PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today 27 games over .500 with an overall 82-55 record (.599 winning percentage).

- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .599 winning percentage overall this year is the 9th-best in the Minors ... the Tennessee Smokies (Cubs Double-A are the best team in Minor League Baseball at 85-47 (.644 winning %).
- 82 wins are the 4th-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 6 behind Sugar Land ... Omaha is 1 of 7 Minor League teams with 80+ wins.
- Prior to Saturday's loss, the Chasers had been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- The 2024 Storm Chasers are on pace for 88 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... **this means the 2024 Chasers are 5 wins away from breaking the wins record.**
- The best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

82 of Omaha's 137 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (59%), including 33 of 55 losses in 2024 (60%), with 18 of 55 losses by just one run (33%).

- Omaha is 26-18 in 1-run games this season ... the Chasers have the 5th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron leads the Minors with 32 wins by 1 run.
- Omaha's 38 saves are tied for the International League lead, tied for the 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and rank tied 8th in Minor League Baseball ... **Evan Sisk's** 13 saves overall this year rank 4th in the league ... he has 11 of the team's last 12 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 726 to 607 this season, a +119 run differential.

- A +119 run differential this year ranks as the 2nd-best mark in the International League and 3rd at the Triple-A level, behind Worcester (+122) and Sugar Land (+127).
- Omaha ranks 12th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland Rockhounds lead the Minors in run differential at +171 (650 to 479).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.65 ERA, 1.32 WHIP and .215/.321/.340 opposing slash line ... the .215 opponents' batting average tied for 11th among all 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 39 games this year (11 times in August and already 3 times in 7 September games), roughly one in every 3.51 games in 2024 ... the bullpen also has 20 games without a walk this season, including 11 times in the 2nd half of the season.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 44 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (54%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 17 of the 44 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 7 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 12 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 13 occasions.

BEST OF THE BEST

With the Omaha Storm Chasers having a franchise-best year, the season has also seen several players set new career-bests.

- John Rave** has led the charge of having career year, setting personal bests already in runs (87), hits (119), doubles (29), triples (5) and home runs (20) ... he is also on base for the best average (.261), slugging percentage (.478) and OPS (.826) of his career ... Rave has played in 121 games this season, his career high is 124 last year.
- Cam Devanney** has set a personal best for runs batted in (71) this year, as has **Nate Eaton** (57 RBI) ... Eaton has also tied a career-best in home runs (15) this season ... Eaton's 22 steals are one away from tying his career high of 23 in a season.

TODAY'S START

- Guerrero is making his 2nd start with Omaha, his 23rd overall start this season and 25th appearance in 2024 ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Tyson made 22 appearances for the Naturals (20 starts) before being promoted to Omaha on Monday, August 29.
- In 2024, ranks tied 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in starts (22), 4th in strikeouts (114) and 6th in innings pitched (111.0)... among qualified Royals full-season arms, ranks 2nd in opponents' average (.218), 7th in WHIP (1.26) and 7th in ERA (3.97).
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 28 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 24 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 5 @ MEMPHIS [G2]

Made his second Triple-A start and took his first loss with Omaha, tied a career-worst with 6 walks ... worked around a walk in a scoreless 1st inning, but fell behind in the 2nd, a run scored on 2 walks and a sacrifice fly ... a double play erased a single in the 3rd for a scoreless inning ... three walks in the 4th loaded the bases, a triple scored all 3 runs to break a tie and put Memphis ahead 4-1 ... all 4 runners that scored in the game against Guerrero were batters that reached out walks.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Over his first 14 appearances (12 starts in Double-A, pitched to a 5.88 ERA (37 ER in 56.2 IP) with a 1.48 WHIP and .264 opponents' batting average (.58-for-220) ... over his final 8 starts with the Naturals from July 6 to August 22, worked a 0.99 ERA (6 ER in 45.2 IP) with a 0.85 WHIP and .141 opponents' average (.22-for-156) and 41 strikeouts.
- Threw 6 quality starts with NW Arkansas (AA), including 5 straight between July 27 and August 16, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts in that span.
- Pitched 5 scoreless starts, including 3 straight from July 24 to August 4, part of a career-best 22.0-inning scoreless streak
- Named the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week for his effort the week of August 3-10 ... threw 2 quality starts and 13.0 scoreless innings on the road against the Wichita Wind Surge ... allowed just 3 hits and 3 walks with 11 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent much of the season with Quad Cities (A+) but ended the year at NW Arkansas (AA), combining to pitch in 21 games (20 starts) and go 3-6 with a 3.97 ERA (42 ER in 95.1 IP) with 121 strikeouts between the two levels (11.42 K/9) ... transferred to NWA's Development List on August 29, where he finished the season.
- Ended the year seventh in the Royals system in strikeouts (121) ... among Kansas City's Minor League pitchers with at least 70.0 innings pitched, ranked second in K/9 (11.42), third in K/BB (3.56) and third in opponents' average (.215).
- Led the River Bandits in strikeouts (106) and ranked second on the team in starts (17) and innings pitched (84.1 IP), trailing only Luinder Avila in both categories.
