Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators on Thursday night. It is the second-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and second-of-six in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Harrisburg last season 7-5, with a 3-3 record at home, and 4-2 on the road. The teams play next in the final week of the regular season in Harrisburg from Sept. 10-15. Harrisburg leads the season series 1-0.

R-Phils.

Looking Back

Reading and Harrisburg were postponned due to rain on Wednesday night, and the teams will make up the game in a doubleheader on Saturday. Previously, the Fightin Phils fell 7-6 on Tuesday night at Harrisburg. Reading jumped out to a 2-0 lead, thanks to Carson Taylor's team-leading seventh home run of the season, a two-run shot. Harrisburg immediately tied it with two runs in the second. Reading got one back in the fifth from a Caleb Ricketts RBI single to make it 3-2. Harrisburg again tied it at three in the sixth, scored three in the seventh to then make it 5-3. The Fightin Phils scored one in the bottom of the seventh on a triple and error from Marcus Lee Sang, then Kendall Simmons blasted a two-run shot to center in the eighth to make it 7-6. Noah Skirrow started and went six innings, marking the eighth time a Reading pitcher has went six innings this season, but the R-Phils are just 3-5 in such games.

Tayloring The Leaderboard

Carson Taylor hit his team-leading seventh home run last night, along with his team-best 40th RBI. Taylor's 40 RBI lead the Eastern League and rank second in Double-A. Taylor's other Eastern League ranks include: AVG (4th/.304), OBP (9th/.393), SLG (4th/.522), OPS (T-3rd/.915).

Who's Hot

Marcus Lee Sang continued his hot-stretch with a triple and run scored on Tuesday night. Since the calendar flipped to May, Lee Sang is slashing .319/.360/.436, with a .796 OPS. He's added five extra-base hits and seven RBI in that stretch. Lee Sang is currently on a four-game hitting streak. Kendall Simmons blasted his sixth home run Tuesday night, and fifth since May began. After hitting .182 in April, Simmons is hitting .296, with nine extra-base hits and 11 RBI since May began. Simmons is also riding a nine-game on-base streak, with a .321 average and .441 on-base percentage over that stretch.

Ricketts Rolling

Caleb Ricketts remained hot with two-more hits and a RBI in Tuesday night's game. He has been incredibly steady since the start of the season and in two games in June, he is hitting .375. Ricketts is currently on an 11-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the R-Phils, which dates back to May 19. Over the course of that on-base streak, Ricketts is hitting .293, with a .408 on-base percentage. He's also added three extra-base hits and 10 RBI over the streak. Ricketts .284 average would rank second amongst Eastern League catchers, if he qualified. It trails only Portland's Kyle Teel.

Defensive Improvement

The Fightin Phils have seen their defense improve over the past week. During last week at Hartford, Reading committed just two errors, which was least in the Eastern League. Additionally, their .990 fielding percentage ranked as the best in the league last week. Reading is tied for 11th in fielding percentage at .969 and is 10th in the league with 53 errors, but those numbers continue to improve for the R-Phils. After ranking at the bottom of the Eastern League in double plays turned, the Fightin Phils have turned six since May 28, which ranks tied for fourth in the Eastern League over that stretch. They've now turned 27 this season which is tied for 11th in the league.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 6, 2007: At Reading, Kyle Kendrick fires Reading's first 9-inning complete game of the season as the R-Phils beat Harrisburg, 8-1. Kendrick surrenders six hits while striking out five. His next start would come in Philadelphia a week later.

Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight alone first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison with a 31-21 record. The Senators are on the back-half of a two-week road trip, after splitting a six-game series at Binghamton last week. Following this week, Harrisburg returns home and welcomes Bowie to FNB Field. Harrisburg's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Washington Nationals' top-30 prospects: Dylan Crews (2), Brady House (3), Yohandy Morales (4), Robert Hassell III (8), Andrew Pinckney (17), Cole Henry (21), Israel Pineda (22), Dustin Saenz (25), Andry Lara (28) and Marquis Grissom (29).

Senators Pitcher

Righty Michael Cuevas makes the start on Wednesday night for Harrisburg. This season, Cuevas is 1-3, with a 5.56 ERA over nine starts (45.1 IP, 48 H, 18 BB, 30 SO). He last pitched May 30 at Binghamton, suffering the loss. Cuevas tossed five innings and allowed five-earned runs, with five strikeouts. Cuevas spent all of 2023 with Harrisburg, going 4-8, with a 5.53 ERA over 23 starts. He pitched twice (5/24 and 8/26) against Reading, going 2-0 over 11 innings, allowing nine hits and six-earned runs, with three walks and 12 strikeouts. He did hit three batters in six innings on May 24. Cuevas spent all of 2022 with High-A Wilmington, 2021 with Single-A Fredericksburg and 2019 with the GCL-Nationals. Washington took the 22-year old in the 23rd round in 2019 out of high school.
