The Round Rock Express and Tacoma Rainiers (Seattle Mariners affiliate) are slated for game three of their six-game series on Thursday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Johnny Cueto is scheduled to take the mound against Rainiers RHP Michael Mariot. First pitch is scheduled for 7:15 p.m. CT.

ONE-RUN WEDNESDAY WIN

The E-Train held on for a 3-2 win over the Rainiers on Wednesday night. Round Rock took an early 2-0 lead with one run in both the first and second innings. In the first, C Andrew Knapp hit a two-out double and scored thanks to a single from DH Sam Huff. SS Jose Barrero rounded the bases in the second on a Dustin Harris base knock. The game was tied at 2-2 as Tacoma plated one run in the third and fourth. The third inning saw CF Jonatan Clase reach base on a fielder's choice, move to second on an error and score as RF Cade Marlowe hit a single. In the fourth, 3B Luis Urias was sent home as SS Samad Taylor grounded out. Express 1B Blaine Crim made it a 3-2 game in the fifth inning when he blasted a triple before scoring as LF Trevor Hauger singled.

HERE'S JOHNNY

Round Rock RHP Johnny Cueto is scheduled for his fifth start as a member of the Express on Thursday night. Cueto lasted 1.1 innings and allowed seven earned runs in his last start on June 6 at Oklahoma City. The right-hander has 2,320 strikeouts between the Minor and Major Leagues.

HUFF HITS

Express DH Sam Huff finished 2-for-4 with an RBI and a strikeout on Wednesday. It was his first multi-hit game since May 31. He was 3-for-27 in his first seven games to start June before yesterday's multi-hit night. He hit seven home runs in his first 25 games but has not hit a home run in his last 23, with his last bomb coming on May 9 against Las Vegas.

ROBERT CONTINUES TO DEAL

Round Rock RHP Daniel Robert extended his scoreless-inning streak to 10.1 innings last night. His last earned run came on May 22 at Sugar Land. He has allowed six earned runs in his 16 appearances this year, with three coming in his first outing of the season. After he allowed three earned runs in just 0.1 innings on March 31, Robert owns a 1.27 ERA (3 ER/21.1 IP) with only five walks and 29 strikeouts since then.

TWO-OUT KNOCKS

All three of Round Rock's RBI yesterday came with two outs. CF Dustin Harris, DH Sam Huff and RF Trevor Hauger each collected an RBI single. The Express are hitting just .203 (55-271) with two outs and men in scoring position this year.

TWO CLOSE GAMES

Both games of the series thus far with Tacoma have entered the eighth inning with the Express leading by only one run. The E-Train improved to 25-4 when leading after seven innings and they are now 10-8 in one-run games this year.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

With 10 games left in the first half of the season, Round Rock is 8.5 games back of first-place Sugar Land in the overall standings. The winner of the first half gets home field advantage in the PCL Championship Series. Sacramento is 1.0 game back and Oklahoma City sits 5.0 games back in third place.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

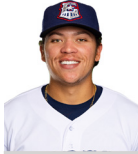
