RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (17-12, 47-46)

Inland Empire 66ers (12-17, 37-57)



RHP Cam Day (2-3, 5.45 ERA) vs. RHP Riley Bauman (1-6, 7.15 ERA)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes complete a six-game road trip tonight, with the final game of a six-game set against the Inland Empire 66ers at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes return home on Tuesday, July 30 to face San Jose.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the last of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the 12th of 12 at San Manuel in 2024. The Quakes are currently 16-7 against the 66ers in 2024 (9-2 here in San Bernardino). Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers.

LAST GAME: Zyhir Hope had four hits and five RBIs in his return to the lineup and the Quakes blew out the 66ers on Saturday night, 11-5 at San Manuel Stadium. Sean Paul Linan (4-2) allowed just one run on two hits over 4.2 innings in relief to earn the win. The victory for Rancho gives them four of five so far and a series win for the second time this year at San Manuel Stadium. Inland Empire starter Andre Sanchez (2-6) gave up five runs in the second and got hit with the loss. Former Quake Imanol Vargas had three hits, including two solo homers. Last night's win for Rancho is their second straight overall and gets them over .500 overall (47-46) for the first time in the second half, as they're also five games over .500 in the second half (17-12) for the first time.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made three roster moves before Friday's game. INF Alexander Albertus was placed on the Injured List, while RHP Eriq Swan and OF Zyhir Hope were both activated from the Injured List. That brings the Rancho roster back to full strength, with 30 active players.

WELCOME BACK HOPE: Zyhir Hope's return to the Rancho lineup was incredible on Saturday, as he went 4-for-5 with a walk in six plate appearances. Hope drove in a season-high five runs and smashed a 445-foot home run (4), his first round-tripper since April 7. Hope has been on the Injured List since April 29, after injuring his right shoulder during an at-bat against Lake Elsinore on April 28. Hope was acquired in a trade with the Chicago Cubs earlier this year and is ranked as the Dodgers' 20th best prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

SERIES WINS: The Quakes won their second series in San Bernardino last night by virtue of taking four of the first five games in the series. The Quakes won their other series at Inland Empire back in April by taking five of six. This is also their third series win of the second-half, after taking four of six over Inland Empire at LoanMart Field to open the second half, as well as five of six at Stockton just two weeks ago.

THE PITCHING: Entering this series, the Quakes and the 66ers have the two worst ERAs in the league, with Rancho at 5.74 and Inland Empire just slightly better at 5.57. The second half of the year has been more brutal to Inland Empire, as they have a league-worst ERA of 6.36 in 24 second-half games, while the Quakes are at 5.86. The root of the cause is walks issued, as these two teams have issued more walks than anyone else in the Cal League in 2024. Rancho has walked a league-high 492 batters in just 771.1 innings. Inland is next with 458 walks in 787.1 innings.

CAM DAY: Cam Day will make his 13th start and 18th appearance of the year, his fifth against the 66ers. In four starts against Inland Empire, he's 0-1 with an 11.40 ERA, allowing 19 runs on 31 hits over just 15 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed three runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on Tuesday against Inland Empire. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

RILEY BAUMAN: Right-hander Riley Bauman makes his 19th start of the year and his fifth against the Quakes. In four starts against Rancho, he's 1-1 with an 8.31 ERA, allowing 16 runs on 22 hits over 17.1 innings. In his last start overall, he allowed six runs on six hits over 3.2 innings in a loss to Rancho on Tuesday night in game one of the series. Bauman was an Angels' 13th-rounder in the 2023 draft out of Abilene Christian University in Abilene, Texas.
