FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game road series tonight against the Biloxi Shuckers, the Double-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Rocket City is coming off a 2-1 home series win over Columbus (July 18-20). This marks the second and final meeting between the two clubs this season, with the Trash Pandas having taken four of six from the Shuckers at Toyota Field earlier this year (May 27-June 1). After the trip to the Mississippi Gulf Coast, Rocket City returns home to close out July with a six-game homestand against Birmingham, running July 29-August 3.

PANDAS SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER BEHIND STRONG STARTS FROM ALDEGHERI, KLASSEN: The Rocket City Trash Pandas split a Thursday doubleheader with the Biloxi Shuckers, winning Game 1, 5-1, before dropping Game 2, 3-1. Sam Aldegheri delivered a strong outing in the opener, allowing just one unearned run over six innings, while Denzer Guzman and Nelson Rada paced the offense. In the nightcap, Oscar Colas tied the game with a solo homer, but a late two-run shot by Biloxi's Ethan Murray proved the difference. George Klassen tossed a complete game in the loss, allowing just four hits and striking out six.

CLOSING IN ON THE CENTURY MARK: Today's starter, Mitch Farris is just three strikeouts away from becoming the seventh pitcher in Trash Pandas history to reach 100 strikeouts in a single season. He currently ranks fourth in the Southern League with 97 strikeouts across his first 17 outings (16 starts) in 2025. The league leader is Montgomery's Brody Hopkins, who sits at 99. The single-season franchise record belongs to Caden Dana, who tallied 147 strikeouts in 2024...

**DID YOU ORDER SOME HITS?:** The Trash Pandas are 5-4 over their last nine games, highlighted by a fourgame win streak from July 12-20. During this stretch, they've posted .286 batting average, which ranks second in Double-A (behind only Birmingham at .297) and racked up 81 hits—an average of 9.0 per game, which is third in Double-A

ROCKET CITY IS LIVING UP TO ITS NAME: Since July 3, the Trash Pandas have launched 17 home runs over 16 games, leading the Southern League and ranking tied for third in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch includes a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. Prior to that, Rocket City had hit 53 home runs over 76 games—an average of just 0.7 per game. The recent surge has seen that average jump to 1.1 per game, fueled by **Oscar Colás** and **Ben Gobbel**, who have combined for 10 of the 17 homers. Colás leads the league in that span with six, while Gobbel is right behind with four.

SPICY BACK TO THE BIGS: Veteran reliever José "Spicy" Quijada had his contract selected by the Angels on Thursday. In his 2025 debut with the Halos, he struck out the side during the fifth inning, and walked one over the 1.0 inning of work. The lefty had been lights-out since June 27, tossing 9.0 scoreless innings over his last nine appearances. During that stretch, he's gone 2-0 with 12 strikeouts, just three walks, and a stingy .194 opponent batting average.

"YOU CAN'T SCORE IF YOU DON'T GET ON BASE.": Four Trash Pandas enter Friday's game riding on-base streaks of five games or more, led by Nelson Rada, who's reached in 13 straight. Myles Emmerson and Denzer Guzman have each reached safely in five consecutive games, while Sam Brown has reached in nine of his last ten. Guzman has also been consistent over the long haul, getting on base in 18 of his last 20 games, while **Travis Blankenhorn** has reached in 18 of 21, and **David Mershon** in 14 of his last 15.

GUZ GONE WILD: DENZER'S BLAZING THROUGH JULY: The San Pedro de Macorís native leads the Southern League and all of Double-A with a 1.113 OPS in July, and batting .349. He also tops the league—and is tied for first in Double-A—with eight doubles this month, and ranks tied for third in RBIs with 16. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second 5-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs.. He now ranks among league leaders in several offensive categories in 2025, including doubles (2nd, 22), extra-base hits (2nd, 34), RBIs (T-5th, 51), total bases (5th, 133), home runs (T-6th, 11), and slugging (8th, .424), and OPS (10th, .757). Guzman leads the team with 15 multi-RBI games.

SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 18 of his last 21 games, and 26 of 31 since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder ranks fourth the Southern League with a .913 OPS, while batting .266 with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 16 walks over that span. During the June 24–29 series at Montgomery, Blankenhorn went 7-for-25 with a double, five home runs, nine RBIs, and a 1.360 OPS. He also became just the fifth Trash Panda to homer in three straight games, doing so from June 22-25

COLÁS CLEANING UP FOR PANDAS: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás leads Double-A with six home runs in his last 15 games since July 3, along with two doubles, 14 RBIs, nine runs scored, a .273 batting average, and a .913 OPS (second in the Southern League). On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. This marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being **Orlando Martinez's** performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.

RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, the youngest player in the Southern League at just 19 years and 11 months, ranks second in the league and T-4th in all of Double-A with 33 stolen bases this season—19 of which came ranks second in the league and 1-4th in act or budgle-A with 30 stater bases this season-17 or which came in a blistering month of May. His 33 steals already rank third in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and **Kyren Parris'** franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada **ranks among the league leaders** in **stolen bases** (2nd, 31), **OBP** (6th, .387), **batting average** (6th, .282), and **hits** (1-8th, 85). Rada has recorded a team-best 24 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.

ROCKET CITY BRINGS THE ATTENDANCE BOOM: Despite the addition of two brand-new ballparks in Columbus and Knoxville, the Trash Pandas continue to lead the Southern League in attendance, averaging 4,434 fans per game, inlouding an average of 4,911 in July. Rocket City has topped the league in average attendance every season since 2021—a testament to the club's strong fan support and game-day experience.

#### ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best. 4.44 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ('24), OF Kyren Paris (' 23), C Edgar Quero (' 23), RHP Ky Bush (' 22), and LHP Reid Detmers ('21).
- **BEN JAMMIN':** INF **Ben Gobbel** has belted four home runs in his last 14 games, including his second career multi-homer performance on July 8 at Chattanooga—the first also came against the Lookouts on June 6, 2024, at Toyota Field. Since rejoining the Trash Pandas on June 17, the Georgia native is batting .267, a notable improvement from his .228 average over 68 games with Rocket City last season.
- KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On July 3, INF Chad Stevens made his MLB debut for the Angels, becoming the seventh this season, and 43rd all-time Trash Panda to make their MLB debut. In 17 games for Rocket City in 2024, he hit .316 with two homers, 10 RBIs, and two stolen bases over 17 games. He joins former Pandas, Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.
- NEW HALF, NEW TRASH PANDAS: In June, the Trash Pandas had 25 roster moves impact the roster, with 10 moves coming on June 17. Only 17 of the current 28-man roster were active on May 19. Newcomers joining the club in June include OF Oscar Colás (6/3), 18 Evan Edwards (6/3), INF David Mershon (6/17), INF Ben Gobbel (6/17), LHP A.J. Block (6/17), RHP Sam Ryan (6/17), while OFTravis Blankenhorn (IL, 6/7), C Jaxx Groshans (Dev. List, 6/24) and RHP George Klassen (IL, 6/1) have been reinstated from the IL, or Dev. List.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Dixie Association".
- PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 11 prospects and eight of the top 20 in MLB Pipeline's newest prospect rankings released on July 22; included in the top 11 are RHP George Klassen (3), OF Nelson Rada (6), LHP Sam Aldegheri (8), and INF Denzer Guzman (11). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP Samy Natera Jr. (16), RHP Walbert Ureña (17), RHP Joel Hurtado (19), and RHP Camden Minacci (20).
- THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF Nelson Rada is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.9 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the league born in 2005. INF Denzer Guzman is the eighth-youngest at 21 years old (2/8/04), and RHP Walbert Urena is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04, 21 years old (1/25/04).
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.
- MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, Sam Brown finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and Nelson Rada finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in MiLB with 19 stolen bases.
- ANOTHER WALK-OFF AT TOYOTA FIELD: The June 11th walk-off single in the 10th inning by Cole Fontenelle was the second of the season for the Trash Pandas. This was the first walk-off since Denzer Guzman hit a walk-off homer in the ninth inning on April 5 against Chattanooga. Overall, it marked the 24th walk-off victory for the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field.
- MLB EXPERIENCE: The Tash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. Sam Aldegheri made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. Kelvin Cáceres made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. Jesus Cruz made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals ('20) and Braves ('22). Jordan Holloway made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Marlins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. Sean Poppen made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. José Quijada made his MLB debut for the Martins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is Travis Blankenhorn, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.
- FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.
