Team Stats

On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils hit the road and begin a six-game series at the Akron Rubber Ducks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the seventh-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and first-of-six at Canal Park. The Rubber Ducks took four-of-six from Reading at FirstEnergy Stadium from July 9-14, and currently lead the season-series 4-2. This is Reading's first trip to Akron since Apr. 12-16, of the 2022 season.

Series Finale

The Fightin Phils dropped the series finale to Hartford 7-1 on Sunday, and also dropped the series four games to two. The Yard Goats scored one run off Reading Starter Eiberson Castellano in the fourth, but otherwise Castellano was solid over five innings, with six strikeouts. Reading tied the game at one in the fifth when Erick Brito doubled home Ethan Wilson. Hartford broke it open though with a run in the top of the seventh and then scored five in the top of the ninth off Andrew Schultz and Wesley Moore to put the game away and clinch the series.

Stolen Base Nugger

The Fightin Phils stole a season-high nine stolen bases in their win on July 23 at New Hampshire. It was the first time that Reading stole nine bases in a game since Aug. 2, 2003, when the R-Phils stole nine in a 7-1 win at Trenton.

Wilson's Week

Ethan Wilson turned in another impressive week against the Hartford Yard Goats. Over the past week, Wilson appeared in four games and slahed .417/.500/1.083, with a 1.583 OPS. He added three runs, two doubles, two homers and four RBI, while striking out just twice in 14 plate appearances.

Crawford's Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Propsect Justin Crawford has been on a roll since making his Double-A debut on July 19 at Portland. Over 11 games since then, Crawford is slashing .326/.380/.413, with a .793 OPS. Crawford's added five runs, four doubles, four RBI and six stolen bases over that stretch as well.

Double Trouble

Since the conclusion of the All-Star Break on July 19, the Fightin Phils have turned 20 double plays, which is the most in the Eastern League over that stretch. Heading into action on July 19, Reading ranked last in the Eastern League in double plays turned at 46, but just 15 games later, the Fightin Phils now rank ninth in the Eastern League with 65 double plays.

Taylor's Roll

Carson Taylor posted a strong week against Hartford. He slashed .417/.619/.667, with a 1.286 OPS. He added a run scored, a homer and three RBI. He also walked eight times on the week, which was the most walks in the Eastern League last week. Taylor now ranks third in the league with 49 walks this season. Taylor also ranks fifth in the league in batting average (.290), T-6th HR (14), 2nd RBI (63), 2nd OBP (.399), 1st SLG (.509) and 1st OPS (.908).

Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils currently sit second in the Eastern League in home runs hit at 110 this season, which trails first-place Somerset by two. Since June 1, Reading has hit the most home runs in the Eastern League with 68, which leads second place Somerset by seven. The R-Phils have also hit 78 home runs over 57 home games this season (1.4/game), which is the most in Double-A by 15. Reading's 78 home runs at home also ranks tied for seventh in all of Minor League Baseball.

The Ducks

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with a 22-11 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently split a six-game series with Harrisburg at FNB Field. Following this week, Akron heads to Erie. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (13), Petey Halpin (14), Parker Messick (20), CJ Kayfus (25) and Dayan Frias (26).

Duck on the Bump

Lefty, and Guardians No. 20 Prospect, Parker Messick makes the start tonight for Akron. This is Messick's eight appearance (seventh starts) for Akron, and he's 3-1, with a 2.54 ERA (28.1 IP, 20 H, 9 BB, 39 SO). Messick last pitched August 1 at Harrisburg, but only went one inning. He allowed one run on one hit, with a strikeout in a no-decision. Messick was promoted from High-A Lake County on June 22, after going 5-5, with a 3.57 ERA over 13 starts for the Captains. He split 2023 between Single-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County in 2023, and Messick combined to go 5-6, with a 3.77 ERA over 26 games and 24 starts. The Guardians drafted the 23-year olf in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Florida State. Messick pitched for the Seminoles from 2020-22.
