**Last Game:** The Delmarva Shorebirds earned their first home victory of the season on Thursday, defeating the Augusta GreenJackets 7-2. After falling behind 2-0 after the first two innings, the Shorebirds roared back in the third, with **Stiven Martinez** getting Delmarva on the board with an RBI double. Martinez scored moments later on a run-scoring single by **DJ Layton**, tying the game at two. **Joshua Liranzo** put Delmarva in front with a two-run double, making it 4-2. **Edwin Amparo** concluded the inning with an RBI single, giving the Shorebirds a 5-2 lead. The Shorebirds had seven straight base runners and six consecutive hits in that inning. **Kiefer Lord** led the way on the mound with a career performance, striking out a personal-best ten batters over 3.2 innings. Add-on runs in the fourth and eighth, plus shutout baseball from **Todd Kniebbe** and **Denton Biller** over the final 5.1 innings, secured a 7-2 win for Delmarva.

**Here Comes the Boom:** The Delmarva Shorebirds have started the season strong offensively, scoring 33 runs on 52 hits in their first six games. The team hit their first three home runs of the season when **Joshua Liranzo**, **Stiven Martinez**, and **Jordan Sanchez** all went yard in the home opener on Tuesday against Augusta. Liranzo has established himself as Delmarva's best run producer early in the season, with a league-high 7 RBIs through his first five games. The Shorebirds' offense currently ranks second in the league in both team batting average (.257) and slugging percentage (.371).

**Self Inflicted Wounds:** The Shorebirds' defense has struggled to start the year, committing 13 errors that have led to 13 unearned runs—both the most in the league. Delmarva pitchers have also struggled to control the zone early in the season, allowing a league-high 42 walks, including 20 in the first three games of this series against Augusta.

**Praise the Lord:** **Kiefer Lord** put together the best start of his young career on Thursday, April 9, against Augusta, striking out a career-high 10 batters in 3.2 innings while walking none. His effort on the mound led the Shorebirds to a season-high 15 strikeouts as a staff, and his 10 strikeouts were the most by a Delmarva pitcher since Chase Allsup did it twice for the Shorebirds last season, most recently on August 9, 2025, against Fayetteville.

**Hits in Bunches:** The Shorebirds' offense has received notable contributions from **Félix Amparo**, who has three multi-hit games. **Cobb Hightower** had a three-hit performance on opening night and leads the team with a .438 batting average. **DJ Layton** has been a regular on base, reaching safely nine times in 17 plate appearances over his first four starts. He also leads the team in on-base percentage at .529, which is the fourth-best mark in the league.

**Sloan and Steady:** **Braeden Sloan** has started the season as one of Delmarva's dominant arms out of the bullpen. The 17th-round pick from last season's draft out of TCU has retired the first eight batters and struck out seven of them. That includes a perfect, two-innings of relief against Augusta on April 8, where he struck out five of six batters he faced, thanks to his dominant change-up.

**About the GreenJackets:** The Shorebirds open Perdue Stadium by hosting the Augusta GreenJackets, the Single-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves. This will be the first of two series against Augusta, as the Shorebirds will make their first trip to SRP Park since 2022 in June. The GreenJackets have a prospect-rich roster with seven Top-30 prospects for the Braves, led by Atlanta's top two draft picks from 2025, **Tate Southisene** and **Alex Lodise**.
