning to Diego Castillo. He retired his first two batters and had Connor Capel down to his final strike before walking him. He then gave up a two-run, walk-off home run to Michael Trautwein to drop the game 6-5.

LOUIE LOVES LOU: Louie Varland threw 7.0 shutout innings on May 3 against Louisville, coming one out short of his career-high 7.1 shutout innings that he threw against Louisville on August 11, 2023. Varland is one of 19 pitchers in the International League since 2021 to have multiple appearances of 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run. Including his May 3 start, Varland is one of three IL pitchers since 2021 to have multiple starts of 7.0 innings and zero earned runs against the same team (Kyle Wright - Gwinnett, vs. Nashville and Caleb Boushley - NAS/STP vs. Toledo).

I'LL TAKE HOMERS FOR FOUR: The Saints clubbed four home runs in for the fifth time this season in their 6-5 loss on Wednesday. However, Wednesday marked the first time this year and just the third time in franchise history the Saints lost a game in which they hit four home runs. The previous two occurrences came in 2021: June 10, 2021 (L 16-9 v OMA) and August 18, 2021 (L 11-7 v Iowa). The Saints were 15-0 all-time when hitting four-or-more home runs on the road prior to last night's loss.

**REHAB ROUNDTABLE:** The Saints have two Major League Rehab assignments added to their roster in Brock Stewart and Zack Weiss. Stewart made his first appearance on Tuesday, striking out one and walking two. Weiss made his first Triple-A rehab outing on Wednesday, striking out four and allowing a hit in 2.0 innings

LOUISVILLE SLUGGERS: Since joining the International League, the Saints have hit well at Louisville, sporting a .264/.358/.481 slash line and an .839 OPS, which are all the best of any venue they've played in (home or road) and the 0.44 home runs per plate appearance is the best of any ballpark the Saints have played in, including CHS Field (0.38 HR/PA). It is also the sixth-best of any IL team in any ballpark since 2021 (min 12 games) and the best for any IL team at Louisville Slugger Field (including Louisville) since 2021.

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .600 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in five of the six games he's played in, drawing four walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is the leader among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .467 across three levels.

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season on Wednesday and the 41<sup>st</sup> of his Saints career. He is now just two home runs away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43. Over his last 11 games, Williams is hitting 11-for-36 (.306) with a double, seven home runs and 11

**SUMMERTIME SEVERINO:** In Yunior Severino's 39 games since May 21, he has hit .357 (51-for-143), with 10 home runs, drawing 28 walks to 40 strikeouts, owning a 1.063 OPS. Since June 1, Severino leads the IL in batting average (.370) and onbase percentage, sporting a .481 clip. He's third in OPS, at 1.092, ranking fifth in slugging percentage at .611. His 23 walks since the start of June are the sixth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins split their doubleheader with the Chicago White Sox on Wednesday, dropping game one 3-1 before winning game two 3-2. Carlos Correa accounted for three of the Twins' six hits in game one and Matt Wallner hit his second home run in as many games, scoring the Twins lone run. Bailey Ober took the los in the quality start, allowing three runs over 6.0 innings. In game two, Brooks Lee hit his second MLB home run as Correa followed with a home run to go back-to-back to tie the game at two. Ryan Jeffers singled in the go-ahead run in the seventh as the Twins' bullpen allowed only one baserunner over the final 4.0 innings of the game.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 6/29 @ IOWA...made 10th AAA start of the season, bouncing back with 5.0 shutout innings, allowing four hits and two walks while striking out seven...gave up hits to his first two batters, then hit a man with one out to load the bases...escaped the jam with a strikeout and fly out...issued back-to-back walks with two outs in the second inning before retiring six in a row...allowed a pair of one-out singles in the fourth, then retiring his final four batters...first Saints start without allowing any runs since May 3 against Louisville...received first win since May 21 at Buffalo and third of the season in 8-2 Saints

SOMEONE IS FLIPPING OVER A CHECKERS BOARD: During the 2023 offseason, Louie got engaged to Maddie Hentges, a former lacrosse player at Concordia-St. Paul (2017-20), the same school as Varland. Maddies brother, Sam, was a star forward on the Totino-Grace HS hockey team, played at St. Cloud State, and was a Minnesota Wild draft pick. Maddies Dad, Mark, was a Hobie Baker Award finalist in 1980 at St. Thomas, a 2x All-American (1980 & 81) and played in the Montreal Canadiens organization.

NOTHING TO RANT(Z) ABOUT X 2: Make it back-to-back years in which Varland was honored with the Jim Rantz Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award. In 2021 he received it after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERA in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids. In 103.0 innings pitched he fanned 142 while opponents hit 214 against him. In 2022, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, he went 8-5, 3.06 (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts as opponents hit .242 against him across 24 games (23) starts. He also went 1-2, 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with six walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .261 opponents batting average in five starts.

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME: With the transfer from Double-A to Triple-A, on August 8, 2022, Varland returned home. He became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became a Triple-A franchise. Some of the players from the Independent days that were from St. Paul that played for the Saints include Jack Morris, Ryan Schlosser, Tim Thomas (1995), Chris Schwab, Steve Butler, Adam Larson, Brian Whinnery, Zach Peterson, Reid Mahon, Matt Schuld, Joe Bonfe, Jack Goihl, and Jake Esch.

HULKAMANIA: While in high school at North St. Paul High School, Varland was on the wrestling team. He was a two-time MSHSL State Tournament wrestler, two-time MVP, Most Improved, Rookie of the Year, two-time section runner up and four-time captain of the wrestling team.

**GET ON THE BUS, GUS:** Louie's brother, Gus, is 13 months older than him. They played together at North St. Paul High School and Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was selected in the 14th round by the Oakland Athletics in 2018 out of Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was then traded to the Dodgers along with 3B Sheldon Neuse in exchange for LHP Adam Kolarek and RF Cody Thomas on February 12, 2021. He was claimed in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 draft by the Milwaukee Brewers from the L.A. Dodgers on December 7, 2022

NOT MY BROTHERS KEEPER: - Louie faced off against his brother Gus in 2022 as the Wind Surge took on the Tulsa Drillers on May 6, 2022 in Wichita. It's the first time brothers started against each other in the Minors since at least the 2000s. Louie went 5.0 IP allowed two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out six. His brother went 3.0 IP allowing six runs on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-2 Wichita victory in game one of a doubleheader.

**BROTHERLY LOVE:** On June 15, 2022 the Wind Surge and Drillers met again in a doubleheader in Wichita. This time, the brothers pitched opposite ends of the doubleheader and each got a victory. Louie won Game 1 allowing two runs across 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out four in a 7-4 Wind Surge win. In the second game, Gus pitched 2.0 shutout innings of relief allowing one hit and striking out four in a 4-3 Drillers victory.

**RUNS IN THE FAMILY:** While Louie has more than made a name for himself, he might not even be the most athletic person in his family. His Aunt's Denise and Sue were legendary softball pitchers at North St. Paul High School.
