Juan Nunez set an early tone on the mound for Delmarva, tossing 4.1 innings, matching his career-high with 8 strikeouts but Lynchburg grabbed the lead once he departed in the fifth as the generated the first run of the game on a bases-loaded walk. The combination of **Adam Tulloch** and **Zach Jacobs** shutdown the Shorebirds all game as Tulloch punched out 7 across 3.2 scoreless innings as the starter, and Jacobs entered in relief in the fourth and allowed nothing as he perfected Delmarva in 4.1 innings striking out 7 of his own. After an RBI single by Guy Lipscomb in the seventh, Magnus Ellerts notched the save in straight order in the ninth as the Shorebirds finished the night with a season-high 16 strikeouts and did not have any base runners in the final five innings of the game.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT:** Alfred Vega gets the ball in game four for the Shorebirds on Friday night and he'll be in a duel with **Adam Peterson** for the Hillcats who has not allowed an earned run in his last three starts and is riding a run 18.1 without surrendering an earned run. The right-hander was Cleveland's 9th round selection in the 2022 draft out of UCONN last pitched five shutout innings against Salem in a victory last Saturday.

**ON THE DOUBLE:** The offense has provided extra-base hits regularly this season as they are tops in the league in that category with 102 through the first 40 games. Their 67 doubles this year are currently the most in the league. **Samuel Basallo** leads the team with 11 two-baggers this season and there are 7 players on the Shorebirds roster who have 6 or more.

LEADER IN THE CLUBHOUSE: Samuel Basallo has put together an incredibly productive first season in fullseason baseball as the 18 year old catcher is the current Carolina League leader in RBIs with 35. Basallo has four games this season with 3 RBI and a career-best 4 RBI performance against Fredericksburg on April 18. He is currently second in the league in hits with 43 just behind **Tim Elko** (48).

FEELING YOUNG: Carter Young has remained an on-base machine for the Shorebirds as of late. Since May 13, Young is third in the Carolina League in OBP at .432 as he has 9 hits and 10 walks in that 10-game span. He has scored 9 runs during that time which is tied for most in the league with fellow teammate Elio Prado.

**PRADO AT THE TOP: Elio Prado** has had a strong run going at the plate since moving into the leadoff spot in the order as he is batting 17/49 over the last ten games, striking out only four times in that time frame. His average of .355 is the best on the club in the last 12 games, and his frequency on base has helped him score a teambest 10 runs in that span as he is now the team-leader with 24.

HOT TEJADA: Angel Tejada has caught fire for the Shroebirds over the last week as he is batting .333 in his last seven games with 9 hits, a double, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI. Tejada matched his career-high in hits and RBI on Tuesday with three each in a 11-3 win over Lynchburg.

WILLEMS MAGIC: Creed Willems hit his team-high 8th home run of the season on Wednesday night in eighth inning to propel the Shorebirds to a 5-3 win. Of the 8 home runs Willems has hit this season, 6 of them have come in the sixth inning or later and 4 of them have either tied the game or give the Shorebirds the lead.

FIRST GLIMPSE OF THE HILLCATS: The Shorebirds will face the Cleveland Guardians affiliate for the first time in 2023 this week. Delmarva won the season series versus Lynchburg last season going 14-10 against the Hillcats. It was just of two teams the Shorebirds had a winning record against in 2022 (Down East) as Delmarva finished season strong winning 9 of the final 12 games over Lynchburg.
