LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned at least a split in the home-and-home series with an 8-3 win at Hudson Valley...RF **Nick Morabito**, SS **Wilfredo Lara**, and LF **Karell Paz** each tallied multi-hit games...Morabito added a triple and an RBI...Lara reached base three times and drove in two...Paz doubled and brought a pair...C **Chris Suero** doubled and collected two RBI...DH **Kellum Clark** walked three times...LHP **Ryan Ammons** struck out four and tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball to pick up the win out of the bullpen in his Cyclones debut...RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** earned the hold with 3.0 frames out of the bullpen, allowing one tally...RHP **Justin Lawson** hurled 3.0 scoreless innings to close the game, earning his sixth save.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On July 6, 2001, the Cyclones and the Pittsfield (Mass.) Astros endure a 25-minute sun delay...Wahconah Park in Pittsfield was built in 1892, well before night baseball games were in fashion, and home plate faced west...In 2006, RHPs **Jake Ruckle** (8.2 IP) and **Joe Smith** (0.1) combined on a one-hitter, as the Cyclones won 1-0 vs. Staten Island...In 2008, 2B-SS **Josh Satin**'s two-run double in the bottom of the eighth broke a two-all tie in a 4-2 win vs. Mahoning Valley... In 2012, after tying the game in the seventh with a CF **Brandon Nimmo** single, the Cyclones walked off Williamsport, 7-6, in 11 innings on a bases-loaded walk to 2B **Richie Rodriguez**...In 2014, LHP **Carlos Valdez** (5.0 IP) and RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (4.0) combined on a two-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 7-0 win vs. Aberdeen.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: On Saturday, RHP **Eric Orze** had his contract selected by the New York Mets from Triple-A Syracuse...When he makes his Major League debut, the 26-year-old will be the 101st former Brooklyn Cyclone to reach the level...He will also be the 67th to make his debut for the Mets...In 26 relief appearances with Syracuse in 2024, Orze holds a 3-0 record with a 3.76 ERA (16 ER in 38.1 IP), two saves, 22 walks (13.3 BB%), and 56 strikeouts (33.9 K%)...The University of New Orleans alum made 13 appearances out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2021...Orze went 1-2 with a 4.05 ERA (9 ER in 20.0 IP), one save, six walks (7.0 BB%), and 26 strikeouts (30.2 K%)...He would be the third former Brooklyn pitcher to debut this season joining RHP **Christian Scott** (5/4) with the Mets and RHP **Michel Otañez** (6/10) with the Oakland Athletics.

ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs **Kodai Senga** (2.2 IP) and **Kade Morris** (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, on Wednesday...A night before, RHPs **Jonah Tong** (5.0 IP), **Ben Simon** (3.0), and **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching threw 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings between OF **Garrett Martin**'s solo home run in the eighth inning on Monday and DH **Omar Martínez**'s three-run blast in the first inning on Thursday...Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the Iron-Birds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively...Each of Brooklyn's last three victories has come in shutout fashion...RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) united on a three-hit blanking in a 7-0 rout at Aberdeen last Friday...With Wednesday's win, Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for third most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Aberdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley...Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks (10.0 BB%), while striking out 25 (41.67 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63)...He is also second in ERA (3.02), tied for second in batting average against (.194), and fourth in WHIP (1.22)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fourth in strikeout rate (36.3%), ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and 10th in strikeouts (99)

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn will play a home-and-home six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley boasts four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley in the first meeting on Coney Island (May 23-28), but the Renegades to 4-of-6 from Brooklyn in their last meeting in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...In 2023, the Cyclones went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 149-152 (.495).

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is tied for eighth in the South Atlantic League walks (39), ninth in OPS (.833), tied for ninth in total bases (119), 10th in slugging (.469), and tied for 10th in home runs (11)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.833)...He is also fourth in slugging (.469), tied for fourth in home runs (11) and triples (3), fifth in total bases (120) and RBI (41), and tied for fifth in hits (68) and extra-base hits (27)...Morabito is 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (36)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the circuit in stolen bases (25), tied for fourth in hits (55), and sixth in runs scored (35)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.319), on-base percentage (.421), and stolen bases (36)...He also is second in hits (86), tied for second in runs scored (49), fourth in OPS (.832), tied for fourth in triples (4), and fifth in walks (40).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with last Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 4-7 in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster last Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 29 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (66) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (66) and is tied for third across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (138).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 30 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 14 walks to 17 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444), slugging (.661), and OPS (1.105)...In 38 road affairs, Lorusso hits .190/.307/.327 with a .634 OPS, adding five home runs and 23 RBI with 25 walks to 43 K's...On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .328/.422/.448 with a .870 OPS, adding two home runs, eight RBI, and 23 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits in the circuit (38)...He is also tied for third in runs scored (26) while swiping seven more bases (23) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .169/.270/.246 with a .516 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 33 contests.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Sunday at Aberdeen...Yielded four runs (three earned) on three hits in 4.0-plus innings...Walked two and struck out six...Plunked a batter and tossed a wild pitch...Threw 82 pitches and 52 strikes (63.41%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** with a man at first and nobody out in the bottom of the fifth and Brooklyn leading, 4-3...Bequeathed runner scored...Trailing 8-5 entering the eighth, the Cyclones scored one in that frame and four in the ninth to take a 10-8 lead on **Karell Paz's** two-run home run... However, after a 19-minute rain delay in the bottom of the ninth, **Tavian Josenberger** clubbed a walk-off three-run homer to propel the IronBirds past Brooklyn, 11-10.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first seven appearance (six starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29.1 IP), 13 walks, and 38 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-3 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.41 ERA (19 ER in 26.2 IP), with 12 walks, and 30 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 29.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks fifth in ERA (1.84).

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)... He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
