MAY DAY: After dropping game two of this six-game series yesterday against the Wood Ducks, the FredNats will try to get back into the win column tonight against Down East behind RHP Jose Atencio, who has been one of the best pitchers in the Carolina League this year. Atencio joined the rotation two weeks ago after a couple injuries to FredNat starting pitchers, and has excelled. He pitched 17 2/3 innings in April, allowing just four runs with 21 strikeouts and zero walks, which is the best in the Carolina League. He faces off against Down East lefty Kohl Drake, who has had a similarly impressive start to the season, allowing just six hits and one run in 8 1/3 innings with 13 strikeouts and just two walks.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wood Ducks got back to the .500 mark with a 6-3 Education Day win over the FredNats. Travis Sykora made his pro debut on the mound for FXBG, pitching two innings and allowing two earned runs with three strikeouts. Elijah Green homered for the second straight day for the first time in his career, but ultimately the FredNats only managed three hits against Down East pitching in the loss.

APRIL RECAP: The FredNats ripped off 15 wins in the month of April to start the year, second most in the league and more than any other month in the entire 2023 season. Fredericksburg led the Carolina League with 139 runs scored, and also led the league in run differential with +50. Fredericksburg's three shutouts on the mound is also the most in the Carolina League, and have won two extra inning games in a row heading into the month of May.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel's 33 RBIs through the first 23 games of the season is tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Pimentel is tied with Clay Dungen of the Triple-A El Paso Chihuahuas, and Dungen has played six more games this year. Pimentel has at least one RBI in nine of his last 12 games, and has driven in multiple runs in seven of those games. He's hit two grand slams this year as well, which has only been done by one other player in the Majors or full-season Minors this season.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are a perfect 11-0 this season when scoring first, including all five wins in last week's series against Delmarva and Tuesday's game against the Wood Ducks. 12 of Fredericksburg's 15 wins have come against the North Division of the Carolina League as well.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in the Carolina League. In 117 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 34 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.62. The Freddies are also 7/8 in save opportunities (four by Thomas Schultz, one by Kevin Rodriguez, one by Samuel Vasquez and one by Mason Denaburg), and the team is 11-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 13-0 when leading after eight innings this year.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 156-128 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jose Atencio is set to make his fifth appearance and third start of 2024, coming off his best outing of the season against the Shorebirds. Last week, Atencio blanked Delmarva for five innings, marking the second straight outing in which he completed five frames. Atencio scattered six base hits, but did not walk a batter and struck out five 'Birds.

A YEAR AGO: Jose proved to be one of the most important pitchers for Fredericksburg last season, as he seamlessly toggled between the starting rotation and the bullpen. He was most effective as a starter (7 GS) as he went at least four innings in each start, did not allow an ER in three of his outings, and never allowed more than four earned runs.

DEEP IN HIS BAG: Atencio may not feature a triple digit fastball, but he utilizes a true five-pitch arsenal to keep opposing hitters off balance. Featuring three different fastballs and breaking balls darting in all directions, Atencio has made a living off missing barrels.

GETTING TO FXBG: Atencio breezed through the FCL in 2022, earning himself a mid-July promotion to Fredericksburg where he did not miss a beat. The Venezuelan-born right hander worked five innings in his FXBG introduction, allowing just two runs against Salem in a FredNats win. That was a sign of things to come, as Atencio did not allow more than three earned runs in seven of his eight starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Last week, Atencio blanked Delmarva for five innings, marking the second straight outing in which he completed five frames. Atencio scattered six base hits, but did not walk a batter and struck out five 'Birds.
