SATURDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 4-3, in 12 innings. **Turner Hill** won the game with a walk-off double in the bottom of the 12th inning. The Baysox opened the scoring with a wild pitch bringing home a run in the top of the first inning, the only run allowed over five innings by **John Michael Bertrand** in his start. It was also the only run he allowed against the Baysox this year in 25 innings of work and his first wild pitch of the year. **Andy Thomas** gave Richmond a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the fourth with a two-run homer. In the top of the ninth with two outs and two strikes, Collin Burns tied the game with an RBI single. The Baysox and Flying Squirrels both went scoreless in the 10th inning. In the 11th, Anthony Servideo gave Bowie a 3-2 lead with an RBI single. **Victor Bericoto** scored on a two-out wild pitch in the bottom of the 11th to tie the score, 3-3. **Eric Silva** pitched 11 scoreless innings to pick up his fourth win of the year.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, in the opener of a six-game series. The series marks the Senators' only trip to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels played a six-game series in Harrisburg from April 16-21, going 3-3. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for six games from August 13-18.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 3-3 last week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half the previous week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .220 and averaging 3.77 runs per game (147 runs/39 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). Richmond is 2-11 in its last 13 home games dating back to June 6.

THE SENATORS are 3-9 to open the second half after finishing second in the Southwest Division in the first half, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg has lost four straight games and has gone 4-13 over its last 17 games since June 19. On the season, the Senators offense ranks last in the Eastern League in batting average (.219), OBP (.300), SLG (.327) and OPS (.627). Harrisburg's pitching staff ranks second in the league in ERA (3.33). Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Daylen Lile (No. 10), RHP Andy Lara (No. 14), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 19) and SS Kevin Made (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes even Harrisburg players, including Lile (No. 6), Pinckney (No. 16), Brzykcy (No. 17), Made (No. 18), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), Lara (No. 27) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Dylan Cumming** makes his fifth Double-A start and seventh appearance. He last pitched last Tuesday in a start at Bowie and allowed one run over four innings in a loss, striking out four. For the year, Cumming ranks third in the Giants system in strikeouts (78). Out of Giants minor leaguers who have pitched at least 60 innings, Cumming is ranked second in strikeout percentage (31.6%) and third in K/9 (11.7). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. **For more on Cumming, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Michael Cuevas makes his 16th start of the season and his second this year against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he pitched a season-high seven innings and allowed one run on three hits with seven strikeouts against the Curve last Tuesday, the most recent win for the Senators. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on April 17 at FNB Field and allowed four runs over six innings in a no-decision. In five career starts against the Flying Squirrels, Cuevas is 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (19 ER/19.0 IP). Cuevas spent all of last season with Harrisburg and went 4-8 with a 5.53 ERA in 23 starts. He made his Double-A debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 12, 2023 and allowed five runs (four earned) over three innings. Cuevas was selected by the Nationals in the 23rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Brennan High School in Texas.

CARTER'S CRUISING: Dating back to June 13 in 18 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .347 (25-for-72) with seven doubles, two triples and 13 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times and he has two hits in three-of-his-last-five games. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for fourth in doubles (18), eighth in batting average (.287) and ninth in hits (73).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 24 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .343 (35-for-102) with three homers, five doubles, six walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 34 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .321 (43-for-134) with six homers, six doubles, 12 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in eight-of-16 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .358 (24-for-67) in that stretch. He is currently riding a seven-game hit streak since June 29.

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .339 (19-for-56) and has added four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 13 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. Last Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

POMARES POWER: **Jairo Pomares** has three homers in his last seven games dating back to June 28. On the year, he leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks fourth in the Giants system in homers (10). Pomares missed the start of the season with an injury and joined the Flying Squirrels for his Double-A debut on May 5. Since then, his 10 homers are tied for third in the Eastern League, trailing only 11 home runs by Eric's Hao-Yu Lee and Chris Meyers. For Pomares, his 17.7 PA/HR is the second-best in a season in franchise history (min. 150 PA), trailing only **Sean Roby** (14.12) in 2022 when he set the single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever **Eric Silva** has thrown six consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 8.2 innings. He has 10 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.84. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,962), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 18), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landon Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.

SHINING STARS: Major League Baseball announced the full 2024 All-Star Game rosters on Sunday night and two former Flying Squirrels, outfielder **Heliot Ramos** and pitcher **Logan Webb**, were both selected for the first time in their careers. Webb, who pitched 14 games for Richmond in 2018 and 2019, became the first former Flying Squirrels pitcher to be selected as an MLB All-Star. With Richmond, Webb went 2-6 with a 2.88 ERA in his two seasons and was the team's Opening Day starter in 2019. Ramos, who joined the Flying Squirrels at age 19 in 2019, then the youngest player in franchise history, went on to play 87 games with Richmond across the 2019 and 2021 seasons, batting .239 with 13 homers and 41 RBIs. The pair marked the first former Flying Squirrels to be selected as MLB All-Stars since 2021. They became the fifth and sixth Flying Squirrels alumni to earn MLB All-Star selections, joining **Brandon Crawford** (2015, 2018, 2021), **Joe Panik** (2015), **Brandon Belt** (2016) and **Adam Duvall** (2016). The 2024 MLB All-Star Game will next Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas at 8 p.m.

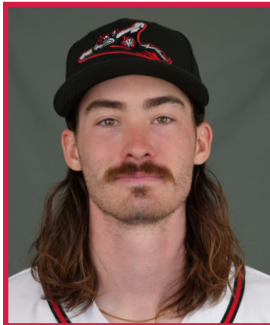
IN OTHER WORDS...
