TONIGHT: The Stripers begin a six-game series vs. the KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in Charlotte Knights (Chicago White Sox) at Coolray Field. It is the seventh of 18 meetings between the clubs this season, and the seventh of 12 games to be played in Georgia. It's Independence Day featuring a post-game Fireworks Extravaganza. Stripers players and coaches are wearing Patriotic Jerseys (presented by Republic Services), which are available for purchase via auction at GoStripers.com (proceeds benefit Make-A-Wish Foundation).

VS. CHARLOTTE: Gwinnett is 72-61 (.541) in 133 games vs. Charlotte all-time at Coolray Field, including 4-2 (.667) in six games in 2022. The Stripers are 7-5 in season home series vs. the Knights dating back to 2009, including 3-1 over the last four seasons (2017-21). Gwinnett is riding a two-game home winning streak over Charlotte since 5/7.

<u>RISING WATERS:</u> Coming off a three-hit game last night in Norfolk (3-for-4, R), Drew Waters is batting .276 (16-for-58, 1 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 7 R, 6 RBI, 2 SB, .820 OPS) over his last 14 games since 6/17. On Saturday, he blasted a decisive two-run homer (#5) in the third inning of a 6-1 win. Gwinnett is 5-0 when Waters homers this season.

- <u>2022 Season</u>: In 43 total games, Waters is batting .254 (43-for-169, 6 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 23 R, 16 RBI, 3 SB, .718 OPS), including .420 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.023 OPS) vs. LHP and .185 (2 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, .591 OPS) vs. RHP.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .249 (169-for-680, 33 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 110 R, 64 RBI, 34 SB, .712 OPS) in 172 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake has hit safely in 11 of 13 games since 6/7, batting .308 (16-for-52, 2 2B, 2 HR, 5 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .801 OPS) in that span. He homered twice on the road trip, 6/22 at Nashville (2-run, off RHP Luke Barker) and 7/2 at Norfolk (2-run, off RHP Marcos Diplan). In 56 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he's batting .270 (57-for-211, 10 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 28 R, 17 RBI, 6 SB, .720 OPS).

POSTSEASON HEROES COMPLETE REHAB: Two key players from the Atlanta Braves' 2021 World Series championship were activated off injury rehab assignments with Gwinnett today: OF Eddie Rosario and LHP Tyler Matzek.

- Rosario: Hit .273 (9-for-33, 2 2B, 4 R, 5 RBI) in eight games from 6/25-7/3. He was on the 10-day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable
- Player, rehabbed with the Stripers for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021). Matzek: Struck out five of six batters faced over two games (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 BB) from 6/29-7/3. Was on the 15-day IL with left shoulder inflammation after going 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA and .167 BAA in 13 games with

Atlanta this season. It was his second career stint with the Stripers (0-0, 9.00 ERA in 5G in 2019).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 14 of 17 games with at least one plate appearance since 6/1, batting .304 (14-for-46, 2 2B, 1 HR, 11 R, 6 RBI, 6 SB, .863 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 44 of 53 games (83.0%) with a plate appearance, batting .265 (40-for-151, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .740 OPS).

IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-9th, 16) and walks (T-14th, 37).

strikeouts with 795 in 78 games (10.19 SO per game). That's one more than Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 794 SO in 78G). Kyle Muller (1st, 102), Tucker Davidson (4th, 78), Huascar Ynoa (T-9th, 67), and Bryce Elder (T-15th, 62) all rank among the International League top 15 in strikeouts.

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 SO on Saturday) enters play riding a team-best 10.0-inning scoreless streak over his last nine appearances. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.50 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .118 BAA, 15.30 SO/9.0 IP ratio (17 SO), and two saves (2-for-2). In 23 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.19 ERA (6 ER in 24.0 IP), .185 BAA, 14.96 SO/9.0 IP ratio (41 SO), and team-high five saves (5-for-6, T-13th in IL).

MULLER'S QUALITY STREAK ENDS: Kyle Muller saw his five-game quality start streak snapped on 7/1 at Norfolk (loss, 5.1 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 3 SO). During the streak from 6/2-6/26, he went 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- · IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (102, ?? in MiLB) and ranks among the IL top five in ERA (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (2nd, 1.09), innings (2nd, 81.1), BAA (3rd, .216), and starts (T-5th, 14).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-9 with a 3.19 ERA (57 ER in 161.0 IP), .219 BAA, and 195 strikeouts (10.90 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 31 starts.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel tallied a seasonhigh four RBI on 6/30 at Norfolk (2-for-4, 2B, HR), his most RBI in a game since 6/24/21, also at Norfolk (1-for-4, grand slam, 4 RBI in 6-2 win). Of his 17 hits, 12 have gone for extra bases (70.6%, 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR). For his Gwinnett career, 50.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (26 of 52), including 10 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meija.

TONIGHT'S START: Nolan Kingham makes his ninth start and 20th appearance of the season in the opener of a six-game series vs. Charlotte.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 27th appearance (15th start) for the Stripers ... Is 1-6 with a 6.38 ERA and .283 BAA with the club since making his Triple-A debut in 2021.
- <u>Triple-A Splits:</u> In 14 starts with Gwinnett, is 0-5 with a 6.71 ERA and .299 BAA ... In 15 home games (8 starts) at the Triple-A level, is 0-4 with a 7.02 ERA and .292 BAA.
- Last Start/Win: Hasn't won in a start since 8/20/21 with Double-A Mississippi at Montgomery (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 5 SO in 3-1 victory).

2022 SEASON: Was a member of Gwinnett's Opening Night roster for the first time in his career ... Did not allow a run over his first five games (9.1 IP), all relief outings ... **4/30 vs. NOR:** Made his first start of the year, tossing a season-high 4.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 1 BB, 2 SO) in a combined six-hit shutout (won 5-0) ... **5/10 at DUR:** Earned his first career Triple-A win in relief (2.0 IP, 0 H, 3 SO in 8-4 victory) ... **6/9 at JAX:** In his fifth spot start, tied his season high with 4.0 IP (4 H, 1 R, 0 ER) and struck out seven (won 5-1), his most strikeouts in a game since 8/16/19 with Double-A Mississippi vs. Birmingham (8 SO in 7.0 IP).
