#### **JACKSONVILLE WINS 8-7 IN 10 INNINGS**

Troy Johnston lashed three hits and drove in three runs, including the game-winner on a double in the top of the 10th inning, on Sunday to lead the Jumbo Shrimp to an 8-7 win over the Memphis Redbirds. Seven of the nine Jacksonville hitters in the order logged at least one hit, including Jacob Berry, who smashed a three-run home run for his first shot of the season. The Jumbo Shrimp plated their biggest inning to this point of the season - a six-run third inning in which they bashed seven hits in total, Janson Junk came out of the bullpen and logged 4.2 innings of onerun ball in the win.

#### FOUR SOUARE

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester, swept the Charlotte Knights and then split a six-game set at Memphis. Thus, with three series victories and a split, this marks just the first time since at least 2005 that Jacksonville started a season with at least four non-losing series'. Jacksonville's 15-6 record to begin the 2025 campaign is their best start to a season since at least 2005.

#### APRIL COME SHE WILL

With a 15-6 (.714) record, the Jumbo Shrimp already posses the most wins of any team in Minor League Baseball. With eight games to play in April, the 15 wins Jacksonville has accumulated through March and April are just one off a club record (2005-present) for most victories over the months of March and April. The 2024 Jumbo Shrimp went 16-12 (.571) in March and April before plunging to an 8-19 (.296) during the month of May.

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just nine times in 21 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.53 ERA, the best mark in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks second in the level in batting average against (.190), seventh in strikeouts (112) and tied for seventh in fewest hits allowed (71). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 103.0 innings through 21 games (4.9 per game), fourth-most in Triple-A.

#### BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 80.2 innings thus far through the season's first 21 games, a rate of just 3.8 per contest and tied for the 12th-fewest in Triple-A. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective: Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have issued just 23 walks, tied for the fewest in Triple-A. The club's starters also rank fifth in batting average against (.226), sixth in ERA (3.35), tied for sixth in fewest hits allowed (67) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (91). Interestingly, Jacksonville starting pitching has the sixth-lowest groundout-to-airout rate at 0.83.

#### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener. Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 12 of their last 18 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp set a club record (2005-present) with seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte, and has also recorded two other games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester, April 9 vs. Charlotte), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently ranks second in the minor leagues with 53 stolen bases; in Triple-A, second-place Nashville's 43 steals are as close to fourth place (Omaha; 33) as they are to the Jumbo Shrimp.

#### **HELLO, OLD FRIENDS**

The Gwinnett Stripers are a familiar foe to the Jumbo Shrimp, with the two clubs having faced off 76 times since Jacksonville rejoined Triple-A in 2021. This year's take on the rivalry features many familiar faces to Jacksonville playing on the Gwinnett side; seven different Stripers have spent time in a Jacksonville uniform. Six of those players, Eddy Alvarez (2019, 2021), Garrett Cooper (2021, 2023), Bryan De La Cruz (2022), José Devers (2021, 2024), Charles Leblanc (2022-23) and Zach Thompson (2021) spent time in Jacksonville during the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present). Jake Marisnick was a member of the 2013 Jacksonville Suns.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has held at least share of first place for the last 10 days... Jakob Marsee leads the IL in steals (14) while placing tied for fourth in walks (16)... Maximo Acosta places third in stolen bases (10) and tied for sixth in walks (15).

#### **ABOUT ROBINSON**

-A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.

-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.

-Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a 4.79 ERA (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .279/.329/.487/.816 against Piña. Those figures dropped to .245/.285/.431/.716 with runners on and .217/.246/.433/.679 with runners in scoring position.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Piña posted fairly similar platoon splits, actually faring slightly better against left-handed hitting (.225/.338/.318/.656 in 213 plate appearances). Right-handed hitters batted .242/.351/.320/.671 against him over 210 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, Piña held opponents to a .205/.323/.274/.597 line in 219 plate appearances. With runners on, however, that swelled to .267/.369/.373/.742 over 205 plate appearances.
