'CAPS TIE FRANCHISE RECORD IN 21-4 WIN: The West Michigan Whitecaps enjoyed an offensive explosion of epic proportions, tying the franchise single-game runs record as part of a 21-4 win over the Lake County Captains on Saturday night at Classic Park. The Whitecaps, who scored 20 runs in a 20-6 win on June 13 at Lansing to clinch the first-half Midwest League Eastern Division, plated one more on Saturday night to tie the franchise record for runs scored when Luke Gold slammed a solo home run to lead off the eighth inning. The 21 runs tie a 15-year-old record when the Whitecaps defeated the Dayton Dragons 21-10 on August 8, 2010. The 'Caps played 20 or more for the second time in June -- marking the first time in franchise history that the Whitecaps have plated 20 runs in multiple games during a season.

POSTSEASON PLANS: The 'Caps will host a playoff game the second week of September, scheduled for Thursday the 11th at 6:35 pm against the second-half Midwest League Eastern Division champion. Individual tickets will go on sale July 8 at 10:00 am on whitecapsbaseball.com.

CLINCHING WITH FLARE: The Whitecaps broke or tied several records in their historic 20-6 Eastern Division clincher on June 13, including breaking the single-game hits record (26 vs. 25), and most at-bats in a nine-inning game (52 vs. 51). Moreover, the club tied the franchise's high-water mark for runs in an inning with 13 in the third, and three home runs in the frame. A pair of players in Seth Stephenson and John Peck tied the club record with 7 at-bats in the contest, while every player in the 'Caps starting lineup enjoyed a multi-hit performance.

SEARS IS SIZZLING: Pitcher Andrew Sears closed the Month of May with some of the best numbers among all pitchers in the Midwest League, going 3-1 with a 1.57 ERA with a 6/29 BB/K ratio in 23 IP. He then matched his High-A record in strikeouts in his first start in June - allowing just one hit through 4.2 innings pitched with eight strikeouts against the Dragons back on June 6. In June, Sears has allowed just two runs through 14.2 innings pitched while working a 7/16 walk-to-strikeout ratio and holding opposing hitters to just a .170 BAA.

PEPPERING THE LEADERBOARD: The Whitecaps are the only Midwest League team ranked in the Top 3 in all three team categories, as they sit 1st in hitting (.266), 1st in pitching (3.05 ERA), and are 1st in total defense with a fielding percentage of .979.

A LOT TO A LITTLE: The Whitecaps currently sit with the second-best run differential in all of Minor League Baseball at +179, trailing AAA Las Vegas (+186) & ahead of the Tigers Double-A affiliate, the Erie Seawolves (+167).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The Whitecaps hold a 23-9 record in games played at LMCU Ballpark this season -- which sits in the top-10 in all of Minor League Baseball. After a 2-0 victory over the Lansing Lugnuts on May 6, the 'Caps began the season a perfect 10-0 for the first time in franchise history - with their previous high coming in 2009 - where they won six straight games to begin the season. Moreover, due to games plated, the 'Caps actually have more road wins (28) than home victories (23).

TOP DOG IN THE MiLB: The Tigers had the No. 1 farm system in baseball heading into the 2025 season according to MLB Pipeline, and currently boast five prospects in MLB Pipeline's updated top 100: IF Max Clark (No. 7), IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 22), IF Bryce Rainer (No. 42), C/IF Josue Briceño (No. 75), and C Thayron Liranzo (No. 80).

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: RHP Max Alba makes his 10th start and 14th overall appearance tonight after allowing just one run through 4.2 innings with a trio of strikeouts as part a 3-2 win over Lake County to begin this series on Tuesday night. Alba has grown into his role as a starter - and the numbers have proven this - allowing just nine earned runs through his last 30.2 innings on the mound while working a 10/30 walk-to-strikeout ratio.

FOR LAKE COUNTY: LHP Caden Favors - who was selected in the sixth round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Wichita State - makes his 15th start of the season. Despite a high ERA (4.11), Favors has done his part in reducing hard contact - posting a 60-32 strikeout-to-walk ratio but holding opposing hitters to just a .220 BAA. Favors, who went from walk-on at Wichita State to the ace in their rotation, exhibits a short arm action paired with a three-quarters delivery generating natural extension above 6.5 feet. His arsenal features a 4-seamer, and 2-seamer/sinker at near identical low-90s velocities and spin rates near or above 2,700 rpm. Favors showcases an upper-70s curveball with spin rates around 2,800 rpm, an upper-80s slider with spin rates above 2,800 rpm, and a low-80s change-up with spin rates around 1,800 rpm.

Max Alba emerged from the prep ranks as the No. 1 right-hander and No. 5 player in the state of Wisconsin in 2018 - posting a 1.00 ERA with a WHIP of 0.67 while providing pop on offense too - hitting .426 his senior season. Alba was selected by the Angels in the 39th round of the 2018 MLB Draft but decided to forgo the pro route and play college ball at North Carolina. Alba finished his college career with the Liberty Flames before a brief stint in the MLB Draft League where he shined - going 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA and 25 strikeouts in 21 innings pitched before signing with the Tigers in July of 2022.

2022: Threw just 1.2 innings in the complex league - allowing two runs through 1.2 innings pitched.

2023: Pitched 41 games out of the Single-A Lakeland bullpen in 2023, going 6-6 with a 4.07 ERA - tallying 65 strikeouts over 55.1 innings of work and holding opposing hitters to .224 BAA and registering seven saves.
