Familiar Faces: The Athletics, the Nuts' current MLB partner, are playing a three-game series at Toronto, the Nuts' prior MLB partner, meaning that each game in the series is filled with Lansing alumni. Last night, Bo Bichette (2017 in Lansing) and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017) homered, and Alejandro Kirk (2019) went 3-for-3 with a walk to lead the Jays to a 12-0 victory. The A's squad included reliever Hogan Harris (2022) and batsmen Lawrence Butler (2021-22), Jacob Wilson (2023), Max Schuemann (2021), Tyler Soderstrom (2022) and Denzel Clarke (2022).

Wink to the Show: Three Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season: Max Muncy on March 27, Gunnar Hoglund on May 2, and Denzel Clarke on May 23. 196 Lugnuts have now gone from Lansing to the Majors all-time... so who will be next? How about 2022-23 Lug Jack Winkler, who was called up today by the Miami Marlins!

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Rocking Double-A: Promoted a few weeks ago to the Midland RockHounds, 21-year-old Kyle Robinson turned in his second straight quality start, striking out eight in six innings of one-run ball to lead Midland to a 2-1 win yesterday over Corpus Christi.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.263), 1st in base hits (412), 2nd in doubles (95), 2nd in on-base percentage (.357), 3rd in total bases (617) and are the toughest team to strike out (329).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (22), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (16), 1st in fewest balks (3), 2nd in fewest walks (164) and tied for 3rd in saves (13).

In the Field: The Nuts have the 2nd best fielding percentage (.979), having committed the 2nd fewest errors (36) while turning the 2nd most double plays (46). Lansing has also allowed the 3rd fewest stolen bases (40 in 58 attempts).

Lugnuts on the Leaderboard: T.J. Schofield-Sam tops the Midwest League in batting average (.359) and base hits (56), tied for 2nd in total bases (80), 3rd in runs scored (34) and ranks 5th in OPS (.930) and OBP (.417). **Tommy "Tommy Tanks" White** is 2nd in the league in slugging percentage (.544) and 4th in OPS (.938) and while ranking 5th in batting average (.312). **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** is tied for 3rd in doubles (13). **Mark Adamiak** is 1st in saves (8). **Blaze Pontes** is 1st in appearances (17). **Grant Judkins** is 4th in innings pitched (46 1/3) and is one of only four pitchers in the league with a complete game.

What a Crowd: Wednesday's attendance of 8,863 put the Lugnuts 22nd among 120 Minor League teams in highest single game attendance. The attendance ranks 1st among all High-A single game crowds this season.

2008: Justin Jackson led off the bottom of the 1st inning with a double, moved to third on a John Tolisano single, and scored on a Matt Liuzza RBI groundout - and that was it for the scoring in a 1-0 Lugnuts victory over Great Lakes. The Loons collected 10 hits against Marc Rzepczynski (5 IP, 6 K) and Edgar Estanga (4 IP, 1 K) but were held off the scoreboard. The Nuts finished with only four hits, with Tolisano going 3-for-3.

2015: Sean Reid-Foley struck out 10 Dayton Dragons in 5 2/3 innings of one-hit ball, and the Lugnuts blanked the host Dayton Dragons, 4-0. Anthony Alford went 1-for-4 to extend his on-base streak to 33 games. The streak ended the next day.

2018: Ryan Noda's first home run of the year was a dramatic go-ahead two-run tape-measure blast into the Chevy Terrace in the bottom of the eighth, and the Lugnuts beat the Captains at Cooley Law School Stadium. Maximo Castillo struck out nine in five innings in a no-decision.

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.
