LAST GAME

The Baysox cruised to a 6-1 victory over the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Saturday evening. It was another dominant start for left-hander Cade Povich against the Flying Squirrels, as the southpaw went five innings, allowing a run on two hits and two walks, while striking out nine. The only damage yielded by Povich was a Victor Bericoto solo home run in the fifth, but by then, Bowie had already built a 6-0 edge. The Baysox started early, as Joseph Rosa singled home Greg Cullen in the second, before Billy Cook later cleared the bases in the frame on a double to give the Baysox a 4-0 edge in what was a 42-pitch frame for Richmond starter Ryan Murphy. Greg Cullen padded the lead with a two-run single in the top half of the fifth, with right-handers Houston Roth (2 IP), Nolan Hoffman (1 IP), and Nick Richmond (1 IP) all contributed scoreless relief efforts for Bowie.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter the series with an overall record of 41-39. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond leads the way in the Southwest division second half standings with an 8-3 start out of the gates. The Flying Squirrels hold the best ERA as a staff in the Eastern League (3.65) and have made the fourth-fewest errors defensively (59), after making seven already this week. Richmond's roster includes nine of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaughn Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenand (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Carson Seymour is set to receive the ball for the series finale. Seymour also started the series opener for the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday, where he went 3.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on a two-run home run to Baysox catcher Tim Susnara. The right-hander walked three and struck out six in his outing, firing 71 pitches in the process. Seymour now owns a 4.35 ERA against Bowie this season (5 ER in 10.1 IP across three starts). He has allowed a home run in consecutive starts, after only allowing one all season prior, back in April. The No. 17 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Seymour is originally a 6th round pick of the Mets in 2021, but was traded over to the Giants this past August in the Darin Ruf deal. Seymour was drafted out of Kansas State University, where he pitched for two seasons after one season at Dartmouth. He only pitched 84.2 innings through his whole collegiate career due to transfer rules and the COVID-19 cancellation for the 2020 season. Seymour's fastball can climb as high as 99 mph, partnered with a turbo sinker in the mid-90s, along with a high-80s slider/cutter, high-80s changeup, and an inconsistent low-80s curveball.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo's 49 extra-base hits on the season are the most in Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 78 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also leads the Double-A level in doubles (30), OPS (1.036) and slugging (.609) on the campaign. Mayo has demolished Richmond pitching this season, posting an average of .333 with seven doubles, a triple, and three home runs against the Flying Squirrels. He has been held to a 3-for-15 week thus far, but also has four walks and a pair of stolen bases. Mayo was named Eastern League Player of the Month on Thursday, after hitting .340 with an 1.178 OPS, 10 doubles, and eight home runs.

STAY HOT, SERVIDEO

Anthony Servideo is coming off one of his best stretches at the Double-A level thus far. Servideo went 6-for-18 this past week with two doubles and his first career Double-A home run. Servideo has gone 3-for-15 this week, but is still 14 for his last 40 (.350), in addition to 12 walks in his past 14 games after having just five in his first 32 games at the Double-A level. Servideo has also collected eight multi-hit games since the start of June, after having just six-career multi-hit games prior.

WEEKEND TRAFFIC

In their past two wins, the Baysox have hit .231 (6-for-26) with runners in scoring position, after going just 2-for-25 (.080) and leaving 27 runners on-base through the first three games of the week. In total, Bowie is hitting .229 as a team with runners in scoring position - the third-lowest total in the Eastern League. However, Bowie has shown a peculiar trend to grow into its situational hitting as the series has gone on. This season, the Baysox hold a .213 average with runners in scoring position Monday - Wednesday (third-lowest in the league), while that average jumps to .236 in the later half of series (third-highest in the league).

SUNDAY SCARIES

The Baysox have struggled when it comes to winning on Sundays. Bowie has lost six-straight Sunday contests and is 2-9 this season on Sundays - the second-worst mark in Minor League Baseball. The Baysox staff posts a 5.99 ERA on Sundays - second-worst in the Eastern League and fourth-worst in Double-A. Sundays are the worst individual day for the Bowie pitching staff by over 1.5 runs per game. However, Bowie does hit .246 on Sundays, which is the third-best mark in the league.

- Sixth-most strikeouts and innings across the Orioles' system in 2022, along with the third-most wins.
- Held opponents to a .183 average with runners in scoring position.
- Named South Atlantic League pitcher of the Week on May 15, after twirling six shutout innings with eight strikeouts against Hudson Valley. Part of a month where he pitched to a 1.64 ERA and held opponents to a .116 average.
- Spent all three seasons in Aberdeen, but due to the reclassification of minor league baseball, advanced to High-A from Single-A short season in between 2019 and 2021.
- Spent three seasons starting games for VCU. Was first-team all-conference as a senior, posting a 2.50 ERA through 20 starts and 86.1 innings. His 118 strikeouts in 2019 are fourth-most in program history.

- 4/7 Dealt with multiple runners on base in all three innings worked, including runners at third base in the second and third innings.
- 4/26 Retired five straight batters, but allowed three-straight extra-base hits with two outs in the second inning. Allowed three-straight singles in the third inning.

ALEX PHAM

DRAFT - 9TH ROUND 2021 (UNIV. OF SAN FRANCISCO)

Started Double-A career with nine scoreless innings over two starts. // Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. // Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23 1/3 IP. // .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. // Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. // Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, throwing two earned runs through 11 innings before promoting to Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 2022 innings in the regular season. // Allowed one run in 2 1/3 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen. // Pitched 6.22 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs in the final game of the season, appearing in Delmarva's final game in the season. // The season was pitched over four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

MILB FREE AGENT - 2022

Began 2023 season with High-A Aberdeen, where he only surrendered a single earned run in 11 appearances, while also picking up a save and a hold. // Acquired by the Orioles as a free agent on 5/25/2022 after being released by the Tigers in December. // Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on 6/6, where he allowed two earned runs in three appearances across 4.2 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on 6/21. Pitched in 16 games the remainder of the season, with a 1.00 ERA and 1.00 WHIP. // Signed with the Orioles as a free agent on 1/2/2023. Threw 2.1 scoreless innings across the postseason for Aberdeen. Only allowed two earned runs through his last 11 appearances (13.2 IP) of the season. // Pitched for Scottsdale in Arizona Fall League following the season. // Pitched exclusively for the GCL Tigers while with Detroit from 2019-2021, registering a collective 7.39 ERA. // Was originally signed by the Orioles as an undrafted free agent by Detroit on 7/1/2019 out of Pfeiffer University, where he had a 1.82 ERA in his first season as a junior.

DRAFT - 29TH ROUND 2019 (MISSISSIPPI)

One of five Orioles' minor league arms to throw over 80 innings each of the past two seasons. // Fifth-most innings, eighth-most strikeouts and second-most wins across the Orioles' system in 2022. // Struck out a career-high eight or four shutout, one-hit innings against Jersey Shore on June 15. Allowed only one earned run across his eight 29.2 innings of the season, including four scoreless innings across two postseason outings. // Also spent 2019 in Aberdeen when it was the Single-A short season affiliate of the Orioles, before spending 2020 in Single-A Delmarva. // Pitched in both a starting and relief role for three seasons at Ole Miss after growing up and attending high school in Oxford. Named a Freshman All-American in 2017, with a staff low 1.57 ERA. // Had a 20-strikeout complete game for Elmira in the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in the summer of 2017.

DRAFT - 12TH RD 2019 (WEST VIRGINIA)

2023 Spring Training NRI – Allowed an earned run with four walks and two strikeouts in two-thirds of an inning against Detroit on 2/26. // Limited to 17 regular season innings in 2022 due to injury. Placed on the IL on 5/21 after eight innings and just one earned run allowed to start the season for High-A Aberdeen. Sent on a rehab assignment on 8/12 to the FCL Orioles, before being sent back to Aberdeen four days later. Pitched 11 innings to close out the season and the first half of the season. // Injured again in 2021 with a shoulder flexion, abduction and extension injury. He pitched in the seventh inning of game three in the South Atlantic League Championship Series – a game the IronBirds would lose 4-0. // Saw 2021 season end in late August, also due to injury in Aberdeen. His ERA and BAA were both a team worst for any pitcher with at least 20 innings. // Pitched for the IronBirds in 2019 as the A-SS affiliate for the Orioles in 2019. // Played three seasons for West Virginia – two as a full-time starter. His 36 career starts are eighth in school history.

He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
