On September 17, 2013, the PCL Champion Omaha Storm Chasers defeated the IL Champion Durham Bulls 2-1, at Coca-Cola Park in Allentown, Pennsylvania. **Chris Dwyer** threw 7.0 scoreless innings, while **Irving Fula** went 3-for-5 with an RBI single in the 6th.

This was Omaha's 2nd of 3 Triple-A titles and the first of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

HOW SWEEP IT IS

After being swept in Toledo back in April, the Storm Chasers returned the favor and swept the Mud Hens last week at Fifth Third Field.

- Last week, the Storm Chasers outscored the Mud Hens 37-11, with a season-high 6-game winning streak because of the sweep.
- Toledo won all 6 games of the series on their home turn, April 22 to 27 ... the Mud Hens outscored the Storm Chasers 30-17, in the middle of a season-long 8-game losing streak for Omaha.
- While the 6-game series scheduling format was introduced in 2021, Omaha has now 3 sweeps in a 6-game series since 2021 ... May 25-30, 2021 vs. Indianapolis, June 13-18, 2023 vs. Columbus and June 10-15, 2025 @ Toledo.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen recently compiled a stretch of 17.0 scoreless innings, compiling parts of 6 games, with 4 consecutive scoreless efforts from the relievers.

- Storm Chasers relievers combined for 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings, from the 8th inning last Tuesday through the 6th inning yesterday ... the bullpen threw 2.0 scoreless innings to end Tuesday's game in Toledo, then did not allow a run until the Bulls scored 4 in the 7th inning yesterday.
- Previously, the bullpen's longest scoreless streak this season was 13.2 innings, from May 7 to 10 ... 2024's longest scoreless relief streak was 12.1 innings.
- In total, the bullpen has 17 scoreless games this year ... 9 of 17 times Omaha relievers have not allowed a run, it's been a stretch of at least 4.0 innings of relief.
- Last week in Toledo, Omaha's bullpen led all 120 full season Minor League teams with a 0.51 WHIP. .099 opponents' average and 7.75 K/BB ... the relief corps' 1.25 ERA ranked 4th in the Minors last week ... the bullpen allowed just 3 earned runs in 21.2 innings of work, with 7 hits and 4 walks to 31 strikeouts.
- 3 members of Omaha's bullpen have not yet allowed a run in June ... RHP **Ryan Hendrix** (6.0 IP), RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** (3.0 IP) and LHP **Evan Sisk** (2.0 IP).

PITCH, PLEASE

Sunday was Omaha's 5th pitching shutout of the season, continuing a strong stretch on the mound, with 3 shutouts in its last 5 games.

- Omaha's .151 opponents' average (26-for-172) and 0.84 WHIP (16 BB + 26 H in 50.0 IP) were the best among full season Minor League teams last week ... those two marks and the staff's 1.98 ERA (11 ER in 50.0 IP) are Omaha's BEST in any series since joining the International League in 2021.
- Storm Chasers pitchers did not allow a run over a season-high stretch of 23.0 innings, from 2nd inning Wednesday through the 1st inning Saturday ... that nearly matched last year's longest scoreless streak of 24.0 innings without allowing a run, from August 2 to 4 @ Rochester.
- Overall, a 0.93 WHIP and .168 opponents' average from Omaha's pitchers against Toledo were the best of any Triple-A pitching staff last week ... the group's 2.41 ERA was 2nd at the Triple-A level ... previously, the best ERA Omaha had in a 6-game series this year was 3.66, May 6-11 @ Louisville.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 104 bases this year, and only been caught 17 times ... 104 steals rank 4th in the International League and 5th in Triple-A.
- 104-for-121 in steal attempts is a 86.0% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 4th-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.5%, 51-for-57).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 665 strikeouts this season ... that is the most of any team in the league or at the Triple-A level, just ahead of the Iowa Cubs (660).

- Over 594.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.06 K/9, which ranks tied 2nd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- With 665 strikeouts through 69 games, an average of 9.63 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,436 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

The Omaha Storm Chasers rank near the top of the Triple-A level in both sacrifice bunts (14) and sacrifice flies (31) as well.

- The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts in 2024, with 38 last year ... 14 this year are the 2nd-most in the league, 4th at the Triple-A level, and tied 15th in the Minors.
- 31 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and tied for the 3rd-most in the Minor Leagues ... **Tyler Gentry** leads the league with 6 sac flies, 1 off the MiLB lead.

- ✓ Hatch is making his **12th start with Omaha** this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after signing a Minor League deal with the Royals in February ... spent 2024 in Japan with the Hiroshima Toyo Carp.
- ✓ In his 2nd stint with the Storm Chasers this season ... went up to the Majors June 5, did not appear in the game.
- ✓ Was named last week's **International League Pitcher of the Week** for his 6.0 scoreless innings @ Toledo ... enters today on a 13.0-inning scoreless streak, with 2 consecutive scoreless starts.
- ✓ **Playing his 9th professional season this year** ... Royals are Hatch's 4th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Cubs, Blue Jays, Pirates and in Japan ... has appeared in 39 Major League games from 2020 to 2023.
- ✓ Began his pro career as a starter, his first 80 games were starts, 2017 to 2020 ... from MLB debut on July 26, 2020 through 2023, just 44 of his 112 appearances were starts, with 33 total relief appearances in his 39 MLB games.
- ✓ Goes by his middle name, Thomas, to honor his grandfather whom he was named after.

Named IL Pitcher of the Week for this start ... threw his team-leading 4th quality start of the year ... pitched on 13 days' rest after getting called up to the big leagues and not pitching ... worked around a walk and single in the 1st inning, then faced the minimum the rest of the way ... retired 10 straight from the 1st inning into the 4th, allowed a single in the 4th, but runner was caught stealing ... retired his final 7 batters ... threw 10 pitches or less in 4 of 6 innings.

- ✓ Has allowed 3 runs between the 1st and 2nd innings this year (22.0 IP) ... 23 of 26 runs allowed have come between the 3rd and 7th innings (35.0 IP).
- ✓ Has made 4 quality starts over his last 4 outings with Omaha ... in this stretch, since May 8, has pitched to a 2.08 ERA (7 ER in 30.1 IP), with a 0.96 WHIP and .216 opponents' average.
