Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the tenth game in a 12-game, 14-day road trip, the fourth tilt in a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Nuts are 4-2 against Great Lakes this year, splitting a doubleheader last night.

Last Night, Game 1: Loons 4, Lugnuts 3. Trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the sixth inning, **Taylor Young** lashed a three-run double down the left field line and the Loons held off a late Lugnuts threat to take the doubleheader opener.

Game 2: Lugnuts 7, Loons 5. Great Lakes seized the lead with a four-run third inning, only to get wiped out by a seven-run Nuts fifth inning that saw consecutive two-run singles from **Caeden Trenkle** and **Daniel Susac** followed by a Little League home run for **Junior Pérez**.

On the Air: Today's game is on Bally Live and MiLB TV with **Brad Tunney** and **John Vicari**, and an audio-only 'cast via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jakska**.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play at the Loons through Monday, returning home on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains, starting a six-game series at Jackson Field.

LUG•NOTES

One Base at a Time: The Lugnuts have 17 hits in the first three games of this series; all but one, a **Danny Bautista, Jr.** seventh-inning double in Game 1 last night, are singles. Conversely, the Loons have 21 hits – seven singles, 11 doubles, one triple, two homers. Yesterday, Great Lakes put the double in doubleheader with four two-baggers in each game of the twinbill.

Start Your Engines: This series features the two clubs with the most stolen bases in the Midwest League, with 112 steals for Great Lakes and 105 steals for the Lugnuts. The Loons are 7-for-10 thus far in the series, with three players picked off. The Nuts are 4-for-4, with two steals yesterday leading directly to two of the club's three runs in Game 1.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense has turned a league-leading 68 double plays this year, ten more than second-place South Bend and West Michigan and 35 more than 12th-place Quad Cities. The Nuts' 53 errors ranks second lowest in the circuit, with only two errors in the last six games and 34 errorless games this season.

The Future is Now: 2022 Lugnuts stars **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Lawrence Butler** will play in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game, Soderstrom's second time appearing in the Futures Game (2021). 2022 Lugnuts outfielder **Denzel Clarke**, currently in Double-A Midland with Butler, played in last year's Futures Game, joining **Ángel Perdomo** (2016), **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** (2017) as active Nuts to play in the event.

Among the League Leaders: OF **Jonny Butler** is tied for second in triples (6), fifth in slugging (.463), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (25), tied for sixth in stolen bases with teammate **Junior Pérez** (19) and tied for seventh in home runs (10). Catcher **Daniel Susac** is sixth in batting average (.278). Closer **Tyler Baum** is tied for first in saves (9).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in Lansing team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles in Lugnuts history: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: Chris Hawkins's two-out bases-loaded grounder up the middle in the bottom of the ninth seemingly lifted the Lugnuts to walk-off victory over the Great Lakes Loons. But Santiago Nussy, the Lugnuts' base runner at first, did not run to second base, turning around and celebrating with his teammates. The Loons executed the force play at second base, erasing the game-winning run, and then defeated the Lugnuts in ten innings, 5-4.

2017: Drama in South Bend! With two balls and two strikes on J.B. Woodman, the bases loaded, two outs, and the South Bend Cubs clinging to a 5-4 lead, Woodman injured an abdominal muscle hitting a foul ball against closer Wyatt Short and was forced to leave the game. He was replaced by pinch-hitter Bo Bichette who took Ball 3 high, fouled one off to the right, and then swung and missed a high fastball to end the game.

2018: Samad Taylor stole four bases in an 8-4 victory over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond, setting the single-game franchise record. The Lugnuts second baseman stole third base in the third inning, second and third base in the fifth inning, and second base in the seventh inning.

Retrospective: Watters made his Midwest League debut at Four Winds Field last year on August 31, opposing rehabber Wade Miley in Lansing debut... had made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts: August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26 and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Current Ranking: MLB Pipeline ranks Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 12 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."
