GIVE EM' THE MIZ: Brewers' no. 4-rated prospect (#72 in MLB Pipeline's Top 100) Jacob Misiorowski will make his second start of the series as he faces the Indians on Saturday night. Misiorowski suffered his first loss of the season on Monday night after allowing two runs (1 ER) over four innings of work. Still, Misiorowski owns the best ERA among qualified arms in the International League and all Triple-A. He enters his 12th game of the year with the second-most strikeouts in Triple-A (71) and trails Durham's Ian Seymour by seven. Misiorowski also owns the best BAA (.169) in Triple-A and leads three qualified arms to have a sub-one WHIP (0.98) in 2025. His eight strikeout game on Monday was one of four games this year in which he has posted 8+ strikeouts and the most since he set his season-high with 11 strikeouts on May 9th vs. Norfolk. He has allowed at least one earned run in each of his five starts in May but has only surrendered more than one run overall in two of his 11 games to start the season and has posted four scoreless appearances of 5+ innings. The loss on Monday snapped a four-game winning streak for the Sounds that Misiorowski has started. Over his last five games, the Sounds have only scored 13 runs total.

CATCHING DINGERS: Jorge Alfaro is the first Sounds player in 2025 to reach double-digit home runs on the season. Alfaro launched his 10th of the season in the top of the eighth inning to give the Sounds a 4-3 lead at the time with his three-run blast. It was his first home run since hitting a game-tying home run last Wednesday night against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Alfaro is tied for fifth in the International League in home runs this season and has his first 10+ home run season since hitting 18 during the 2019 season with the Miami Marlins.

I AM BOB: Bobby Dalbec recorded his second three hit game of the series and his fifth multi-hit game over his last 12 games with the Sounds. Over his last 12, Dalbec is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with four doubles, two home runs, and 11 RBI. Two of the four doubles came on Friday night. It was his second game this season with 2+ doubles. His first came on April 16th when he was with the Charlotte Knights against the Sounds.

THIRD AND HOME: Sounds outfielder Eddie Rosario recorded his third straight multi-hit game after going 2-for-4 with a RBI on Friday night. Rosario is hitting .500 (8-for-16) for the series after playing in each of the first four games. He's got a pair of doubles and three RBI this week against the Indians. The last time Rosario had three straight multi-hit games was June 17-20 during the 2023 season when he was playing with the Atlanta Braves. Rosario has the longest active hitting streak by a Nashville player with a hit in each of his last five games.

DON'T CRY BECAUSE IT'S OVER: After an 0-for-3 day at the plate, Anthony Seigler saw his 16-game hitting streak come to an end. It was the third-longest streak by a Nashville player over the last three-plus seasons. Estuary Ruiz was the last player to have a 17-game hitting streak for Nashville when he did it from August 10-28, 2022. Seigler posted five multi-hit games during his 16-game streak that began on May 2nd, including his single-game career-high four hits that he had in Wednesday night's win.

HAMMER AND NEL: Raynel Delgado had his 11th multi-hit game of the season on Thursday, tying Jared Oliva for the most on the team in 2025. Seven of those 11 multi-hit games have come in the month of May for Delgado who is hitting .316 (25-for-79) with five doubles, a triple, 14 RBI, and seven runs scored in his 23 games played this month.

RISPY BUSINESS: Following their 2-for-9 with RISP in Friday's loss, the Sounds are hitting .246 as a team and rank 15th in the International League. Memphis leads the league hitting with RISP, hitting .297 and have 51 XBH with RISP compared to the Sounds 30.

ELVIS IN THE BUILDING: RHP Elvis Peguero earned his second save of the season and struck out all three Indianapolis batters he faced in the bottom of the ninth inning on Wednesday night. The right-hander has now pitched seven straight games with Nashville without allowing an earned run dating back to April 24th. Over the span he has allowed three hits in 8.0 IP with nine strikeouts. Eight of the nine appearances he has for the Sounds this season have come without an earned run charged to him. His three strikeouts are tied for the most he has had in a game with Nashville so far this year.

- Selected by the Brewers out of Crowder Junior College (Crowder, MO) where he posted a 10-0 record and 2.72 ERA in 76.0 IP during his redshirt freshman season.
- Currently ranked as the no. 4 prospect in the Brewers' Top 30 (MLB Pipeline) and no. 72 overall in the MLB Pipeline Top 100.**
- After having his senior season in high school wiped out during COVID, torn his meniscus during his first college start at Crowder.
- Finished third in NJCAA Division I with 136 strikeouts during the 2022 season and was named Second-Team All-American...Had a scholarship offer to LSU but decided to sign with the Brewers after being selected 63rd overall and above slot value at \$2.35 million..Became the highest-drafted player out of Crowder, surpassing current Brewers pitcher Aaron Ashby (4th Round, 2018).
- Worked his way through three levels of the Brewers system in his first full season in 2023...Combined to go 4-2 with a 3.41 ERA in 20 starts and had 110 K in 71.1 IP.
- Was selected to the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game in 2023 and struck out the side during his lone inning.
- Named Pitcher of the Week in the Carolina League and Southern League during the 2023 season as well as being named Brewers MiLB Pitcher of the Month in May.
- Led the Brewers farm system in strikeouts (105) and BAA (.182) and was third in ERA (3.50) and WHIP (1.20) after his final start with Double-A Biloxi before his promotion to Triple-A on July 28, 2024.
- After starting his first 41 professional games, was made two planned short starts with the Sounds before moving to the bullpen in an attempt to limit innings on his arm.
- Ended the 2024 season with the fourth-most strikeouts in the farm system (127) and eighth-most IP (97.1) and posted a .167 BAA in 33 G (21 GS).
- Has won International League Pitcher of the Week twice already in 2025...Seven career POTW awards.**
