### TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Reno are set to play in game three of the series on Thursday night. Express RHP Seth Nordlin is slated to start against Aces LHP Blake Walston. First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CT.

### SHUTOUT WIN AT HOME

The Express took game two 8-0 over the Aces on Wednesday. Round Rock got on the board to take the lead in the second inning after 1B Dustin Harris tripled in RF Elier Hernandez, who had drawn a walk. In the following inning, DH Bubba Thompson and CF J.P. Martinez each drew walks and were on base for a two-out home run from SS Davis Wendzel that extended the E-Train lead to four. The E-Train saw more two-out magic in the fourth after Thompson drew a walk, stole second base and scored on a single from Martinez. With the bases loaded, Aces 3B Phillip Evans committed his second error of the inning, which allowed Wendzel to reach base as two more runners scored to put the home team up 7-0. In the seventh, Harris doubled and scored after back-to-back ground outs allowed him to advance and increase the lead to 8-0. Express RHP Edwar Colina pitched a hitless ninth inning to lock in the 8-0 victory.

### NORDLIN GETS THE NOD

Express RHP Seth Nordlin is slated to take the mound in game three. In two starts, Nordlin owns a 6.75 ERA (6 ER/8.0 IP) for the E-Train. In his last appearance on July 14, Nordlin went 4.0 innings and allowed two earned runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts. He has appeared in 20 games at Double-A this year.

### ANOTHER SHUTOUT AT HOME

Reno was shut out for the third time this season while the Express got their fourth shutout of the year yesterday. Three of those have come at home for Round Rock. Eight runs are the most the E-Train have scored in a shutout this season. The four shutouts are the second-most in the Pacific Coast League behind Oklahoma City (5).

### L'S DON'T LAST LONG

Since June 1, Round Rock has lost 10 games and has not lost back-to-back games at home since May 17-18. In their last 10 losses, the Express have averaged 7.3 runs per game the following night. Since June 1, they are 8-2 after a loss.

### PITCHERS BACK IN BUSINESS

Last night, the pitching staff struck out every Reno batter at least once and compiled 12 total strikeouts in the win. RHP Yerry Rodriguez tossed a season-high 3.0 innings and recorded five strikeouts against the Aces in his first start of the season. In 14 games in July, the E-Train pitching staff has held opponents to four or fewer hits in seven games. With only two hits allowed last night, the staff has given up 84 hits in the month of July which is the fewest in all of Triple-A. The next closest team, the Buffalo Bisons, have allowed 96 hits.

### OFFENSIVE UPDATES

Last night, Express SS Jonathan Ornelas saw his 12-game hit streak come to an end after he went 0-for-4. RF Elier Hernandez broke the tie with Aces INF Phillip Evans for most hits in the PCL (98) after tallying a hit in last night's win while Evans went hitless.

### ACES OFF THE BASES

The Reno Aces have four players among the top eight batting averages in the Pacific Coast League in Phillip Evans (.346), Diego Castillo (.344), Buddy Kennedy (.330) and PJ Higgins (.317). In the first two games of this series, this quartet of hitters has gone 2-for-17 against the E-Train pitching staff. Evans (.459), Kennedy (.459) and Castillo (.448) also have three of the four highest on-base percentage in the PCL and have combined to reach

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

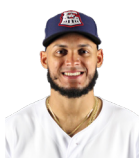
