LRST TIME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA - Sept 12) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 6-5 Friday night at PNC Field with a bases-loaded walk-off free pass in the eleventh inning.

Scott Kingery led off the game with a solo homer to left off Scranton/Wilkes-Barre starter Tom Pannone for a 1-0 IronPigs advantage. The RailRiders jumped ahead in the third. With a runner on, Jahmai Jones drilled a two-run shot to left 409 feet, putting Scranton/Wilkes-Barre up 2-1. Lehigh Valley regained the lead in the sixth. Jim Haley drove in a pair with a double to left and Carlos De La Cruz hit an RBI single, making it 4-2. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre pulled within one in the eighth. After Oscar Gonzalez doubled, Jones singled for his third RBI of the game to make it 4-3. The RailRiders worked the bases loaded but an inning-ending double play kept Lehigh Valley ahead.

Down a run in the ninth, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tied it up to send the game to extras. Taylor Trammell worked a walk to lead off. Cam Eden came in to pinch run and stole second, advancing to third on an errant throw. After Carlos Narvaez walked, Greg Allen pinch-ran and stole second. An RBI base hit from Oscar Gonzalez tied the contest at four.

Allen's ninth-inning steal was the 224th of the season for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and set a new modern-era International League stolen base record, surpassing Omaha's tally of 223 in 2023. After a scoreless tenth, Carlos De La Cruz singled home Jared Thomas in the top of the eleventh to give the IronPigs a 5-4 lead. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre won the game in the home half of the frame. JC Escarra singled to lead off. A sacrifice fly off the bat of Oscar Gonzalez knotted the game at five. With two outs, Yankees #16 Prospect Jorbit Vivas singled and Caleb Durbin was hit by a pitch to load the bases. Ben Rice then worked a free pass to plate Escarra and walk off the IronPigs, winning the game 6-5.

NEWS & NOTES

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE RECORD- The RailRiders set the single-season stolen base record in the International League with 224 steals, topping the mark of 223 set by Omaha last summer. They have reached 200 stolen bases for the first time in franchise history with an 83% success rate. This tops last year's franchise record of 174 swipes. Brandon Lockridge led in his tenure with 34 while Caleb Durbin has 26 and counting. Twenty-three players have had at least one. The Charleston Charlies also had 224 in 1976.

ELEVENTH HEAVEN - The RailRiders have played in three contests that have gone into the 11th inning this season and they have won all of them. All of these games have occurred in the second half of the season and they have outscored opponents 15-5 in extras. The team holds a 6-3 record when the game goes tied into additional frames.

WALK-OFF HEROICS - After a 6-5 victory in the 11th inning, the RailRiders recorded their seventh walk-off win of the season. They are 1-1 in extras against the IronPigs.

A MAGIC MAN - Manager Shelley Duncan emptied the bench in an effort to take down Lehigh Valley last night. It worked, but he ran out of available hitters in the 11th inning. Scott Effross was slated in the order but Duncan pinch-hit for him with fellow arm Josh Maciejewski. Magic batted from the left side and struck out looking. It was the first time a pitcher batted for the RailRiders since Chance Adams did so since April 11, 2019.

LEADING OFF SWINGING - Scott Kingery of the IronPigs smacked a leadoff homer to begin the contest yesterday. The RailRiders have allowed five lead-off homers to their opponents this season with now the past three of them coming off the bats of Lehigh Valley. Weston Wilson homered off of Yoendrys Gómez on July 2 and Cal Stevenson got to Will Warren on July 6.

LOU LOOKING GOOD - Lou Trivino is finding it on the bump as his rehab assignment extends on. After allowing runs in his first three appearances, the righty has turned it around with three straight scoreless outings. He has now tossed 3.2 consecutive run-free innings.

POST-SEASON POSSIBILITY- The RailRiders sit in fourth as they are four and a half games back of Columbus in the International League. Worcester and Indianapolis are also in front of them. Lehigh Valley is ten games out of the leader as there are 8 games left to play.

WHO CAN GO? - The RailRiders active roster currently contains nine players that are also on the Yankees 40-man roster. There are four pitchers, including one starter. The team also features five position players who are eligible for a quick call-up, including #16 Jorbit Vivas, Oswald Peraza, Ben Rice, and Carlos Narvaez also remain on the big league 40-man.

2023 TRIPS: Began season on injured list with elbow inflammation. Activated and assigned to Somerset on 5/30, made season and Double-A debut on 5/31 with 11 total relief appearances...Was promoted to SWB on 8/1 where he made 10 starts

SPRING NUMBER: Made one appearance in spring training against the Phillies...Pitched 2.2 innings allowing just one hit and a walk...Struck out three on 40 pitches

IMPRESSIVE FEAT: Pitched an immaculate inning at Binghamton on 7/16/23

GROWING UP: A Hawaii native, Barclay grew up in Hilo and attended St. Joseph High School, which did not have a baseball program, instead playing in his local PONY league.

COLLEGE JOURNEY: Pitched one season each at Central Arizona College (2017), Gateway Community College (AZ, 2018) and Cal State-Bakersfield (2019). Was a 3x Western Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week in his season at Cal State-Bakersfield, where he led the WAC with 111 strikeouts and also led the Roadrunners in shutouts (2) and complete games (2) en route to being named 2019 Academic All-WAC.

- **2023:** Began the season on the injured list and was activated on 5/30 with Double-A Somerset going 3-1 with a 1.32 ERA - all eleven appearances were out of the bullpen (34.0IP, 51K, 11BB)...Promoted to Triple-A SWB on 08/01 where he completed ten starts for a 5.89 ERA (44.1IP, 49K, 33BB)...Tied career-high eight strikeouts in a game twice during the season
