### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express opens its third series of the season against the Sugar Land Skeeters on Thursday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Drew Anderson is scheduled to get the start against Skeeters RHP Austin Pruitt. First pitch in Round Rock is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

### LAST TIME OUT

The El Paso Chihuahuas topped the Round Rock Express by a final score of 2-1 in Tuesday night's series finale at Southwest University Park. The E-Train scored in the first inning as LF Delino DeShields hit a leadoff single before moving to second on a Chihuahuas error then third on a Ryan Dorow groundout. A wild pitch by El Paso RHP Chase Johnson allowed DeShields to race home. The Chihuahuas plated their first run in the fourth. SS Pedro Florimón led off with a single before advancing to second then third on consecutive Round Rock throwing errors before a third error later in the inning allowed him to score. With the contest knotted at 1-1, El Paso scored the game-winning run in the eighth as LF Tucupita Marcano drew a walk then 2B Matthew Batten singled before Marcano found home on a Brian O'Grady groundball double play. El Paso RHP James Norwood threw a perfect 1-2-3 ninth inning of relief to collect his first save of the season and cement the 2-1 final.

### ANDERSON WITH THE START

Round Rock RHP Drew Anderson is set to make his 10th E-Train appearance of 2021 in tonight's start. Over seven starts, the righty is tied for the top spot in the Triple-A West League in strikeouts with 55 and is third in ERA with a 3.63 mark (16 ER/39.2 IP).

### THAT'S WILD, WILES

Express RHP Collin Wiles has been beneficial on the mound as both a frequent starter and reliever this season. In his four starts, the righty has amassed a 3.79 ERA (8 ER/19.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts. While throwing in relief, Wiles holds a 3.31 ERA (6 ER/16.1 IP) with 19 K's after 3.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday night in El Paso.

### TEXAS TWO STEP

Before heading into a 12-game homestand, the Round Rock Express hold a 19-17 record when playing contests in the state of Texas, including a 13-11 record at Dell Diamond. Three of the E-Train's four series victories this season have been in the state of Texas.

### ANOTHER SKEETERS SHOWDOWN

The Express and Skeeters face off in a six-game series for the third time in 2021. Round Rock has won each of the two previous sets between the new-found rivals 4-2, one at Dell Diamond and one at Constellation Field. The Express and Skeeters meet two more times this season, August 5-10 and again September 9-14, both in Round Rock.

### FAMILIAR TERRITORY

Twelve members of Sugar Land's roster saw playing time in a Round Rock uniform during the 2019 season when the club was affiliated with the Houston Astros: RHP Bryan Abreu, RHP Ronel Blanco, RHP Riley Ferrell, LHP Ryan Hartman, RHP Josh James, RHP Carson LaRue, RHP Colin McKee, LHP Kit Scheetz, RHP Joe Smith, INF Alex De Goti, INF Taylor Jones and OF Ronnie Dawson.

### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Round Rock knocked out six El Paso runners in Tuesday's contest by turning three double plays, marking the second time during the 2021 season that the E-Train has tallied a trio of double plays in a single game.

## ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

## STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Texas and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine (Bridge City) and INF Jax Biggers (Missouri City) are the lone Texans on the roster. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 23 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez, RHP Dennis Santana and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

## EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
