CARDINALS SUNK BY HOOKS POWER DISPLAY: The Corpus Christi Hooks outhomered Springfield 4-2 and put the game away with a four-run 7th inning as the Cardinals dropped game two of six this week at Hammons Field 10-4 on Tuesday night. Nathan Church hit a two-run shot and drove in three runs for the Cards and RJ Yeager added a solo homer. The Cardinals, however, managed just four hits on the night, three of which went for extra bases. Leonardo Taveras fired 2.1 scoreless innings for Springfield out of the bulloen.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Tyler Guilfoil** makes his 14th start (18th appearance) of the season for Corpus Christi...Last pitched in relief as part of a piggy-back role on Friday, July 19 against Midland and took the loss allowing 7 runs (5 ER) on 7 hits (including 2 HR) over 5.0 IP against Midland at Whataburger Field...The Hooks lost the game 7-3 in 10 innings...Last two appearances have come in relief... Pitched twice against the Cardinals in June in Corpus Christi, going a combined 0-1 while allowiong 4 ER on 9 H in 9.0 IP with 6 BB and 5 K...Split his first full season in 2023 between High-A Asheville (5 appearances) and Low-A Fayetteville (18 appearances) and went 3-6 with a 3.21 ERA over 23 appearances (13 starts) overall...Made 7 appearances after being drafted in 2022 between the FCL and Fayetteville... Selected by the Astros in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of Kentucky...Named 1st team All-American by Baseball America, NCBWA, and Perfect Game as a junior at Kentucky going 3-1 with a 1.59 ERA and 6 saves in 21 relief appearances...Spent his first 3 collegiate seasons at Lipscomb where he served as the Bison's closer with 13 saves from 2018-21...Grew up in Lexington, 1 mile from UK's campus...24 years old

**CARDS HOST HODKS IN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON MATCHUP:** The Cardinals return to Hammons Field for a six-game series and their final regular season matchup with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). Springfield won four of six against the Hooks at Whataburger Field in June, including a postseason-clinching win in the series finale on the final day of the first half on June 23.

#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

TEXAS LEAGUE SCOREBOARD







For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**HOME SWEET HOME:** After struggling for a stretch and even after Wednesday night's loss, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield is 9-3 over its last 12 games at home, lifting its home record to 23-25 (.479). The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61.

**POWER SURGE:** While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in home runs this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles of late. Over its last 18 games since June 30 Springfield has clubbed 21 homers, tied for 2nd with Corpus Christi for in the circuit during that time behind only Midland (26). The Cardinals sport a SLG of .442 and .799 OPS during that time and have homered in 11 of their last 13 games. For the season the Cardinals are 8th in the Texas League with 63 homers.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 19 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league among qualified hitters with a .358 average while adding 5 HR and 16 RBIs with 3 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .657 and has a 1.076 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .876 OPS and .408 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF Mike Antico is inching toward a pair of career milestones. Antico's next steal will give him 150 for his career, and with his 2-run shot on Tuesday is just 3 homers shy of 50 career bombs. Over his last 10 games, Antico is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the alltime franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 6-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 12-for-23 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI In 11 games in July, he is batting .395 (15-for-41) with a team-high 1.044 OPS.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: The 2024 season has been an up-and-down one for Cardinals OF Nathan Church, but the UC Irvine product has heated up of late. Church is batting .302 over his last 14 games since the 4th of July, adding 3 homers while going 5-for-5 in stolen bases. Church is riding a 12-game onbase streak and has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 15-for-15 and his 15 saves lead the Texas League and is tied for the most in all of Double-A with Austin Roberts of Pensacola (MIA).

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 11.0 IP (0.82 ERA) and is 5-for-5 in save opportunities.
