#### JACKSONVILLE FALLS IN BLOWOUT FASHION

After an eight-run first inning for Nashville, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp allowed a total of 17 runs to the Sounds. The 17-3 loss was the largest margin of defeat for Jacksonville this season. Nashville sent 10 men to the plate in their eight-run first which was highlighted by two home runs, a grand slam from Patrick Dorrian and a two-run shot by Luis Urias. Jacksonville scored two runs in the fourth and one run in the sixth. After trailing 9-3, Nashville came back with their second eight-run inning of the contest, sending 12 men to the plate and knocking around seven hits in the inning.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 37 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 58-for-156 at the plate, slashing 372/418/468/886 with six doubles, three home runs, 22 RBIs and 34 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to the second in the International League in batting average (.351) and eighth in OBP (.423). Among the 281 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.7 percent).

#### **AUSTIN POWERS**

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 47 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 50-for-166 (.301/.380/.693/1.073) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 47 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 14.0 percent of the time in 2023.

#### NFFD FOR SPFFD

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Thursday, pushing his personal streak to 23 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84 0 percent stolen hase success rate is third in Triple-A and sixth out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Jake Mangum was the first Jumbo Shrimp to be caught stealing since July 9.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Following their 17-3 loss to Nashville on Friday, 14 of Jacksonville's last 22 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 93 games played thus far in 2023, 51 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 23-28 (.451) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other 13 games of the second half of the season. Jacksonville is just 4-9, with all four of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those nine defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 44 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -25 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester & Nashville).

#### MINIMUM EFFICIENCY

Over the entirety of their six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9, the Jumbo Shrimp walked just 20 Knights. Jacksonville has followed that up with a whopping 55 walks over their last seven games, including 11 on Saturday against Worcester, which matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp have thrown 1301 pitches during the 60 innings they've played since that series (21.7 per inning). In comparison, the WooSox and Sounds have tossed 1043 in 63.0 innings over the six games, an average of 16.6 per inning. Jacksonville has stunningly walked at least seven batters in seven consecutive games.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Following a four game winning streak to start their series in Charlotte from July 4-7, Jacksonville has lost five of their last seven games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 7-8 against the Sounds this season. Nashville has outscored Jacksonville 95-67 in those games... Jacksonville's 14-3 loss on Friday was their worst loss since falling 17-1 to Mississippi in 2018.

#### **ABOUT CHI CHI**

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.
