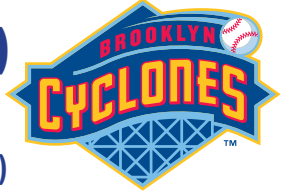

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones played their third doubleheader in eight days and second in four days, splitting a twinbill with Hudson Valley on Wednesday...Brooklyn took the lid-lifter, 3-2, before Hudson Valley snared the finale, 7-0...The Cyclones erased a one-run deficit in the seventh in the opener, winning on 3B **Jacob Reimer's** walk-off two-run single to right...RHP **Jack Wenninger** took a no-decision, striking out eight for the 'Clones over 3.2 innings...RF **D'Andre Smith** picked up two hits, including a double in the win...RHPs **Blane Abeyta** (2.0 IP), **Kelly Austin** (1.0), **Mason Vinyard** (1.0), **Indigo Diaz** (1.0), **Sean Boyle** (1.0), and **Hueston Morrill** (1.0) combined on a three-hit shutout for the Renegades in Game 2...2B **Roc Riggo** doubled and drove in three runs, while C **Antonio Gómez** picked up two hits, a triple and a walk...RHP **Jonah Tong** battled through 5.0 innings for Brooklyn but walked a career-high six and struck out five, suffering the loss.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 8, 2007, the Cyclones shut out Mahoning Valley on the road in both ends of a doubleheader, taking the two contests by final scores of 2-0...RHP **Nicholas Waechter** (5.2 IP), LHP **Grady Hinchman** (0.1), and RHP **Eddie Kunz** (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in Game 1 before RHPs **Dylan Owen** (5.0 IP), **Daniel McDonald** (1.0), and **Stephen Clyne** (1.0) tossed a four-hitter in Game 2...In 2016, 1B **Pete Alonso** and C **Ali Sánchez** each went 4-for-5 in a 14-3 win at Tri-City...Alonso scored three runs, doubled, homered, and drove in three in the rout...In 2019, a throwing error on 2B **Luke Ritter's** sacrifice bunt in the bottom of the 10th scored the winning run in a 3-2 win vs. Connecticut...In 2021, the Cyclones rallied from 4-1 down in the seventh, tying the game in the ninth on a SS **Ronny Mauricio** triple and walking off on a DH **Francisco Alvarez** sacrifice fly, to defeat Hudson Valley at home, 5-4.

YOU SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: OF **Omar De Los Santos** celebrates his 25th birthday on Thursday...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the Cyclones' single-season (37) and all-time (71) leader in stolen bases...In 158 games over two years with the Cyclones, De Los Santos is a .193/.257/.318 hitter with a .575 OPS, adding 78 runs scored, 37 extra-base hits, 14 home runs, and 61 RBI.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the fourth time in the last 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.00% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 235 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.77%)...The Cyclones have also earned 23 wins in their last at-bat.

LET'S PLAY TWO: After playing two doubleheaders from Opening Day until July 28, the Cyclones played their third doubleheader in eight days on Wednesday...Brooklyn split their third-straight twinbill, walking off with a 3-2 win in Game 1 before dropping Game 2, 7-0...Brooklyn is 5-5 in doubleheader games this year and 1-1-3 in doubleheaders overall...In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders overall and 2-10 in games.

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...Over his last four appearances (three starts) since July 14 at Wilmington, the 22-year-old has no record, but a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP) and one hold...Wenninger has surrendered 13 hits and nine walks while striking out 19 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native's 1.72 ERA ranks seventh in the South Atlantic League in that time.

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 30th multi-hit game of the year in the second game of Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen and is hitting .339/.409/.407 with a .816 OPS in 16 games since the All-Star break...The McLean, Va. native is tied for eighth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (47)...He is just one steal (36) away from tying OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones return to Coney Island for their final six-game series of 2024 against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades have six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **George Lombard Jr.** (6), LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (17), RHP **Cade Smith** (20), OF **Anthony Hall** (27), and OF **Jace Avina** (29)...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split a home-and-home series (July 1-6) after the Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley on Coney Island (May 23-28)...Hudson Valley won 4-of-6 in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...On the year, the series is tied 9-9...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 150-154 (.493)

in hits (82), is second in stolen bases (36), sixth in batting average (.289), tied for sixth in runs scored (47), and eighth in on-base percentage (.365)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (36), sixth in batting average (.289), and ninth in on-base percentage (.365) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.312), stolen bases (47), on-base percentage (.404), and hits (113)...He is also tied for second in triples (4), third in runs scored (61) and total bases (142), fourth in OPS (.796), and tied for fifth in walks (49).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and is second among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also good for seventh in the circuit overall...He is also second in the SAL in batting average against (.213), third in ERA (3.63), fourth in WHIP (1.28), and sixth in innings pitched (69.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.17), third in strikeout rate (35.2%), fourth in strikeouts (129), and seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and has homered in six of his last 16 games since July 13 at Wilmington...Five of those six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for the league lead in triples (2), second in slugging (.627), tied for second in home runs (5), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (8), tied for sixth in total bases (32), and tied for seventh in runs scored (12)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 34 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (71) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for first in the South Atlantic League (71) and is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (143).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 10.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winnfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.79 ERA (2 ER in 22.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 18.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.79).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 21 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .319/.380/.361 with a .741 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, and three stolen bases over the 21 games...Clark is sixth in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.319) since that date.

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are three behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for ninth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (23), and Wenninger (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Collected a third-straight no-decision last Friday night at Aberdeen...Yielded one run on one hit over 3.0 innings...Walked two and struck out four...Threw 55 pitches and 32 strikes (58.18%)...Game was suspended until Saturday after a 46-minute delay in the middle of the fourth inning...Relieved by LHP **Zach Thornton** to start the bottom of the fourth when the game resumed the next day...Cyclones rallied to tie the game in the seventh on a CF **Omar De Los Santos** three-run home run...Aberdeen regained the lead, 4-3, in the bottom half before the game was halted once more with De Los Santos at the plate and the bases loaded with two out in the top of the eighth...After a 21-minute delay, the game was called and the IronBirds awarded a 4-3 win...The second game of Saturday's doubleheader would be postponed to Sunday.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first eight appearances (seven starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 2.92 ERA (12 ER in 37.0 IP), 16 walks, and 45 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-4 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 5.80 ERA (26 ER in 40.1 IP), with 17 walks, and 42 strikeouts.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday a day early by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
