## "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**MCCUSKER GOES YARD TWICE AS SAINTS TAKE TUESDAY OPENER:** St. Paul Saints outfielder Carson McCusker continued his torrid start to the season with his second multi-homer game of the year, including crushing a two-run go-ahead blast to break a 1-1 tie in the sixth in an eventual 6-2 St. Paul victory over Buffalo. McCusker's game-winning homer came off the bat at 114.7 mph, the hardest-hit ball by a Saint this year, and carried 426-feet, the longest round-tripper of the season, and bounded off the back of the Cub-a-Cabana lawn in left field. He followed that up with an insurance blast in the eighth, his team-leading 9th of the season, in his next at-bat, a solo shot that followed Mickey Gasper's home run two batters previously. The three longballs backed a strong outing from David Festa, who left the game with a 1-0 lead after 5.2 innings and striking out 7 with just three hits allowed. His one-out double turned into the game's tying run when Travis Adams gave up an RBI single to the first man he faced, Joey Loperfido. The Saints wasted no time taking a lead in the Top 1st. In his first game back from an IL stint with a hamstring strain, Austin Martin singled to extend a six-game hit streak, but came up limp as he scored on a delayed double steal coming home, and exited the game.

**MCCUSKER MCCRUSHING:** Recently named the Twins minor league player of the month for March/April, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). Tuesday night marked his ninth career multi-homer game as a pro (his fifth as a member of the Twins org). On one swing on Tuesday night, he simultaneously tagged the Saints' hardest-hit ball (114.7 mph) and the longest home run of the season (426 feet), a go-ahead, two-run blast in the sixth vs Buffalo. McCusker now has the two hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including two batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history (see below). The 6-8 slugger is one of seven hitters in the minors with at least 9 homers this year and has already tied Junior Severino in 2024 for the most home runs in Saints history by the end of May (Severino had 9 at the end of May last season and went on to tie the Saints franchise record with 21 by the end of the year). The Sparks, Nevada native is also currently in the midst of a 9-game hitting streak, the longest by a St. Paul bat so far this year and 2 games shy of his career-high of 11, a stretch he established from May 26-June 7, 2023 in indy ball.

**SAVE SOME FOR TOMORROW:** The ups and downs of the St. Paul offense have continued in the past couple weeks with the Saints scoring as many as 16 runs in the opener of their last homestand, while also being shutout for the fourth time this season in game one of a doubleheader. The Saints now rank 12th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.6/game entering play on Tuesday. The Saints' low run-scoring rate is despite the team ranking 5th in team batting average (.262) and 4th in OPS (.778). In their 16 wins, the Saints have scored 97 runs (an average of 6.1/game) while in their 14 losses, they've scored just 31 (2.2/game). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been due to hitting with runners in scoring position. They now rank 7th in the International League with a .276 average (76-275) w/ RISP. In their 16 wins, St. Paul are hitting .337 (60-178) situationally and just .165 (16-97) in their 14 losses.

**BUILT FORD TOUGH:** Mike Ford is coming off a road trip in Columbus in which he went yard three times in five games to help the Saints to their first-ever series victory at Huntington Park. He went 7-for-16 in the series and has now hit safely in eight straight dating back to April 26, a stretch where he is hitting .400 (10-25), 3 HR, 8 RBI, 5 BB. It mark's Ford's longest hit streak since he collected a knock in 11-in-a-row from July 3-July 17, 2021 with the Durham Bulls (TB). The longest hit streak of his career was a 12-gamer from July 12-August 18, 2014 with the Charleston RiverDogs in A-ball.

**STRAIGHT GAS:** The Saints pitching staff rank as the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season with an average pitch velocity of 89.4 mph that ranks as a harder throwing staff than 21 Major League teams. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 10th in the IL in K-rate (25.2%) and 8th in whiff-rate (29.1%). By average velocity on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks 1-8th in Triple-A (92.6). Jacob Bosikovic (96.9, 16th), Ryan Jensen (96.8, 17th) and Alex Speas (96.5, 21st) are all top-25 in the Triple-A circuit in average fastball velo among arms with at least 100 pitches thrown.

**THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY:** The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America while also touting four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's Top-100 list.

**TWINS REPORT:** The Minnesota Twins (16-20) have won three straight after taking the homestand opener 9-1 over Baltimore last night at Target Field. The Twins hung five runs on Orioles starter Cade Povich in the third and never looked back. Carlos Correa (2) and Byron Buxton (8) each homered in the win. Royce Lewis and Willie Castro combined to go 1-for-7 in their first games back off the IL. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (15-13) have lost four straight after dropping a 5-4 game in the series opener last night at NW Arkansas. High-A Cedar Rapids (18-9) have won 7 of their last 8 with an 8-0 shutout win in Beloit yesterday. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaelen Culppepper has hit safely in all five games in May for the Kernels, a stretch where he's 9-for-22 (.409) incl. a homer. Twins No. 14 prospect Billy Amick ranked top-5 in the Midwest League in hitting (.342) and OPS (.922) before being placed on the 7-day IL with a left oblique strain last Friday, becoming the fifth Twins top-15 prospect to hit the shelf this season. Low-A Fort Myers are 15-13 to start this season. 22-year-old right-hander Alejandro Hidalgo ranks second in the organization in strikeouts, having fanned 29 of 88 batters faced (33%) despite a 6.00 ERA.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Started Wednesday night in Columbus and got off to a rocky start, allowing four runs in the first two innings, including allowing leadoff doubles to the leadoff batter in the first two frames. Settled in to retire seven of the last eight he faced, including five straight to end the night, to complete four innings. Threw 17 cutters, 15 changeups, 14 curveballs, 13 sweepers, 12 four-seamers, and 8 sinkers. Induced just four swings-and-misses on the night. Recorded three of his five strikeouts on the curveball, one on the four-seam, and one on the sweeper.

**ON THE FAST TRACK:** In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

**BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS:** Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

**LET'S GET FUNKY:** Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in [last year's mid-season report](#) that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

**MAD MORRIS:** Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but real it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."
